



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Jewish 11th and 12th grade high school students from Sarasota or Manatee County (you and your parents must have resided in Sarasota or Manatee County for a minimum of one year.)

WHAT'S REQUIRED?

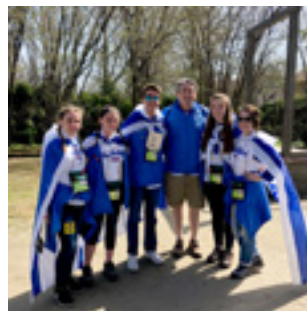
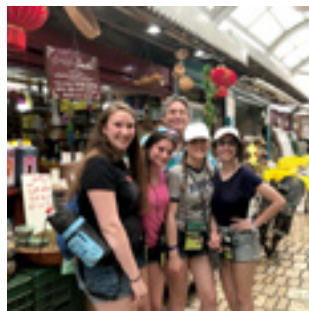
- A completed application, submitted by the deadline, and a personal interview.
- \$1000 family contribution toward the cost of the program. The remainder of the cost will be subsidized by The Jewish Federation.
- Attendance at all pre- and post- mission meetings.
- Upon your return, complete an evaluation of the MOL program and write an essay (at least 500 words) about your experience as a MOL participant. Deadline: TBA
- Attend and/or volunteer for at least 5 Federation events throughout the year. Events may include: speaking opportunities, educational programs, parlor meetings, Annual Meeting, Teen Travel Expo, training sessions and mentorships.

If you feel that you are unable to meet these requirements, please reconsider your involvement with this program.

NOTE: No student will be denied this opportunity due to the lack of financial resources. Such situations will be addressed by the Financial Hardship Committee.
