DAY 1: 12th October 2026: BUENOS AIRES

Welcome to Buenos Aires! Upon arrival, transfer to the downtown hotel.

At night, enjoy a special welcome dinner at Glitter Kasher Restaurant (inside Alvear Icon hotel).

DAY 2: 13th October 2026: BUENOS AIRES

PRIVATE CITY TOUR BUENOS AIRES SOUTH WITH COLON FABRICA

Discover the vibrant spirit of Buenos Aires on a guided tour through its iconic southern neighbourhoods, culminating in an exclusive behind-the-scenes cultural experience. Begin at Plaza de Mayo, the city's historic and political heart, where landmarks such as the Casa Rosada and the Metropolitan Cathedral reveal the story of Argentina's past. Continue to San Telmo, a neighbourhood full of old-world charm, with cobbled streets, colonial architecture, and traditional antique markets. Next, explore the colourful streets of La Boca, the artistic soul of the south. Walk along the famous Caminito, an open-air museum alive with murals and tango dancers, and take in the lively atmosphere near La Bombonera, the legendary stadium of Boca Juniors. Stop for a quick Lunch (not included). The tour concludes at Colón Fábrica, an extraordinary exhibition space where the magic of the Teatro Colón comes to life. Located in La Boca, this venue showcases original stage sets, costumes, and large-scale props from the theatre's world-class opera and ballet productions, offering a rare glimpse into the craftsmanship behind one of Argentina's greatest cultural treasures. Return to the hotel. Dinner on your own. (Duration: ~5hs)

DAY 3: 14th October 2026: BUENOS AIRES

PRIVATE CITY TOUR BUENOS AIRES JEWISH HERITAGE

Discover the rich Jewish history of Argentina, from colonial times to modernity. You will explore the neighbourhoods of Once, Tribunales, and Retiro, delving into the traditions and iconic places of the largest Jewish community in South America. During the tour, you will visit several important sites, such as the heart of the Jewish community in Once, Argentina's most important institution, AMIA (entrance ticket is included), the Paso Synagogue, Tribunales (the first Jewish neighbourhood of Buenos Aires), the Libertad Synagogue, the Jewish Museum, and the Plaza of the former Israeli Embassy. (Duration: 4hs)

DAY 4: 15th October 2026: MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY

Early transfer to the port in Buenos Aires. Catch the 07:20 am direct ferry to **Montevideo and arrive at the capital city of Uruguay around 10 am.**

Explore the rich cultural footprint of the Jewish community in Montevideo with a guided tour that weaves together history, tradition, and daily life.

Begin in the heart of the city at Plaza Independencia and the iconic Palacio Salvo, where the story of Jewish immigration to Uruguay unfolds against a backdrop of architectural grandeur. Continue along the picturesque Rambla, taking in sweeping coastal views and an overview of the city's diverse neighbourhoods.

Visit the striking Holocaust Memorial, a moving tribute set by the sea, honouring memory and resilience.

Lunch Boxes included.

Continue with a guided visit to one of Montevideo's most important Jewish institutions (either the Centro Israelita or the NCI Synagogue), offering insight into the spiritual and communal life of the city's Jewish residents (visit subject to prior pre-approval).

The tour concludes with a walk through the Pocitos neighbourhood, home to Jewish-owned shops, bakeries, and a warm sense of tradition that still lives in its streets.

Whether you're visiting for the first time or reconnecting with your roots, this tour offers a meaningful perspective on Uruguay's Jewish heritage.

Free time for dinner will be provided around the Pocitos neighbourhood, before a private transfer to the port for the express ferry back to Buenos Aires.

Arrive at Buenos Aires and private transfer to hotel. **Return: ~22:00hs**

DAY 5: 16th October 2026: CITY TOUR BUENOS AIRES NORTH & MUSEO EVITA

Experience the sophisticated side of Buenos Aires on a guided tour through its most elegant northern neighbourhoods. Begin in Recoleta, renowned for its impressive architecture, cultural landmarks, and the world-famous Recoleta Cemetery, the final resting place of iconic figures such as Eva Perón. Continue to El Ateneo Grand Splendid, a magnificent bookstore housed in a former theatre (a must-see for both literature lovers and architecture enthusiasts). Then, explore Palermo, a lively district known for its expansive parks, stylish boutiques, and vibrant street art, a perfect blend of nature, fashion, and modern city life.

Continue to visit Museo Evita, located in a historic building once used by her Social Aid Foundation. The Evita Museum was inaugurated on the 50th anniversary of María Eva Duarte de Perón's passing. It offers an inspiring journey into the life and legacy of one of Argentina's most influential women. Through personal belongings, dresses, family mementos, and historical artifacts, the museum highlights Evita's political role and her enduring impact on the nation. A charming restaurant and café in the museum's courtyard complete the experience.

Kabbalat Shabbat walking distance from the hotel at Beit Chabad Recoleta.

DAY 7: 18th October 2026: BUENOS AIRES DELTA & TIGRE

After the boat tour, we will continue by land with a panoramic tour that will take you to the main attractions of Tigre, stopping at Puerto de Frutos, a large open-air market with a great variety of local and craft-made products. Then, return to Buenos Aires.

DAY 9: 20th October 2026: PUERTO IGUAZU

PRIVATE TOUR of the IGUAZU FALLS- ARGENTINE SIDE

Today, discover one of the most breathtaking natural wonders on Earth- the **Iguazú Falls**, nestled within the lush expanse of Iguazú National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1984. Spanning over 67,000 hectares of protected rainforest, the park is home to more than 250 waterfalls surrounded by vibrant flora and fauna. Enjoy a day immersed in nature as you explore the park's scenic walkways and viewing points, including the iconic *Garganta del Diablo* (reached by the Ecological Train), each revealing a new and awe-inspiring perspective of the cascades. Feel the refreshing mist on your face, hear the thunderous roar of the water, and marvel at the sheer power and beauty of this extraordinary landscape.

Optional (additional fee): Great Adventure Navigation: For guests seeking a more immersive, high-adrenaline experience, this guided add-on combines a 4x4 jungle ride along the Yacaratiá Trail with a thrilling speedboat journey into the Lower Iguazú River canyon. The boat approaches the waterfalls closely, and participants should expect to get wet (change of clothes or a swimsuit under your clothes is recommended). The route features views of Tres Mosqueteros and San Martín Falls before ending at the San Martín Island dock, connecting to the Lower Circuit.

DAY 10: 21th October 2026: PUERTO IGUAZU/OUT

Check out from the Hotel.

Bus Transportation to border crossing from Argentina to Brazil **(Canadian Passport Holders require a VISA)**

PRIVATE HD IGUAZU FALLS BRAZILIAN SIDE

The tour begins at the Visitor Center, which operates as a visitor embarkation/disembarkation center, where you board panoramic buses that will take you to the walkway path. The extension of the walkways is 1,200 meters from where you can get a spectacular panoramic view of the 275 waterfalls that make up the Iguazú Falls, of which the most important on the Brazilian side are four: Floriano, Deodoro, Benjamín Constant and Salto Unión or Garganta del Diablo. At the end of the tour you will take the panoramic elevator that will take you to the bus that will return the group to the Visitor Center.

Group transfer to the **Foz do Iguaçu- Cataratas International Airport (IGU)**.

our initial aim will be to get you to the airport before 1pm for late afternoon flights. However, the order of your last 3 days at the IGUAZU is subject to change to tailor to the flight needs of the majority
