

## JEWISH FEDERATION'S PROGRAMS OVERCOMING HATE & ANTISEMITISM

It has become increasingly evident over the last two years that the Rockland Jewish community is uncommonly placed in both vulnerability and opportunity as the entire American Jewish community grapples with a rising tide of hate and antisemitism. With over 400 Jewish institutions and a Jewish population density (31%+) higher than any other county in the US, the challenges - in terms of security, policy, wellbeing and confidence - are unique.

Addressing the needs of this large and diverse Jewish community is a key role of the Jewish Federation of Rockland. Federation's role as convener, consensus builder, program coordinator, and security provider mandates continuing and sustained programming, reflecting the needs of all elements of the community in understanding the challenges of the moment and rising to them.


Past stand-alone and partnered programming has included **Understanding Antisemitism in Progressive Spaces** with **Joe Roberts**, dialogue with representatives of the **Muslim Women's Speakers Bureau**, and regular community briefings with local and international experts like retired IDF Colonel **Grisha Yakubovich** and Honest Reporting CEO **Gil Hoffman** 

Federation will continue to develop and deliver programming that meets the challenges of the day, partnering with synagogues and other places of worship, as well as bringing together the entire community for commemoration or celebration. Federation's Oct. 7th, 2024 one-year memorial brought together over 1,500 community members. The size, scope, and location of each program differs, but the goal is to build the community's knowledge and resilience in the face of hate.
