Is the March of Remembrance still happening?

Yes! Due to COVID-19, we are asking all participants to walk anytime they wish during October 4-11th. We will be having a formal program with Dr. Stephen Smith on Zoom on Monday, October 12, 2020 starting at 7 PM that we hope you will join us for.

If you ever thought about participating in the March of Remembrance or have walked with us in the past... now is the time to take a stand. We know that these are uncertain times, but we are all in this together, and we need your support and our community now more than ever.

When and where are participants walking?

This year we are encouraging participants to walk during New Jersey's Week of Respect happening October 4-11, 2020. Walkers have the flexibility to walk with their families or 'social bubbles' in their neighborhoods, out in nature, or whenever they feel most comfortable.

What should walkers wear when they are out? Walkers should dress comfortably when out walking in their neighborhoods. We encourage participants to wear a previous March of Remembrance t-shirt or **purple** while out walking.

Should I take a photo or video of myself/group?

Absolutely! Please take photos/videos of yourself or your group while out walking. Use the hashtag #NoMorHate when sharing on Facebook, Twitter or Instagram and make sure to tag @RaabGoodwinMuseum on Facebook. You can also email your photos/videos to raabgoodwin@jfedsnj.org.

Can I invite friends and family who don't live in the Cherry Hill area?

Absolutely, since everything is virtual this year, this is the perfect time to spread the word about our Raab/Goodwin efforts to remember the Holocaust and its many lessons of accepting differences.

Can I walk with a sign?

We encourage those that are marching to create their own signs with uplifting messages or to create signs that honor and remember Holocaust survivors in your own family.

Suggested sign messages include:

Be an Upstander, Celebrate Diversity, Choose Respect, and Make a Difference

Will there be a March of Remembrance t-shirt?

Unfortunately there will be no March of Remembrance t-shirts this year.

Is there a fee to participate in the March of Remembrance?

There will be no charge to participate in the March of Remembrance. However, we are encouraging all of our walkers and supporters to [make a donation to a the Esther Raab Holocaust Museum & Education Center](#).

Why should I register if I'm walking on my own and I don't have to pay a registration fee?

We want to know how many people are walking with us as we stand up to hatred and intolerance. It will also enable you to get the link to hear Dr. Smith and see photos of community members who have joined our efforts to make our voices heard in our community and beyond.

What link do I use to join the virtual event featuring Dr. Stephen Smith on Monday, October 12, 2020 at 7 PM?

If you register for the March of Remembrance, you will receive an email confirmation with a link to access the virtual event. The event will be a webinar/seminar format meaning that participants' microphones and cameras will be automatically turned off for the whole event. However, during the event, participants will be able to ask our speaker questions through a chat feature.

Who should I make the check out to?

What happens if I check the box “Cover Processing Fees?”

If you check this box, you will be charged the amount indicated. This amount will also be visible to the Esther Raab Holocaust Museum & Goodwin Education Center, however, on the fundraising page your intended, initial donation amount will be displayed.

Are donations tax-deductible?

All monetary donations are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Do all donors who mail their donation receive a receipt?

Any donor who mailed their donation and provided an address will receive a receipt via mail once the donation has been processed.

Do all donors who contribute online receive a receipt?

Yes, anyone who donates online, regardless of amount, will receive a receipt via email.
