Featuring recent films and trailers including:

Nana, an award-winning documentary by Belgian filmmaker Serena Dykman, tells the story of her grandmother, Maryla, a heroic Auschwitz survivor who served as a translator for Dr. Josef Mengele. After the war, Maryla made it her mission to transmit her eyewitness reports. The film explores the effect that process has had on her daughter and granddaughter as they have been retracing Maryla's harrowing journey. The 25-year-old producer will be here for the post-screening discussion.

Michael Zeiger, a child survivor who, along with his brother, parents, and two young, Jewish girls, was saved by Anton, the subject of a picture book, *The Secret of the Village Fool*, will be here to discuss the book, which is currently being made into a Hollywood feature film.

My Little Diary: The Story of Eva Heyman (1931-1945) is a short documentary made by Association Tikvah Oradea, in Romania. The film, based on Eva's diary, is about their "Anne Frank," who wrote about her hopes and desire to live.

We will also screen four trailers: **Unconquered Souls**, about the life of Anita Boyko Fox and her unusual family; **Be An Upstander: The Life of Fred Heyman**, executive producer, Howard Goldberg; **Windows**, scenes from the Holocaust Council's "Shoah Stories on Stage" contest winner, Melissa Shaffer; and **An Inconvenient Time**, a film about Ruth Ravina, executive producer Dennis Klein.
