

#### DR. STEPHEN SMITH, USC SHOAH FOUNDATION FINCI-VITERBI EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Dr. Stephen Smith is the USC Shoah Foundation Finci-Viterbi Executive Director and holds the UNESCO Chair on Genocide Education.

Dr. Smith founded the UK Holocaust Centre in Nottinghamshire, England and cofounded the Aegis Trust for the prevention of crimes against humanity and genocide. He was also the inaugural Chairman of the Holocaust Memorial Day Trust, which runs the National Holocaust Memorial Day in the United Kingdom.


Dr. Smith has served as a producer on a number of film and new media projects, including Dimensions in Testimony, and the VR project The Last Goodbye.

In recognition of his work, Dr. Smith has become a member of the Order of the British Empire and received the Interfaith Gold Medallion. He also holds two honorary doctorates, and lectures widely on issues relating to the history and collective response to the Holocaust, genocide, and crimes against humanity.












