OUR PROGRAMS

KEHILLA (K - 5th)

This program focuses on "old-fashioned" camp fun and is open to campers entering kindergarten through fifth grade. We pack each day full of activities that campers choose from based upon their interests. We also take weekly field trips, visit the pool/have water play three times a week, celebrate Shabbat, and immerse our campers in a unique themed program every Friday.

Past field trips and activities have included: escape rooms, water parks, museums, the arcade, visits to the beach, historic/cultural sites, and more!

Our Counselor in Training (CIT) program is for campers entering ninth and tenth grade. Interested youth must apply and be accepted into the program. CITs help design and run programs for our Kehilla campers and participate in training throughout the summer, including lessons in leadership, child development, teamwork, conflict resolution, lesson planning, and much more!

OTHER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Israeli-American Camper: Up to \$1,500 for campers in CA, AZ, CO, OR, and WA with at least one Israeli-born parent. Apply via email at israeliamerican@jewishcamp.org. (This replaces traditional One Happy Camper grants.)
- Military Family: Scholarships available for rising 5th-8th graders with a parent currently active or discharged from the U.S. military in the last three years. Covers costs for up to four weeks at a Jewish Community Center (JCC) movement - affiliated camp for three consecutive summers. For details, email h.nitzan@jcca.org.
- Synagogues: Many synagogues in our community offer scholarships to their members whose children are attending a Jewish camp this summer. Check with your synagogue for potential assistance; multiple aid programs can often be combined to help cover camp fees.
