

SECURITY ASSESSMENTS OF JEWISH AND OTHER VULNERABLE INSTITUTIONS

An alarming increase in hate-based and antisemitic attacks in the U.S. - a nationwide escalation of 890% in 10 years - led to the launch of a Community Security Initiative by the Jewish Federation of Rockland in July, 2022.

The heart of this Initiative is protecting lives, by heightening the security of Jewish institutions as well as organizations in other targeted and vulnerable communities. The first step is the provision of security assessments of physical structures and properties that may be vulnerable to harassment, vandalism, and violence, with the ultimate goal of preventing or lessening the impact of an attack.

To date, the Jewish Federation's Security Director has completed comprehensive assessments of more than 100 synagogues, day schools, camps and other community organizations that may be at risk. With a network of over 250 institutions that have received these assessments and/or other consulting and training, Federation's Security Initiative is the single most prolific professional resource for security assessments in all of Rockland County, advising on specific, detailed measures to heighten the security of each facility.

A private assessment costs up to \$10,000, which is not realistic for many non-profit institutions, especially smaller ones. Rockland's Community Security Initiative provides these and other vital services at no cost
