



JEA Camp Savannah Hours

JEA Camp Savannah hours are Monday through Friday, 9am–5pm. JEA Camp Savannah offers complimentary early drop off from 8-9am and late pick up from 5-6pm.

To drop off or pick up campers in the middle of the day, please proceed to the Front Desk of the JEA. Please note, it may take up to 10 minutes for campers being picked up to arrive at the Front Desk. JEA Camp Savannah utilizes all areas of the JEA and campers may be away from their belongings. Please plan accordingly.

After Hours Fees

Late pick up fees will be assessed at a rate of \$1 per minute per camper after 6pm. The parent or pick up person will be required to sign a form noting the time of pick up and authorizing to charge the card on file.

JEA Camp Savannah Registration Fee

A \$50 non-refundable registration fee, that does not apply to the weekly camp fee, is required at the time of camp registration. This fee is ONLY refundable for families whose financial aid packages do not meet their needs and therefore are not able to attend camp.

If you are registering campers for both JEA Camp Savannah AND JEA Preschool Savannah's Summer Program at the same time, there is only one \$50 family registration fee required. (Registering children at separate times will result in a registration fee for each program.)

Payment Process

Registration must be submitted in person or via email to kids@savj.org. All registrations must include a valid credit card form at the time of submission. Registration packets cannot be accepted via mail as there is no reliable way to track receipt. If no alternate form of payment is provided, the credit card provided will be charged \$50 at the time of registration.

A camp invoice will be sent via email within a week of registration. This invoice will confirm JEA Camp Savannah registration and provide camp payment dates. If you do not receive an email within one (1) week of submission, please contact kids@savj.org.

JEA Camp Savannah Discounts

1. Multi-Camper Discount - \$10 off per additional camper per week (first camper is FULL PRICE). To receive the discount, campers must be registered for the same weeks. Discount does not cross over to include the JEA Preschool Savannah Summer Program. All campers must be registered in JEA Camp Savannah.
2. Early Bird Discount – If you plan on paying your bill for Camp Savannah in full by 6pm, March 15th, a \$20 per week discount per child will be applied. Your child(ren) must be registered for no less than four (4) weeks of camp (the weeks do not need to be consecutive). Payment is non-refundable, but is transferable to other JEA camp weeks this summer and to other JEA Children's Programs. In the event that your camper attends less than four (4) weeks, the discount will be voided and the difference will be deducted from your credit. This credit will remain active for six (6) months following the last day of camp. After the 6-month period, the credit is surrendered to the JEA. Any weeks that are added after March 15th will not receive the discount.



Clothing & Personal Items

- Sneakers are required for camp. Please do not send your camper in open-toed shoes. Open-toed shoes may be used during water activities ONLY.
- Campers should bring a swimsuit, towel and sunscreen every day. **MARK FIRST AND LAST NAMES ON ALL BELONGINGS.** Lost items will be placed in the camp lost-and-found and kept there for two (2) weeks. If you are missing any items, please notify the Camp Director immediately. The lost-and-found will be emptied out on a monthly basis and all unclaimed items will be donated to local charities.
- PLEASE AVOID THE FOLLOWING: Nice clothes that you do not want to become dirty, cell phones and iPods, any hand-held gaming units, slime, and toys from home.

Sunscreen

Please apply sunscreen daily. We ask that all campers bring sunscreen with them to camp. Counselors will remind campers to apply sunscreen periodically throughout the day to avoid sunburn. If needed, campers will be assisted with applying sunscreen.

Water/Hydration

Campers are required to come to camp with a water bottle daily. Water fountains and coolers are provided for all campers daily.

Bad Weather/Excessive Heat

In the event of bad weather or excessive heat (i.e. thunder, lightning, heat advisory), campers are brought inside and provided with alternate activities.

Head Lice Policy

JEA Camp Savannah takes every instance of head lice seriously and takes precautions to prevent its spread. If a camper is found to have head lice at camp, a parent or guardian will be notified and the camper will be required to leave camp. After 24 hours of proper treatment, and once all nits have been removed, the camper may return to camp. Upon returning to camp, the camper will have a head lice screening by a Camp Director. If nits are found, the camper will not be permitted to return to camp. If the camper is nit free, they will be permitted to return to camp activities.

Medication

Please list on the registration form special needs or medications regarding your camper's health. JEA Camp Savannah staff recommend that medications which enable your camper to positively participate in group settings be continued throughout camp. If a camper is in the process of changing medications or cycles, please notify camp staff so they can keep you informed of any change in behavior or health.

Medications required to be taken during the camp day must be given to the Camp Director with a note naming the medication, what it is for and when it should be given, along with a parent's/guardian's signature. Prescription medication must be in its original container (no plastic bags please!) and will be dispensed only under the specific directions of a licensed physician.



Lunch & Kosher Rules

Please send a cold, bagged lunch with your camper each day. Due to the volume of campers, lunches cannot be warmed or heated. Please respect the Jewish dietary laws, called Kashrut or Kosher, observed by the JEA. This requires that lunches only contain kosher dairy or certified kosher parve (neither milk nor meat) items. No meat items are allowed. Suggestions on lunch ideas are listed below. For any questions about the laws of kashrut, please ask. We are happy to help!

Shabbat Lunches

Every Friday, JEA Camp Savannah has a special themed lunch celebration in honor of Shabbat. A hot lunch is provided by camp that day. Lunches may include BBQ hamburger/hotdogs, chicken nuggets, mac-n-cheese or pizza along with sides, a drink and dessert. Campers do not have to bring lunch on Fridays. However, campers are welcome to pack their own lunch if they may not like the meal or if they have certain dietary restrictions.

Payment & Registration Due Dates

The dates listed on the next page are the registration and payment due dates for Camp Savannah 2019 – each of these days is the Wednesday before each week of Camp. If you have registered but have not paid for your camper-week before the dates listed below, your on-file credit or debit card will be charged on Thursday morning. Should any pre-authorized credit/debit card charge not be honored by 10am on Friday morning, then your credit/debit card will be charged in the amount of the original payment plus a \$25 service charge. If such payment is not honored by the credit/debit card institution, then the JEA may resubmit the amount due (including service charges) at a future date. If corrections to the amount are necessary, it may involve an automatic adjustment (credit or debit) to your debit/credit card on file.

To add or change weeks:

- Space must be available.
- Please email kids@savj.org by 5pm the Wednesday prior.
- If a week is added after 5pm Wednesday, there will be a \$25 late fee per child.
- **Camp changes must be requested by email to kids@savj.org.**

Late Registration Fees

All campers must be registered and paid for by 5pm on the Wednesday prior to the week they wish to attend. Campers registering/paying after 5pm on the Wednesday prior to the week they wish to attend will be charged a \$25 late fee per camper.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

While the JEA understands that family plans may change, camp plans are made based on camper enrollment. See below for details about cancellations, refunds and credits.

There will be no refunds made for cancellations received after 5pm on the Wednesday prior to the scheduled start date unless a camper is unable to participate due to medical reasons. Canceling a camp week for medical reasons require a physician's letter provided to the JEA no later than the Friday of associated sick week. After receiving physician's letter within deadline, a full refund for associated week will be given. (Emailed doctor's notes are accepted. Please email to kids@savj.org.)

Cancellations made on or before 5pm on the Wednesday prior to your camper attending the registered week of camp will receive a 100% refund. After this time, a credit of the amount paid will be given for future weeks at Camp Savannah or children's programs. This credit will remain active for six (6) months following the last day of camp. After the 6-month period, the credit is surrendered to the JEA.

Non-compliance with JEA Camp Savannah's Behavior Contract can result in a camper's termination from JEA Camp Savannah's programming, without a refund.

Cancellations and week changes are not accepted over the phone. All cancellations must be submitted by email to kids@savj.org.
