The Annual Meeting in June, at the end of the fiscal year, and the Campaign Kickoff in early September, are long-standing annual highlights of the Jewish Federation of Rockland County.

While the Annual Meeting informs the community of the Federation's programmatic and fundraising accomplishments during the past year, as well as goals for the upcoming year, the Campaign Kickoff launches the start of the year's fundraising effort to sustain the organization's community wide programs and support for vital agencies in Israel.

The Annual Meeting also recognizes the leadership of outgoing and the appointment of incoming members of the Federation's Board of Directors.

A highlight of the Campaign Kickoff is typically a performer or a guest speaker providing words of significance for the Jewish community, and a brief presentation on Federation's short- and long- term goals in meeting the organization's Mission. A dessert reception is offered ahead of or following these events, with opportunities for interaction with leadership and donors.
