

Pool Safety and Swimming

We love swimming at the JEA!

In order to ensure that everyone is comfortable and safe in the water we require that ALL campers wear a life jacket, provided by the JEA, until they pass a Swim Test. The Swim Test requires that the camper

- Is able to confidently swim a set distance (about 25 feet) independently without the use of a flotation device; and
- tread water with their head above water for one minute.

Once a camper passes the Swim Test they are no longer required to wear a life jacket unless a parent/guardian requests otherwise.

Each group will swim once a week throughout the year.

JEA Pools are supervised by trained and certified Life Guards at all times.
