



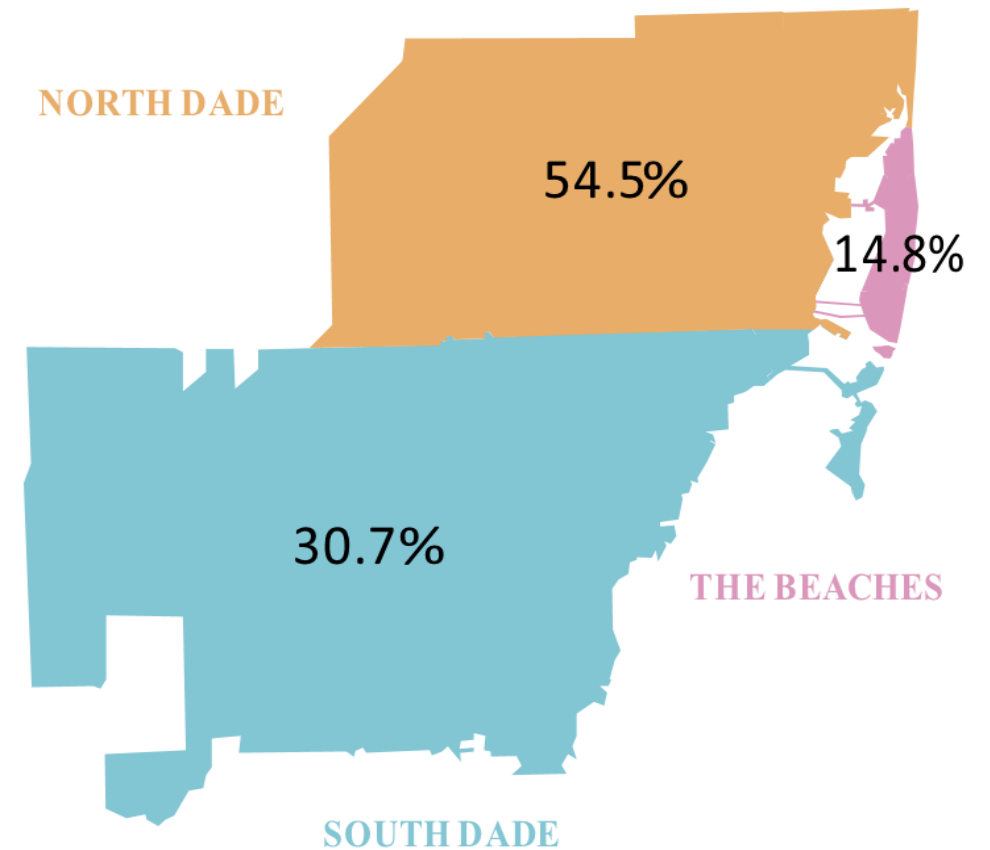

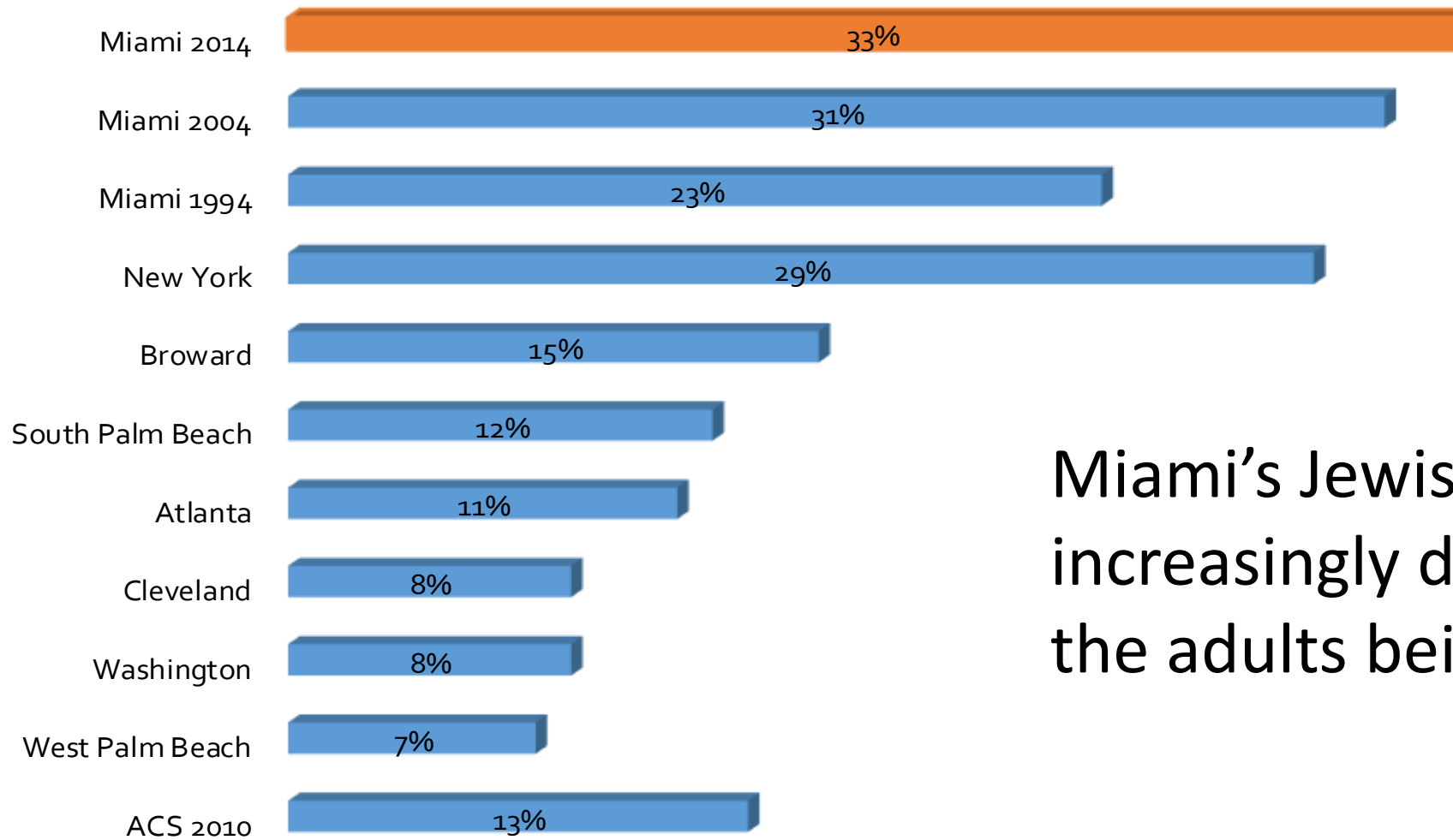

# Foreign Born population

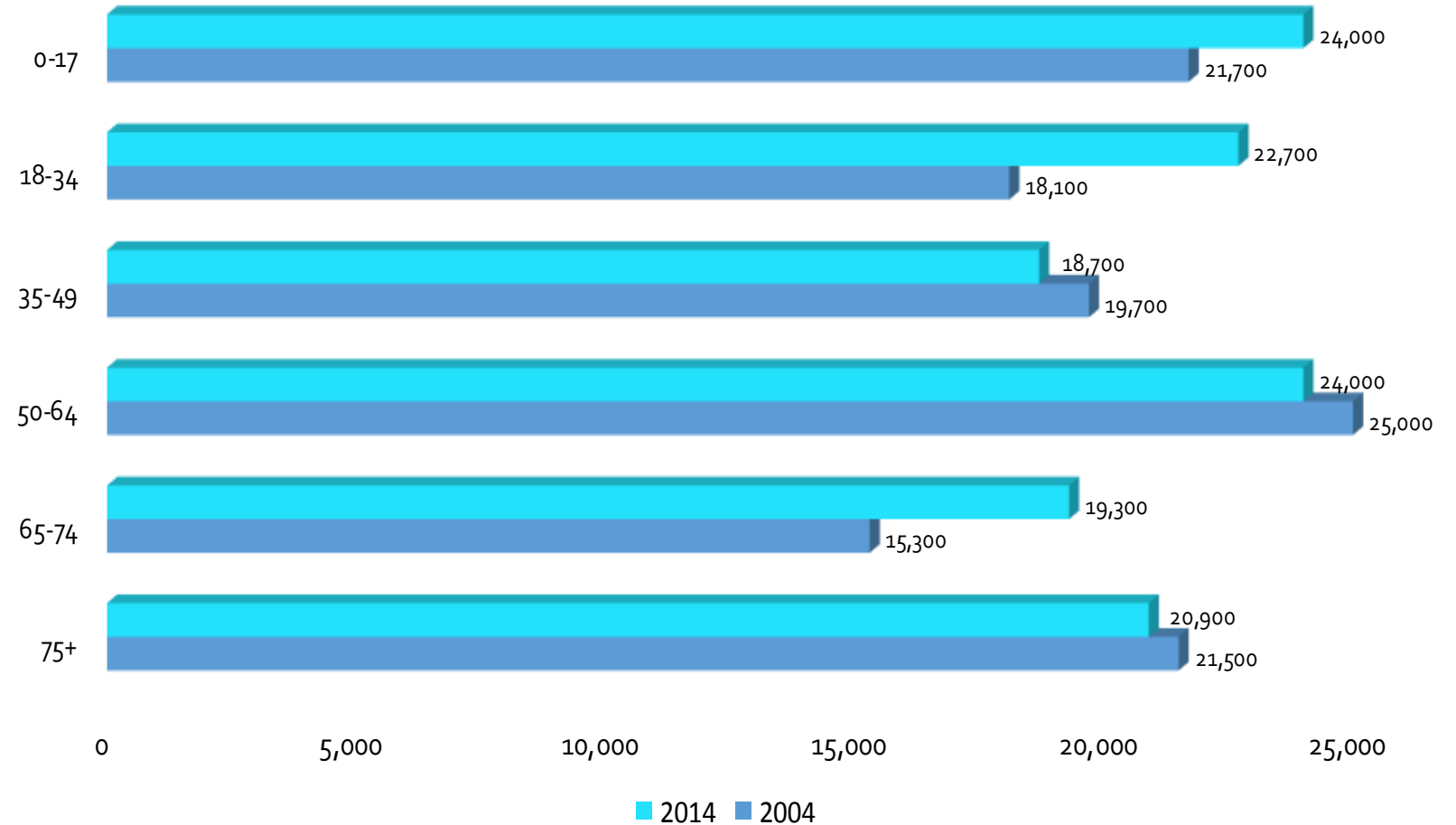


Miami's Jewish population is increasingly diverse with 33% of the adults being foreign born

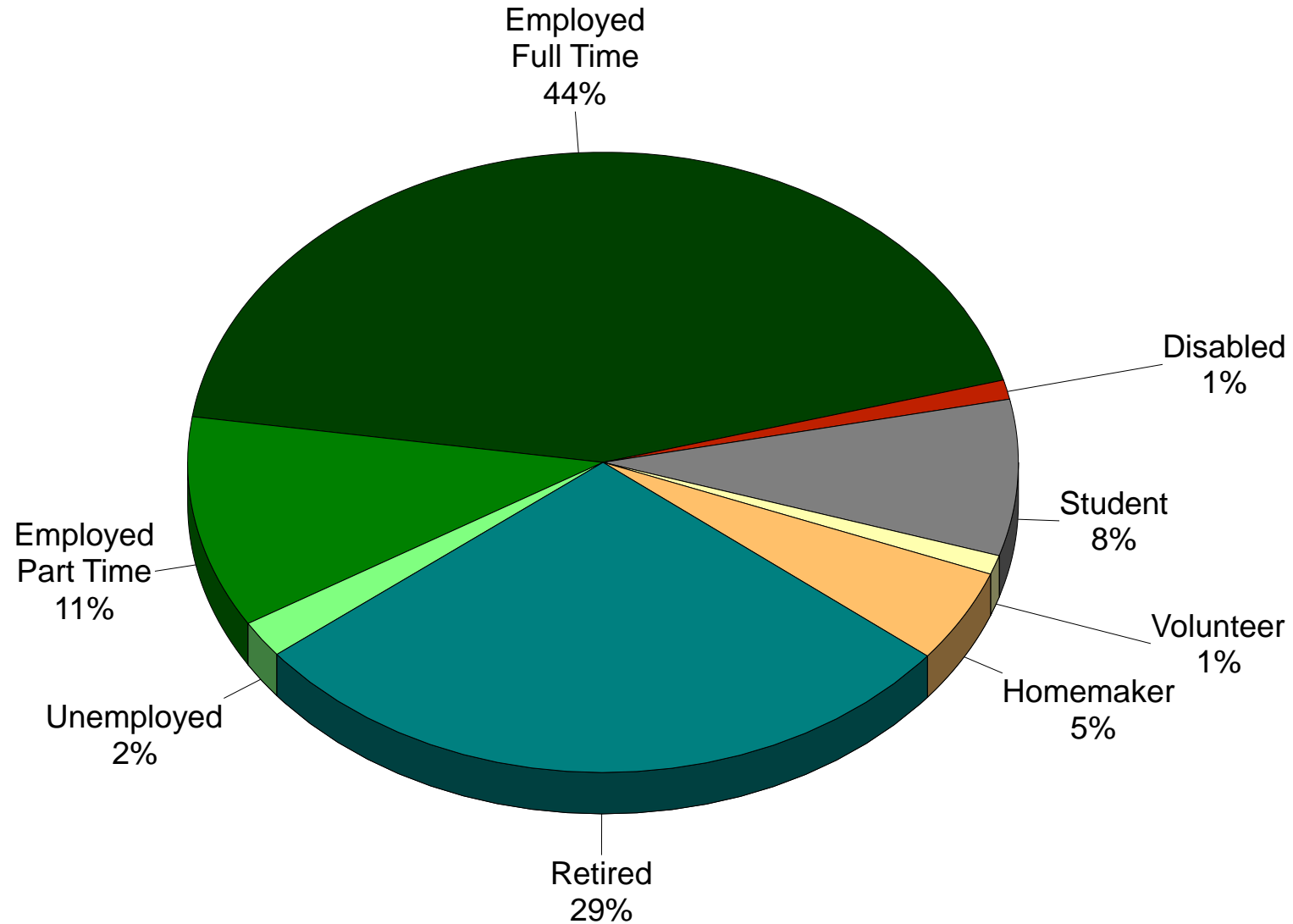
# Age Distribution

Significant growth in under 35 Jewish population

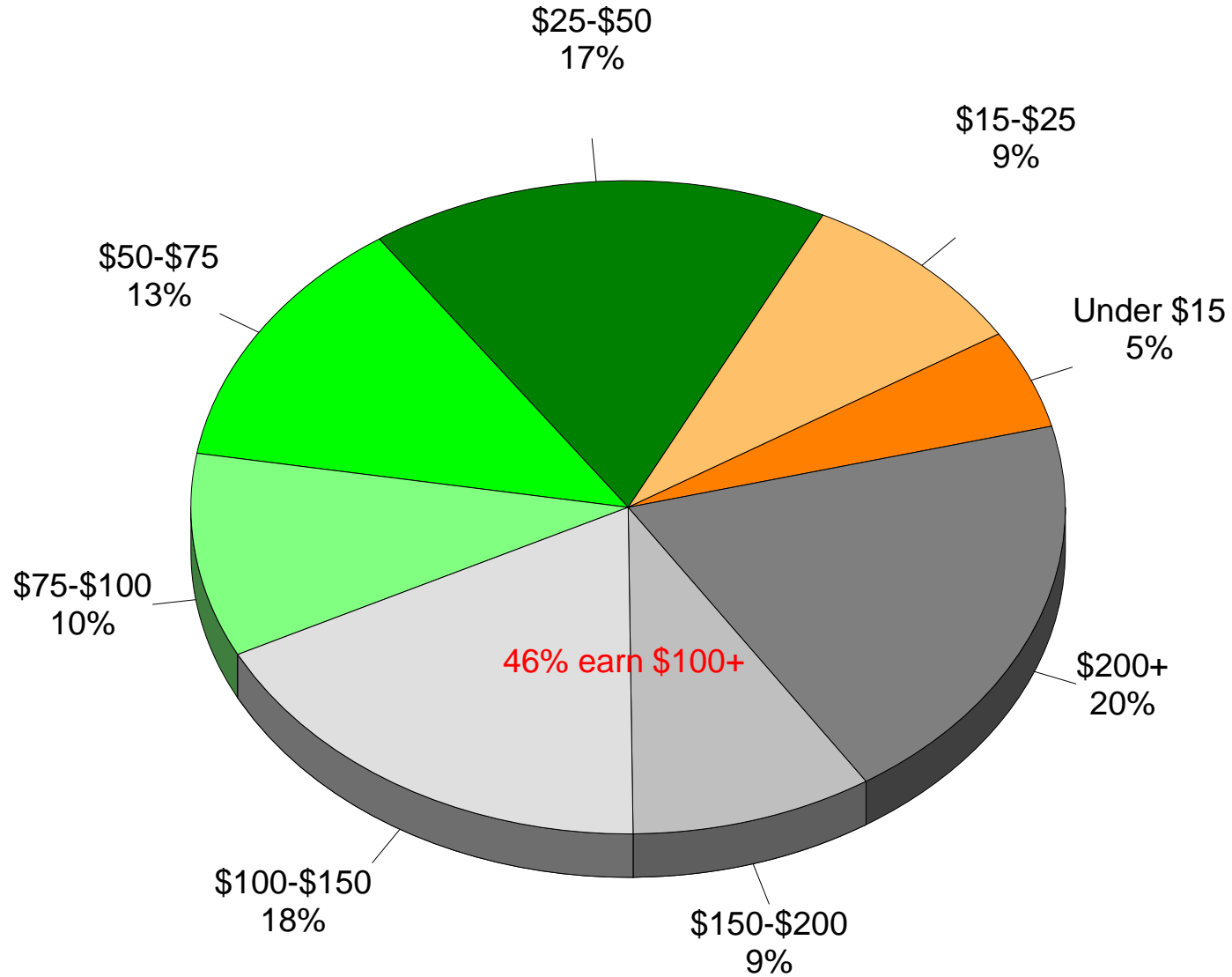
Stable but large older adult population



# Employment Status



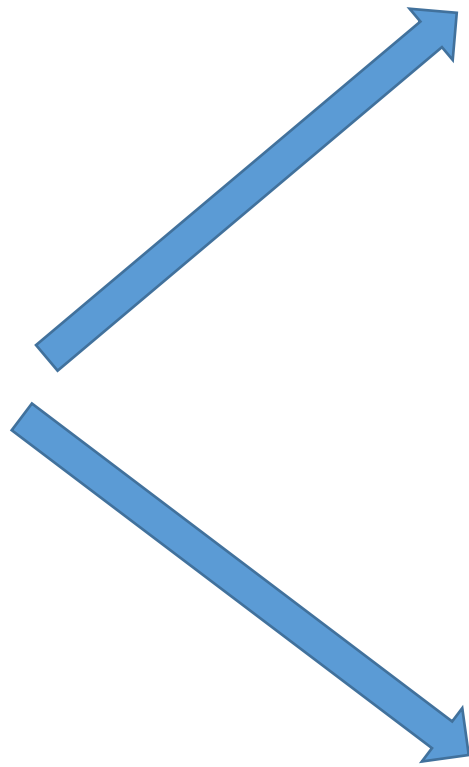
