His books have been translated into more than ten languages. Now retired, he has taught at Carnegie-Mellon University, the University of Missouri-Kansas City, and the Harvard Graduate School of Education. In the course of his career, he served as a tenured professor, department chair, dean, director of federally- funded research projects, and educational chair for Harvard executive programs.

He holds a Ph.D. in Organizational Behavior from Yale University.
