Opinion Pieces Policy

The *Jewish Journal* is dedicated to providing its readers with factual, unbiased, and informative news coverage. In line with this commitment to responsible journalism, we have decided not to publish opinion pieces.

Our decision stems from the following goals:

- 1. Objective Reporting
 - a. Our primary mission is to deliver objective news reporting that is free from bias or personal opinion. By excluding opinion pieces, we ensure that our readers receive accurate, unbiased information.
- 2. Focus on news
 - a. We believe that our readers turn to the *Jewish Journal* for reliable news about current events in the community. We aim to maintain a clear focus, and continue to provide them with factual, timely, and relevant stories.
- 3. Avoiding Controversy
 - a. Opinion pieces can be polarizing and controversial. By abstaining from publishing them, we maintain and foster a space for civil discourse and dialogue within our community.

Submission Policy:

While we do not accept opinion pieces for publication, we encourage those representing Jewish organizations and synagogues in our community and around the world to submit articles and stories that are relevant to the San Antonio Jewish community. We are always open to working with contributors who provide well-researched, fact-based content that aligns with our mission.
