Our camps are available on a flexible week-byweek basis with 3-4 specialty camps each week to provide a unique experience, custom tailored to your camper's unique interests.

Whether your camper chooses a Specialty Camp or Traditional Camp, everyone will attend Camp JCC from 8:00-3:30pm daily!

Daily Schedule

- Morning (8:00-10:45am): Drop off and pick up will take place at the Camp Pavilion. <u>Drop off</u> <u>begins at 8 am. All campers are expected to</u> <u>arrive before 8:45 am.</u> Campers will have their morning snack, participate in daily swimming, and counselor-led activities with their peers during this time.
- Lunch (10:45-11:30am): Parents may pack lunch for their camper or elect to purchase boxed lunches. Please see details under the Lunches & Snacks section of this guide as lunches must be kosher-style and nut-free.
- Afternoon (11:30am-2:30pm): Your child will attend their designated Specialty Camp or Traditional campers will engage in themed hands-on creative arts and physical education activities!
- Dismissal (3:00-3:30pm): Children will enjoy
 a snack with their peers while awaiting
 departure. Pick up from the Camp Pavilion
 begins at 3 pm and all campers must be
 picked up by 3:30 pm. We are happy to offer

 who need a bit more flexibility.





STEP 1

CampMinder is our one-stop database to register and manage your child's summer, all online. If your child has attended Camp JCC from 2019-2023, your information is already in the system and can be updated for each season by logging into your account! To log into your existing account, visit akronjcc.campintouch.com, then choose "Camper Application" and the 2024 season to add desired sessions!

- If you are a new camp family, to register for Camp JCC 2024, please visit our website at shawjcc.org/camp-j and click the "registration," button to access CampMinder. You will enter each child's information just once, and it will be saved and available to update whenever you wish.

Fill out the required information and follow a few simple steps to get signed up for Camp JCC 2024! As you go through CampMinder, here are a few helpful tips:

- 1. List the grade that your child is CURRENTLY IN, for the 2023-24 academic school year.
- 2. If there is a parent/quardian who lives in a separate household, choose "Add a Parent/Guardian who Resides at Another Address" and enter the appropriate info.
- 3. You may save your progress at any time and come back to it at a later date!

- 1. For JCC members, your member number begins with a "J" and is followed by a series of digits. This can be found on your JCC card!
- 2. If choosing 3 Day PM Care, you can tailor the days of the week to meet your needs/schedule!
- 3. Your electronic signature is required just type your full name after you've read our TERMS and CONDITIONS, enter your financial information and form of payment and your camper will be all set!
