VISION

Through its annual campaign, the Federation is the primary collector and distributor of funds for Jewish causes in Savannah, in Israel, and 56 countries throughout the world. SJF oversees the distribution of approximately \$2,000,000 annually, including Federation allocations to beneficiary agencies in Savannah and around the world, grants through the Jewish Community Foundation of Savannah and financial assistance to the needy.

HISTORY

The Savannah Jewish Federation has a long history of providing for the needs of our local community, as well as contributing to the education, welfare, and support of our world Jewish community. The City of Savannah has a very active and diverse Jewish community that has its roots going back to 1733.

MISSION

The Savannah Jewish Federation is charged with the mission to "advance the welfare of the total Jewish community." The Federation strongly supports Israel and world Jewry. Additionally, SJF strives to "preserve the civil, political, economic and religious rights of all Jews" to develop an articulate, intelligent and constructive Jewish community and to promote mutual understanding with the community at-large.

- A. To coordinate, facilitate and make more effective the functioning of all Savannah Jewish Communal life; to encourage and support social, recreational, religious, benevolent, philanthropic, educational and cultural activities among organizations, the individual members thereof; and to be constituted and governed in a manner that will exemplify, foster and preserve the principles of the Jewish heritage and American democracy.
- B. To raise, collect and distribute funds to local, national and overseas causes, for the purpose of advancing the welfare of the total Jewish community, either directly or through presently existing or subsequently established agencies.
- C. To preserve the civil, political, economic and religious rights of all Jews wherever they may be, whenever and wherever such rights may be in jeopardy, either directly or through presently existing or subsequently established agencies.
- D. To further the development of an articulate, intelligent and constructive Jewish community.
- E. To promote mutual understanding with the community at large and, to that end, use means that are democratic and representative of the wishes of the Jewish community.
- F. To encourage the amicable adjustment of differences between individuals and organizations by providing the appropriate machinery for conciliation and arbitration.

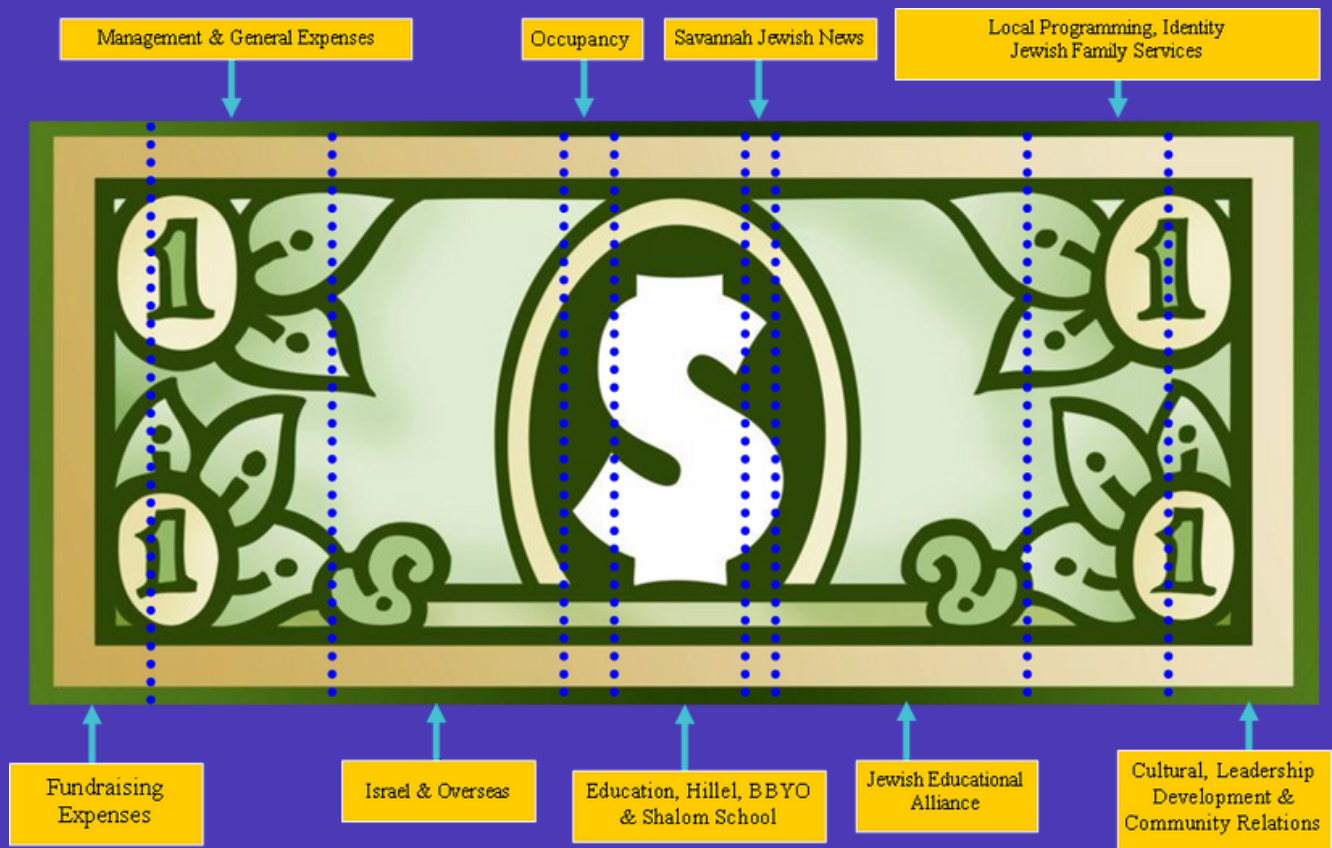

FOUR STAR CHARITY

Each year the Savannah Jewish Federation receives an independent Annual Audit done by the Certified Accountants of Canady, Richbourg, and Woodward, LLC, of all donations and expenditures made for the past year. Highlights from the audit of our Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2021 include:

Fundraising Expenses - Reflects what a charity spends to raise money, including printing, publicity, mailing, and event expense - 2.19%.

Management and General Expenses - Reflects what percentage of its total budget a charity spends on overhead, administrative staff, and associated costs including depreciation, building, maintenance, telephone, etc. SJF's total was only 10.5%.

Program Services - What percent of its total budget a charity spends on the programs and services it exists to deliver was 87.1%



The Savannah Jewish Federation is proud to be a Charity Navigator "4-Star Charity," the highest designation given to a non-profit. The Savannah Jewish Federation received an overall score of 94.00

That is higher than 99% of all charities in the US (in recognition of financial health, performance, accounting & transparency.)

JEWISH COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF SAVANNAH

The Jewish Community Foundation of Savannah (the Foundation) is dedicated to creating permanent resources to meet the challenges and needs of the Savannah Jewish community, connecting yesterday, today and tomorrow. Individuals and family donors work in partnership with the Foundation to enhance Jewish community life and education.

The Foundation is fortunate to be invested in The Investment Fund for Foundations (TIFF). TIFF is a cooperative-style investment organization founded by a nationwide network of foundations whose mission is

- To seek to enhance the investment returns of non-profit organizations.
- To reduce the investment and administrative expenses of non-profit organizations.
- To broaden the universe of investment choices available to non-profit organizations.
- To assist non-profit organizations in deploying their assets in a manner that will support charitable expenditures while preserving the purchasing power of their assets.

The TIFF Multi-Asset Fund seeks to produce an annualized real return of 5% or more over long-term holding periods. In pursuit of this aim the fund employs a globally diversified portfolio. The Fund is a highly blended combination of assets including US Stocks, T-Bills, High Yield Bonds, Inflation Hedges (i.e. REITs and commodities), and Deflation Hedges (Conventional bonds).
