What is it?

- A Lion of Judah Endowment Fund is a permanent endowment fund of the Jewish Federation of Western Massachusetts established in your name to perpetuate your annual Lion of Judah commitment to the Federation's Annual Campaign.
- The annual spendable portion of the Lion of Judah Endowment Fund is used each year to make a grant to the Federation's Annual Campaign. The grant will be made into perpetuity in your name.

How does it work?

- You create a Lion of Judah Endowment Fund with a minimum gift of \$100,000.
- You can make a gift of cash, securities or other property through your estate plan to create a Lion of Judah Endowment Fund either during your lifetime or after your death.
- You can also use life insurance, charitable remainder trusts, retirement accounts and donor advised fund recommendations to create a Lion of Judah Endowment Fund.

What are the benefits?

- When you make the gift during your lifetime, you may receive a charitable income tax deduction.
- If you use your estate plan, and a gift is made upon your death, your estate can receive a charitable income tax deduction.
