

FILL THE FRIDGE



The Jewish Federation of Central Mass in partnership with Worcester JCC Cares and ClarkU Hillel are working together to “Fill the Fridge” to combat food insecurity in our greater Worcester Community with volunteers purchasing and delivering food (perishable and non-perishable) to the Worcester Community Fridges located in downtown Worcester. One is located at 910 Main Street outside Fantastic Pizza near Clark University, and the other is located at 44 Portland Street. Please note that when you bring food, items **can’t be homemade**. They must be store bought, wrapped up, canned, or boxed for safety. Food can also be stored in the freezer. Non-refrigerated/freezer items can be placed on the shelves adjacent to the refrigerator.
