Outshine Hate

THE POWER OF ALLYSHIP IN COMBATTING ANTISEMITISM

In April 2022, The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte launched Outshine Hate: Together Against Antisemitism in response to an alarming increase in antisemitism in Charlotte and nationwide. The goal of this multiyear initiative is to educate, strengthen, and unite the local community to put an end to antisemitism and anti-Israel hate.

- *“Outshine Hate is a true community-wide effort to ensure that local Jewish community members have access to the resources and support that empower them to be proud of their Jewish identities,”* said Tair Giudice, Chief Impact Officer at The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte. *“We all have a responsibility to act to combat this uptick in antisemitism happening in our own backyard.”*

As part of this initiative and the focus on increased community education and engagement, Federation worked with Project Shema to hold two workshops this Fall: one for Jewish communal professionals and one community wide workshop about incorporating antisemitism into Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) work. The DEI workshop was attended by nearly 60 representatives from over 30 organizations in the

greater Charlotte area. One of those attendees was Michael Marsicano, the President and CEO of the Foundation For The Carolinas.

While not Jewish himself, Michael sent out an email to his professional network to encourage them to attend the workshop because he saw the value and importance of addressing antisemitism in the workplace. In the email Michael stated:

- *“In the last few years, companies and organizations have emphasized diversity, equity, and inclusion. However, antisemitism—which is on the rise locally, nationally and globally—is too often left out of these discussions. Together, we will explore the history of antisemitism and why the voices and concerns of the Jewish community should be incorporated as part of broader DEI conversations.”*

Reflecting on the workshop afterwards, the lessons Michael learned further instilled in him the importance of serving as an ally in the fight against antisemitism.

It was through Outshine Hate that Michael was able to cement his allyship into a tangible call to action.



“In recent years, I have witnessed with great encouragement corporate strategies, practices, programs and policies proliferate in service to Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.”

While the depth of these activities has advanced considerably, they have not reached the breadth of their promise. Rarely do they address antisemitism - tragically on the rise in America today. My hope is that every corporate DEI program will become a force for good in the elimination of antisemitism.”

REACHING OUR MILESTONE \$5 MILLION CAMPAIGN GOAL TAKES A VILLAGE

- *“Being a part of the Jewish community in Charlotte has inspired and positively shaped my adult life,”* said Angie Zimmern. *“It has brought our family joy, belonging, and a sense of purpose. It has helped me find a home in Charlotte – and for that I am very grateful.”*

Angie’s joy for Charlotte Jewish life is a feeling Federation wanted to be able to replicate for each member of our community. In our quest to make this sentiment a long-term and sustainable communal goal, Federation committed to an ambitious three-year path to reach \$5 million in annual campaign funds raised to meet the pressing needs of the Charlotte Jewish community.

In 2022, Federation not only met our \$5 million goal – we exceeded it. The funds secured allow us to continue to enrich Jewish life in the region through allocations to more than 70 local and global organizations that work to consistently support and provide for the community’s needs.

This milestone was only made possible through the generosity of the Charlotte Jewish community and the commitment of families like the Zimmerns.

When Sam and Emily Zimmern moved to Charlotte in 1982 with their children Bill and Amelia, they brought with them a strong foundation of Jewish values. Sam was raised Jewish with longstanding traditions and a distilled sense of Jewish pride. Emily, on the other hand, chose her Jewish identity and let it guide her values and her purpose.

Together, they took their Jewish values and traditions and passed them down to their children. Federation became an integral part of the Zimmern family’s life, connecting them and their children and grandchildren to Judaism as a religion and an identity.

HOW THE SPIEGLERS FOUND THEIR CHARLOTTE JEWISH COMMUNITY THROUGH FEDERATION

When Jason and Karen Spiegler first moved from New York City to Charlotte in September 2006, they were looking to find a city where they could settle down, start a family, and begin to grow roots in the community. While adjusting to a new environment takes time, their connection to the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte was immediate.

- *“Our main drivers for a move to Charlotte were*
- *quality of life, cost of living, the weather, the strong*
- *Jewish community and having family not too far*
- *away in Greenville, SC,”* said Karen Spiegler. *“When*
- *we first visited Shalom Park, we were surprised to*
- *find something so special in the southeast.”*

Soon after their move, Jason and Karen joined Federation’s Bernstein Leadership Group, an 18-month leadership program preparing the next generation of leaders to assume leadership positions in the Jewish community. Along the way, they met many of their closest friends who make up their personal Jewish community today.

Taking the lessons learned in the Bernstein Leadership Group, Jason created a Jewish Burger Club, where Jewish men could meet once a month for burgers. Participation took off, and the group began raising money each year, leveraging corporate and additional match opportunities to quadruple their impact in the Jewish community. Jason leveraged the money raised by the Jewish Burger Club by donating it to Federation and allowing Federation’s Allocations process to ensure that the money got where it was needed most.

Since arriving in Charlotte, Jason has also served on Federation’s Allocations Committee and Federation’s Board of Trustees, gaining further insight into Federation’s impact both within the Charlotte community, in Israel, and around the world. Karen has

served on the Jewish Family Services’ Board and has been involved in Federation through PJ Library, Women’s Philanthropy, and several Federation-funded agencies.

For Jason and Karen, their support for the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte comes down to their trust in Federation to act in the best interests of the local Jewish community.

Regardless of life’s changes, the Charlotte Jewish community and Federation will continue to be constants for both Karen and Jason and their three children. As the Spieglers’ involvement in Federation has increased over the years, they continue to make their mark in the Jewish community through their volunteer work and philanthropy.


