

THE JEWISH FEDERATION'S AM HASEFER INITIATIVE

In the Post October 7th environment, Jewish and Zionist voices in creative spaces have been silenced and marginalized, specifically among writers, booksellers, awards, conferences and related academia. This has been happening at an unparalleled scale and pace in the US and across the English speaking world. By highlighting Jewish and Zionist authors and books, the community can support their creativity, draw attention to their talent, learn from their insight, and call out the silencers. This is a proactive way for community members to be engaged in confronting antisemitism.

Rockland's unique Am Hasefer Initiative (amhasefer.org) engages the community in a creative endeavor, in an accessible and stimulating way. The Initiative asks community members from several different constituencies to read and review Jewish books for our platforms on our website, on social media and in our newsletter. Reviewers are offered a reimbursement for books purchased with a completed and published review. The Initiative aspires to highlight at least two titles per month reviewed by a community member.

Subject areas in our curated list include Fiction, Non Fiction, Children's, Jewish Cookbooks, Jewish Thought, Israel and antisemitism. The Initiative actively seeks out local Jewish authors to highlight and build additional programming around, including author talks and readings.

Data from the first four months of the Initiative is promising. There have been thousands of engagements on social media and the unique website, as well as a dozen reviews, with more anticipated each month. Potential partnerships being explored include local book clubs, synagogues, informal education programs and schools.

Your support will enable us to reach a broader audience, soliciting more content and providing more opportunities for creative action to confront hate and antisemitism by platforming Jewish and Zionist voices. A sponsorship of \$2,500 will support the basic operational infrastructure of the initiative. A sponsorship of \$5,000 will support the infrastructure and programming, such as presentations by authors. A sponsorship of \$10,000 will support all of the above and provide an opportunity for naming the initiative.






The Gates of Gaza
