Choose your track

Option #1: Geopolitical

Get a better understanding of the complex reality of Jerusalem. Visit sites along the seamline accompanied by Colonel (re) Dani Tirza, the architect of the security barrier between Israel and the Palestinian Authority, meet with high-ranking officials for in-depth briefing on Aliyah rescue operations and visit the site housing the complex network of surveillance cameras in the Old City.




Option #2: Arts, Culture, Food & Wine Track Explore the tastes and scenery of Jerusalem that inspired hit TV shows such as Beauty Queen of Jerusalem, Shtisel and Fauda. Walk picturesque neighborhoods in the heart of Jerusalem, and meet with artists from music and visual theater schools. Taste the various kitchens that characterize the city, Jewish and Palestinian-Jerusalemites, and hear the secrets behind the dishes.

### Option #1: Geopolitics Track

Board jeeps and travel along the border, including a visit to a Hezbollah tunnel which was exposed during Operation Northern Shield in December 2018. Enjoy homemade lunch at Shula from (Moshav) Shtula and hear the story of the Kurdish Mana. Visit Palsan in Kibbutz Sasa to hear firsthand how a small Israeli kibbutz on the border of Lebanon, has changed the face of security combat forces in the Middle East.



Option #2: Arts, Culture, Food and Wine Track Visit Talking Walls project and meet with the inspiring artists behind the project. Meet with Muhammad Mizal who will share his unique story of coexistence in the Galilee. Enjoy lunch and wine tasting at a Galilee wineries.

Indulge in an ice cream dessert as you meet with Alaa Sweita, cofounder of Buza - a joint venture of an Israeli Jew and Israeli Arab.

Participate in a Galilean cooking workshop and dinner at the home of a Druze family

Head over to Tel Aviv, Israel's capital of business, culture, and startups.

Visit ANU Museum, the largest Jewish Museum in the world that portrays the story of the Jewish people through the generations and up to the present time. Follow the footsteps of the founding families of Neve Tzedek, the first neighborhood outside ancient Jaffa and hear the beyond-the-scenes of modern Jewish pioneering, entrepreneurship, and community leadership.

Enjoy Shabbat picnic lunch bringing together Jewish traditional cuisines such as jachnun (a Yeminite Jewish pastry), sabich (Iraqi Jews staffed pita), and kugel.
