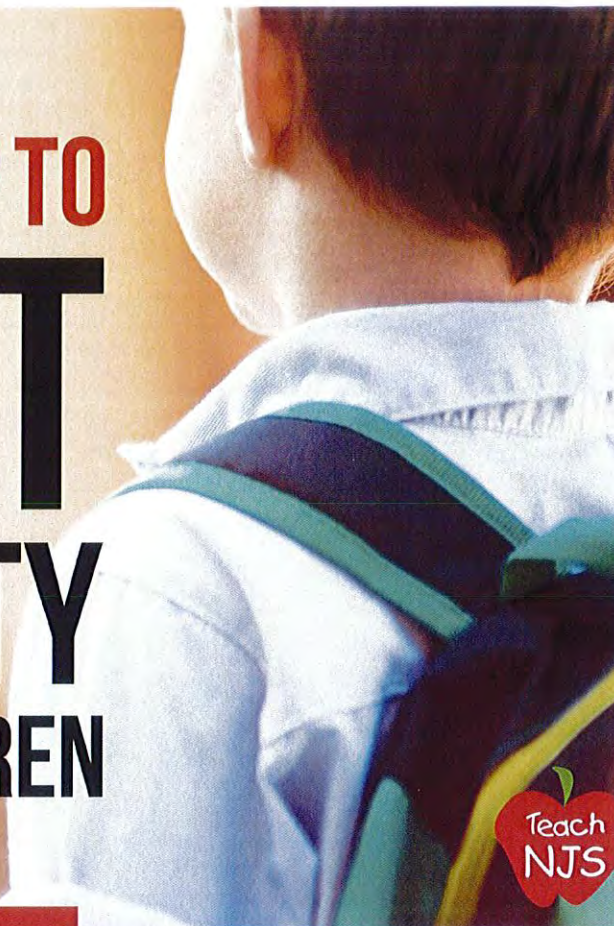


URGE OUR LEADERSHIP TO SUPPORT MORE SECURITY FUNDING FOR OUR CHILDREN
