- McClellan Street Cemeteries

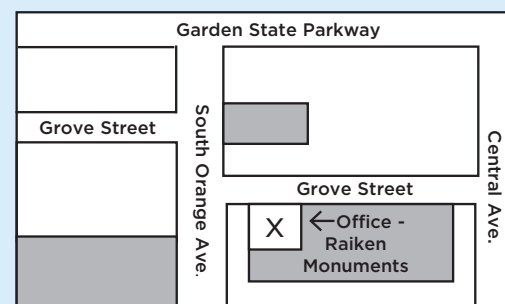
