

Community Planning & Allocations Application

Program Eligibility Requirements

1. It is the expectation of the Planning and Allocations Committee that all applicants submit a complete application by the stated deadline and fully participate in both the presentation and reporting processes. Failure to meet these requirements may result in a reduced allocation or disqualification.
2. All proposed programs should serve the San Antonio Jewish community in a meaningful, innovative, and relevant way by aligning with one or more of the following community pillars:
 - Amplifying Joyful Jewish Life
 - Bringing together San Antonio Jews of all ages, backgrounds, and traditions—celebrating, learning, and strengthening Jewish programs.
 - Securing the Community & Fighting Antisemitism
 - Providing education and awareness to combat antisemitism, ensure a safer, more resilient community, and build productive relationships with our elected and law enforcement officials.
 - Caring for Jews and Others in Need
 - Reflect our Jewish responsibility to care for the community's vulnerable.
 - Mobilizing to Meet Needs Across Israel
 - Providing relief, rebuilding support, and foster solidarity.
3. Program must benefit the San Antonio Jewish community without membership requirements.
 - Ex. Cannot be solely directed at the membership of a specific congregation
4. Program can be directed at a subset of the community.
 - Ex. It can be directed at serving senior citizens
5. Innovative programs, as well as programs geared toward the long-term sustainability of the SA Jewish community, will be given preference for funding.
6. Program Funding must be spent during the fiscal year of the allocation.
