Through strategic grant making, JWF addresses issues of importance to this population both locally and internationally.

JWF funds organizations that address issues through a gender and Jewish lens.

We are interested in funding projects that recognize Jewish women and girls as having unique needs due to both their gender and their religious and cultural heritage.



### OUR FUNDING PROCESS

JWF practices a hands-on approach to funding, helping women who may be overlooked by other funding sources.

In December, non-profits locally and around the world can access our letter of intent for grants via our website.

In March, we review letters of intent and decide which organizations will submit a full grant application in early April.




## THE IMPACT OF JWF
