Student Eligibility

1. Student must...
 - a. Be a permanent resident of Bexar County.
 - b. Apply for financial assistance with Jewish Children's Regional Service

Scholarships Available

- **Level 1:** Up to \$1,000, determined primarily by financial need.
- **Level 2:** Up to \$2,500, determined primarily by financial need, academic achievement, participation in Jewish activities, and/or involvement in community.
 - *A 1- page essay describing personal goals is required if applying for this level.*
- **Level 3:** Up to \$5,000 scholarship determined primarily by financial need, outstanding academic achievement, significant participation in Jewish activities, and/or involvement in the community.
 - *Substantial essay describing your personal goals is required if applying for this level.*

Application Checklist:

- Original transcript from the student's currently enrolled educational institution (if entering freshman year, this may be a high school transcript).
- If you are dependent, submit the following forms from your parent/guardian. If you're not a dependent, submit your own forms.
 - Signed copy of your 2023 IRS Federal Tax Return. *(If not available, you may upload a 2022 tax return with your 2023 W-2.)*
