THOU SHALL NOT HATE

A surgeon in Trieste, the son of a Holocaust survivor, encounters a traffic accident on his way home from work, but refuses to help the victim when he sees a swastika tattoo on the injured man's chest. Wracked with guilt, the anguished doctor confronts the ethics of his choice and bonds with the victim's daughter. Posing profound questions about hate and redemption, this provocative film won the Best Italian Film and Best Actor awards at the Venice International Film Festival.



PERSIAN LESSONS

Gilles, a young Belgian sent to a concentration camp in Germany in 1942, narrowly avoids execution by swearing that he is not Jewish but Persian. This lie saves him until he is assigned an impossible mission: to teach Persian to the officer in charge of the camp's kitchen, who dreams of opening a restaurant in Persia (Iran) once the war is over. As Gilles invents a language he doesn't know, word by word, the unusual relationship between the two men begins to incite jealousy and suspicion.

CODE NAME AYALON

In 1975, a demolition crew in central Israel was clearing away the remains of an old kibbutz when a small entryway leading to a secret chamber was revealed. They had discovered the Ayalon Institute, an ammunition factory built in 1947 by a group of teens from the Haganah (Jewish underground military). Through interviews with surviving group members, this documentary recounts the construction of the secret bullet factory that played a critical role in the founding of the State of Israel.

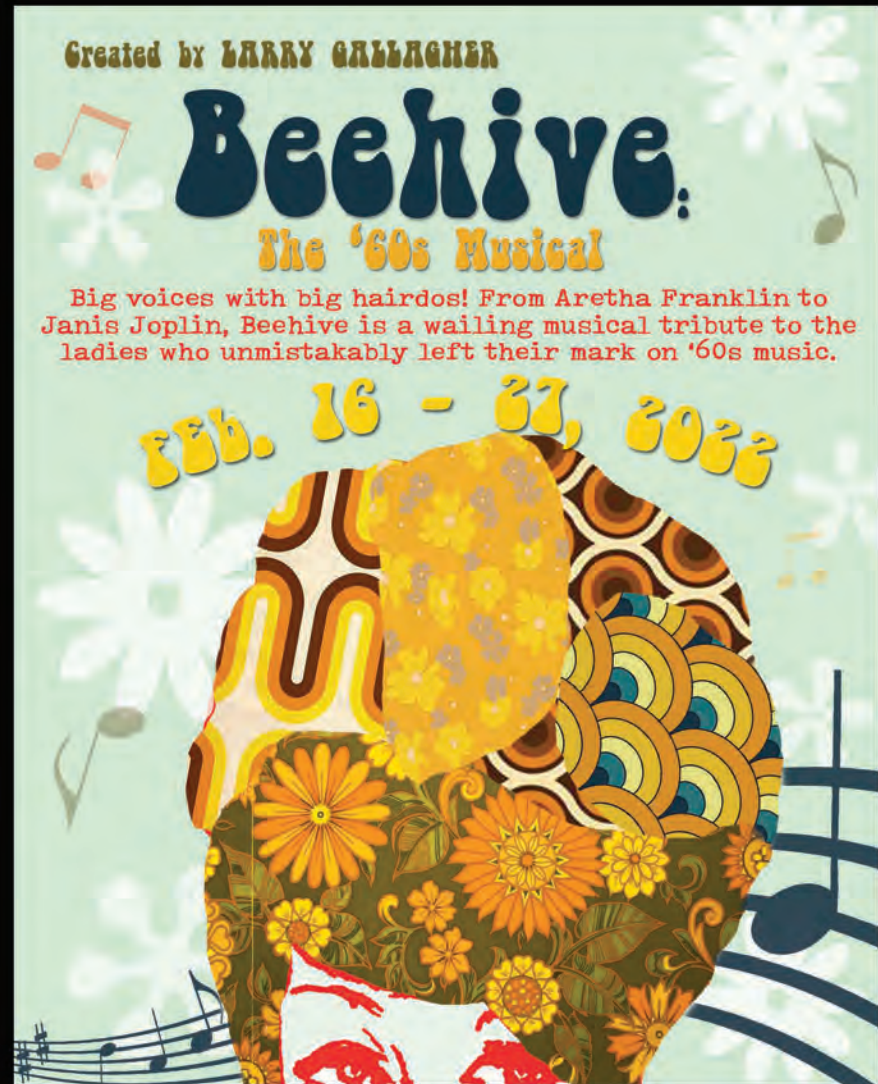

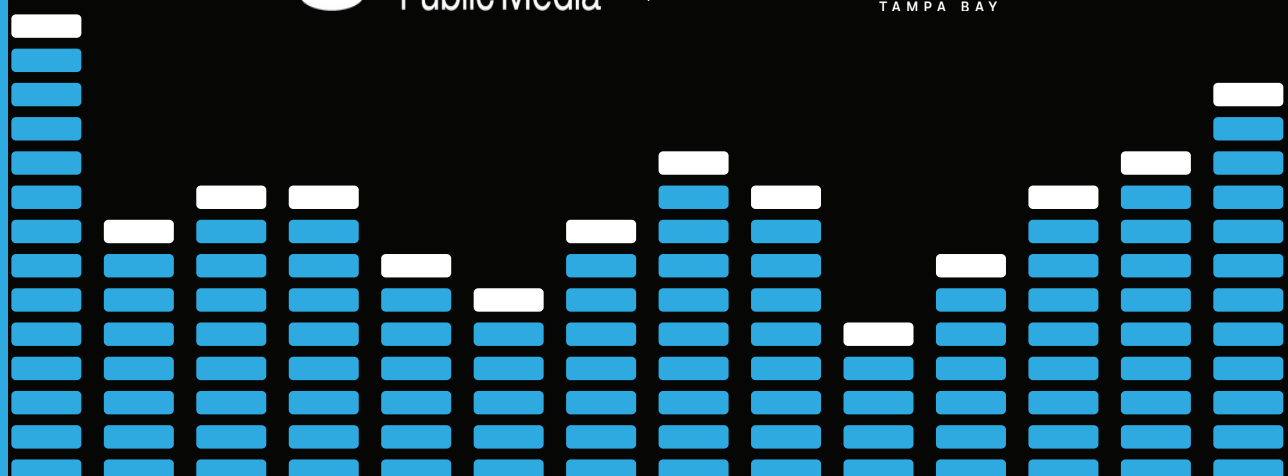

UPHEAVAL: THE JOURNEY OF MENACHEM BEGIN

Menachem Begin was fiercely devoted to the Jewish people and the State of Israel. Jailed in a Soviet gulag for pre-war Zionist activities and scarred by loss in the Holocaust, he founded the Likud party and was vilified as a fascist and terrorist by critics. Yet Begin is remembered as one of Israel's most democratic prime ministers for defending Jewish immigration and signing the historic peace accord with Egypt. Through rarely seen archival materials and astute interviews, this documentary offers nuanced insights into a complex and controversial political figure.
