Whether your camper chooses a Specialty Camp or Traditional Camp, your camper will attend Camp JCC from 8:00-3:30pm Mon-Fri!

Daily Schedule

- Morning (8:00-10:45am): Drop off and pick up will take place at the Camp Pavilion.
 <u>Drop off begins at 8 am. All campers are expected to arrive before 8:30 am.</u>
 <u>Grades 1-3:</u> Swim from 8:45-9:45am followed by morning activity from 9:45-10:45am.
 <u>Grades 4-8:</u> Morning activity from 8:30-9:45am followed by swim from 9:45-10:45am.
- Lunch (10:45-11:30am): Parents may pack a nut-free, kosher-style lunch for their campers or elect to purchase lunches. Afternoon snacks will be provided.
- Afternoon (11:30am-3:00pm): Specialty campers will go to their specialty camps. Traditional campers will take part in rotations, including PE and art activities, led by specialists!
 2:30-3:00pm: Campers will finish cleaning and packing up.
- Pick Up Time (3:00-3:30pm): Children will enjoy an afternoon snack with their peers while awaiting departure.

Aftercare is available from 3:30-5:30pm daily.
All campers must be picked up by 5:30pm.

SWIMMING AT CAMP

- All campers should bring a swimsuit, towel, goggles (if needed), and a swim bag to put wet clothes in daily.
- Grades 1-3 swim from 8:45am-9:45am. All campers must be at camp by 8:30am so they have time to get ready for swimming. Please make sure your campers are in a swimsuit when they get dropped off.
- Grades 4-8 swim from 9:45am-10:45am. All campers should be at camp by 8:30am. If they come in swim wear, please have them wear a t-shirt and shorts over a swimsuit as they will first be participating in a morning activity.

PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF

- Drop-off begins at 8:00am. All campers should arrive by 8:30am.
- Pick up begins at 3:00pm. All campers must be picked up by 3:30pm.




