Survey Methodology



This survey was conducted online within the United States from November 11-12 among 1,331 adults by public opinion firm HarrisX. The sampling margin of error of this poll is plus or minus 2.7 percentage points. The results reflect a nationally representative sample of registered voters. Results were weighted for age, gender, region, race/ethnicity, income, where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population.

Note: Some percentages on the following slides may not add up to exactly 100% due to rounding **Note:** "T2B" or "Top 2 Box: refers to the combination of the top two responses. "Example- Very Likely+ Somewhat Likely= Likely"










There is widespread agreement that the attacks were unjustified and indiscriminate in their violence.








ISRQ3: Do you think the recent attack on Israel focused on the Israeli military or indiscriminately targeted civilians? | ISRQ4: Do you think the Hamas killing of 1200 Israeli civilians and the kidnapping of another 250 is justified by the grievances of Palestinians or is it not justified and a pure act of terror?



Three-quarters of Americans identify Hamas as a terrorist organization, and a similar number identify the Oct. 7 attacks as a genocidal attack towards Jews.
















ISRQ9: Does Israel have a right to defend itself against rocket and terror attacks on its cities by launching air strikes on terrorist targets in heavily populated areas with warnings to those citizens or does it not have the right to launch such attacks? ISRQ10: Does Israel have a responsibility to bring back it's abducted citizens – mostly innocent children, women and the elderly - home from Gaza or not?



Americans also believe the United States has a responsibility to bring back the hostages. There is strong support for Israel sending troops into Gaza to free hostages and eliminate Hamas.

















Hamas is overwhelmingly seen as responsible for endangering civilians and starting the humanitarian crisis in Gaza.






Few Americans think Hamas allows gay people to live openly, with strong majorities believing the regime punishes them.






Nearly 3 in 5 support the \$14 billion aid package to help Israel defeat Hamas.

Favor vs Oppose: \$14 billion aid package to help Israel defeat Hamas and other terrorists in the area




Over 2 in 3 U.S. adults believe Iran is behind the terrorist groups in the region.




There is strong agreement among U.S. adults that Americans share common values with Israel, and over 4 in 5 see America as a strong supporter of Israel.


Just under 2 in 3 U.S. adults say antisemitism is prevalent on U.S. college campuses today, reaching over 7 in 10 of those aged 55+.




