Greetings



Dear Friends:

What a joyous journey we in our Atlanta Jewish community have traveled during our Centennial year. We met financial and community building goals, conducted our first community-wide survey in ten years, and through it all celebrated our 100th birthday.

Our Centennial Mission to Israel in November, for example, drew a whopping 430 Jewish Atlantans. Together, we explored our Jewish homeland, shed tears at Yad Vashem, and celebrated Shabbat in Jerusalem. In February – exceeding all expectations – more than 7,500 Jewish Atlantans of every age and from every corner of the metro area turned out for the Jewish Community Centennial Celebration at the amazing Georgia Aquarium. What a day to remember!

Federation raised close to \$41 million in total resources this past year, an incredible achievement. Our community campaign allocated \$18.2 million, our largest allocation ever. The transition to a shorter, more efficient primacy period was a complete success. In addition, Federation's endowment efforts brought in over \$21 million in new funds. And through some very exciting programs, we engaged more women, young leaders, and professionals this year.


The occasion of our Centennial has given us an opportunity to look at our community in full perspective. Our Centennial coffee table book is a commemorative history, while the 2006 Jewish Community Centennial Study is a read on the present. From 76,800 Jews in 1996, the metro-Atlanta Jewish community now is home to 120,000 Jewish individuals – a phenomenal growth of 56 percent – making Atlanta the 11th largest Jewish community in the United States.

The study also revealed our challenges in serving and involving all members of our Jewish community, and we are ready to meet those challenges head on. Many new initiatives have already begun, such as the opening in April 2006 of the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta North Metro Campus, a central Jewish address serving the burgeoning North Metro area. There, social services and educational programs are already becoming a convenient and important part of the Jewish fabric, meeting needs and enriching lives. Engaging individuals, our affiliates, synagogues, and other Jewish partners is essential in defining and expressing the way our community wants to build Jewish Atlanta.

We offer immense gratitude to all our volunteers and leadership, the backbone of our entire community at every level, who served during the past year. A heartfelt *mazel tov* and *yasher koach* to Linda Selig, Federation's outgoing president, who stood steadfastly at the helm during these last two years guiding us with her experience, wisdom, humor, and grace.

Going forward, we'll also continue to make a deeper difference in the lives of our Jewish brethren worldwide. JFGA plans to contribute financially to bringing the last of the Ethiopian Jews to Israel and assisting their successful integration into Israeli society. In the Former Soviet Union, we will ensure that all older Jewish adults live dignified lives and that youth are connected to their Jewish identity.

Join us in making Atlanta a thriving, vibrant, caring Jewish community. Whether you work a campaign phoning, participate in a mission to Minsk, or aspire to community leadership; whether you are fresh out of college, an empty nester, or anywhere in between, the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta has a place for you.

Center for Jewish Philanthropy

More than just the annual Campaign for Community Needs, endowment opportunities, or the necessary emergency appeal, the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta now provides opportunities and all the tools donors need to make an impact on causes close to their own hearts, leave a community legacy, make philanthropy a family affair, and become fully engaged in programs that inspire. Through the Center for Jewish Philanthropy, Federation offers professional advice and counsel that can help donors devise innovative ways to make true community impact.

A series of high-energy phonings involved more volunteers than ever before.



Campaign

- The 2006 Campaign for Community Needs raised a record in excess of \$18 million, an increase of close to \$700,000 over the previous year. It was accomplished in a shortened, more focused time frame successfully making the transition to a nine-month campaign from September – June, with a shortened primacy period of September and October.
- This year, we found that a series of high-energy phoning sessions produced better results and involved more volunteers than the single Super Sunday event of the past.
- Women's philanthropy increased dramatically, comprising an unprecedented 30 percent of the entire campaign.

Endowments/Family Philanthropy

- Concentrated efforts to educate donors on the impact of creating endowments, which support the community's long-term well being, resulted in signing a record 34 new endowment fund holders this year.
- Federation completed the successful implementation of PHIL, an innovative mechanism that enables donors to manage and direct conveniently and privately their endowment funds online via www.ShalomAtlanta.org. Seventy-four percent of fund holders use PHIL, and the project has made JFGA a leader in the Jewish Federation system for on-line philanthropy.
- A unique pilot program was introduced to JFGA families this year. Twenty-four multi-generational philanthropists completed the Abraham Curriculum, a Melton school text based study program on Jewish philanthropy.
- The Professional Advisory Committee (PAC) enjoyed a comeback, with an outstanding seminar, featuring motivational speaker Dan Taylor, drawing a crowd of 40 professional advisors.

Corporate Partnerships

Bringing corporate partners on board creates a positive situation in which businesses can make important and visible contributions to the communities which they serve. A greater effort to find appropriate corporate partners resulted in a terrific response from businesses that sponsored many of Federation's high-profile activities this year, including the events of the Centennial Celebration. We are truly grateful for their support.

- Corporate sponsorships in FY '06 totaled \$400,000.
- Wachovia joined as the Premier Sponsor of the Centennial Celebration. Northside Hospital and Piedmont Hospital were major contributing sponsors.

- Other corporate sponsors include: SunTrust Bank, Anheuser-Busch, Atlantic Trust, Coldwell Banker Realty, Dick's Sporting Goods, Environ, Kilpatrick Stockton LLP, Mutual of America and Atlanta Décor and Design.



Cultivating government relations and a variety of program funding sources are always top priorities.



Government and Other Funding Sources

- Efforts at creating relationships and educating government officials remain a Federation priority. JFGA hosted its second annual Legislative Reception in February and continued to employ a legislative consultant to advance JFGA's priorities. The Georgia General Assembly increased funding to \$375,000 for JFGA's NORC program, recognizing its success in allowing older adults to age in their own homes.
- Additional gains to the community were increased dollars for nursing home providers (William Breman Jewish Home) and community-based services for older adults (MJCCA) and people with disabilities (JF&CS).
- Understanding that a variety of funding sources are necessary to maintain many of JFGA's programs, such as the Atlanta Jewish Coalition for Literacy, JFGA's grantwriting efforts resulted in the receipt of \$34,500 for that program alone.





Atlanta's Jewish citizens and Federation's affiliate agencies stepped up to respond to emergencies and assist those in need.



Emergency Relief

In August 2005, severe Hurricanes Katrina and Rita devastated the Gulf Coast, resulting in the complete upheaval of life for the region's citizens. Federation responded immediately to lead the Atlanta Jewish community's efforts to help. Jewish Atlantans stepped up to raise \$400,000 in emergency funds, and our affiliate agencies organized relief efforts, including a variety of social and religious services for the many displaced Jewish citizens that sought shelter in Atlanta.

Jewish Community Centennial Study 2006

Planning for the future requires a good grasp of the present. JFGA conducted the first community-wide survey in ten years, seeking to obtain not only a numerical census, but to better understand social demographics, affiliations and needs. Some key points emerging from the study:

- The metropolitan Atlanta Jewish population has grown 56 percent since the last community-wide census was conducted in 1996 – from 76,800 to 120,000 Jewish persons in 2006. Currently, that makes Greater Atlanta the 11th largest U.S. Jewish community, moving from 17th place in 1996.
- Atlanta is a relatively young Jewish community. Children under 18 years comprise one quarter of the Jewish population, while seniors 65 years and older make up just 12 percent.
- The study offered insight into how well engaged Atlanta Jews are. For example, while 56 percent of Jewish residents agreed that being Jewish is “very important” to them, just one third belong to a Jewish congregation and 42 percent of all Jewish households are communally connected (members of a synagogue, the JCC or another Jewish organization). Just 20 percent of newcomers to Atlanta are synagogue members.
- The study found that intermarriage rates have increased in Atlanta, paralleling national trends. Half of currently married couples are intermarried, compared to 37 percent in 1996. In intermarried households, 39 percent of children are being raised exclusively Jewish.

Community Partnerships

The power of partnerships is at the cornerstone of Federation's mission. This year we invited and involved many more voices, recognizing that inclusiveness makes our community stronger.



The opening of the North Metro Campus in April 2006 was a great milestone for our community.



Local Partnerships – North Metro

A JFGA study conducted in 2004 confirmed what many already intuitively knew: that the Jewish population in the northern suburbs is booming. Serving and engaging those Jewish residents, many of them young families, became a high priority. This year we, along with our partners, made great strides in addressing those needs.

- In April 2006, a great milestone was achieved when the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta North Metro Campus opened its doors in Alpharetta. The 6,000 square foot facility provides office space and services from Federation and our partners – Jewish Family & Career Services, Marcus Jewish Community Center of Atlanta, and My Own Backyard/Do Jewish Campaign. Other area partners for community impact in North Metro are: The Cohen Home, Congregation Gesher L'Torah, Temple Kehillat Chaim, Chabad of Alpharetta, and the American Jewish Committee.
- Federation worked with our community partners to identify desired outcomes and develop initiatives for the North Metro Jewish community. Here's what we plan to achieve:
 - Welcome and introduce newcomers to the many Jewish resources in our community;
 - Engage community members through cultural, religious and social programs;
 - Strengthen Jewish youth's confidence in their Jewish identities;
 - Ensure the mental and physical health of Jews of all ages through counseling services and recreational programs.
- JFGA created and is the facilitator for the North Metro Outcome Strategy Team consisting of lay leaders and Jewish professionals who ensure that these community outcomes are being met and that the programs are evaluated.

Local Partnerships – NORC Expansion

- Building on its highly successful model of helping seniors age in place, JFGA expanded its NORC (Naturally Occurring Retirement Communities) initiative. Providing services such as home modification, transportation and social programs, NORCs are a highly cost effective way for senior adults to remain in their own homes and neighborhoods for as long as possible.
- Federation's lead agency partners in the NORC initiatives are: Jewish Family and Career Services, the Atlanta Regional Commission, Senior Citizens, Inc. and The William Breman Jewish Home.
- Two new sites were added this year: Savannah's Ardsley Park and the Marian Road Highrise, with the next site at the Jewish Tower and surrounding neighborhood implemented in July 2006.
- The two original NORCs developed in 2004 continue to serve seniors in two diverse metro Atlanta communities. The Toco Hills NORC has to date served 220 seniors and is adding a focus on emergency and safety initiatives. The East Point NORC has served 300 seniors and this year expanded its assistance to residents in the area of minor home repairs.
- Once again, the State of Georgia nodded its approval of the NORC model and JFGA's program by granting an allocation of \$375,000 from the state's FY '07 budget.

Other Local Partnerships

- This year, our Planning and Allocations Committees recommended five new affiliates: American-Israel Chamber of Commerce Southeast Region, Georgia-Israel Law Enforcement Exchange (GILEE), Jewish Healthcare International, Temima High School and The Breman (William Breman Jewish Heritage Museum). These affiliates received their first affiliation grant in FY '07.
- Strengthening our partnerships with houses of worship, Federation created the Institute for Synagogue Excellence and facilitated two well received synagogue conferences focusing on resource development and providing community networking opportunities.

Federation is committed to the health and well being of Jews in our partner regions in Israel and the Former Soviet Union and to assisting Ethiopian-Israelis through Operation Promise.



Overseas Partnerships

The following activities for 2006 reflect JFGA's devotion to Israel and commitment to impacting the lives of Jews worldwide.

- This year, JFGA's International Planning and Allocations/Partnership Committee (IPA) implemented a comprehensive strategic planning process, together with our Israeli partners in Yokneam/Megiddo, to address Ethiopian-Israelis and families at risk. The committee created outcomes and strategies, brought existing and new partners to the table, and created a continuum of services in the education and employment arenas.
 - The education outcome focus ensures that youth-at-risk are able to reach their scholastic potential (matriculation).
 - The employment outcome focuses on helping families become self sufficient. All programs look at the family as a holistic unit within the community.
- In the Former Soviet Union, specifically in our partnership community of Minsk, Belarus, JFGA supported programs which target teens and elderly and focus on camping, education, and increasing quality of life for elderly.
- Additional collective support will focus on Operation Promise, which encompasses the above, plus ensuring Ethiopian Jews who are still in Ethiopia can make aliyah to Israel and fully integrate into Israeli society.
- JFGA continues its commitment to building *kesher* (living bridges) with our partnership communities in Yokneam/Megiddo, Israel and Minsk, Belarus together with our affiliates, local organizations and synagogues. Over the coming year, there will be many professional, teen and youth exchanges between the communities helping to ensure that youth and teens in Atlanta are knowledgeable about and connected to Jews throughout the world.




Federation's Centennial Year celebration involved our entire Jewish community and was celebrated in Atlanta and in Israel.



Centennial Celebration

Reaching the hundredth year of our organized Atlanta Jewish community called for big celebrations. Federation's lay leadership, community volunteers and professionals planned and carried out events that honored Atlanta's Jewish heritage and included Jews of every age, affiliation, and Atlanta zip code.

- It all began with the unforgettable Centennial Mission to Israel in November 2005 during which more than 430 Atlantans – more than any previous single mission from Atlanta (and the phones were still ringing with mission hopefuls up until the very last week before departure) – embarked on a historical, spiritual and communal week-long journey to the Jewish State.
 - In February 2006, the whole *mishpacha* turned out for the Jewish Community Centennial Celebration. More than 7,500 Jewish Atlantans enjoyed the festivities and bonded with the sensational sea creatures at the new Georgia Aquarium. With 350 volunteers and nearly every Jewish community organization represented, it was truly a community celebration and a day to remember.




