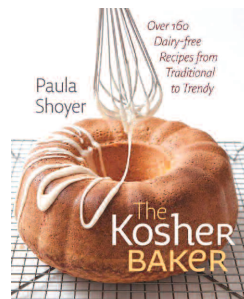

Reuven Hazan is a professor of Political Science at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. His expertise is in historical and current analysis of Israeli politics, particularly putting into context the developments that are in the headlines. Dr. Hazan was involved in reforming Israel's electoral system and continues to advise Israel's politicians on the restructuring of its legislative branch.

He appeared as a commentator on NPR as well as in major television networks and newspapers including the *Los Angeles Times*, *Boston Globe*, *Time Magazine* and *Newsweek*.

Reuven Hazan is a ninth generation Israeli, born in Jerusalem, where his family has resided for well over 100 years.
