

JEWISH FEDERATION'S PRE-HOLIDAY SECURITY BRIEFINGS

Pre-holiday security briefings have been an integral part of the Jewish Federation of Rockland County's Community Security Initiative since its inception in 2022.

In our mission to raise the level of security for institutions in the community, we collaborate with law enforcement at every level - local, county, state and federal. In Rockland, we work closely with town and village police departments, the Sheriff's office and the District Attorney's office. This includes intelligence sharing, which takes place 24/7 and every day, threat training collaboration, and coordination on advising the public of active or potential threats.

In preparation for the High Holy Days, just prior to the start of Rosh Hashanah, and before the start of Passover, the Jewish Federation organizes a communitywide briefing (in person and/or via zoom) inviting lay leaders and professional staff charged with security responsibilities at synagogues, day schools, day camps and other Jewish and faith institutions. Statistics, threat analysis, and relevant best practices are shared along with any alerts, at a time when Jewish community institutions and the community they serve are visibly involved in holiday preparations and providing synagogue services.

Additionally, the Jewish Federation convenes special briefings via Zoom or in person, when there may be an elevated threat, environment or global events affecting Jewish community security.
