OUR PROGRAMS

KEHILLA (K - 5th)

This program focuses on "old-fashioned" camp fun and is open to campers entering kindergarten through fifth grade. We pack each day full of activities that campers choose from based upon their interests. We also take weekly field trips, enjoy water play games, celebrate Shabbat, and immerse our campers in a unique themed program every Friday.

CITs help design and run programs for our Kehilla campers and participate in training throughout the summer, including lessons in leadership, child development, teamwork, conflict resolution, lesson planning, and much more!
