

KIMBERLY DAWN ELLIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Kimberly attended Mesa Elementary, Sierra Vista Junior High and South Hills High School where she graduated in 1993. She attended the University of California at Santa Barbara and majored in Law and Society. After graduating from UCSB with honors in 1997, she attended Pepperdine Law School. In addition to her academic achievement, her strong Jewish commitment was shown through her involvement in B'nai Brith Youth Organization (BBYO) and Jewish day camp.

While attending Pepperdine Law School, she was killed on December 9, 1997, by a drunk driver. A \$500 scholarship is being offered by her family for future college students to perpetuate her memory.
