


Shaw JCC: Your One-Stop Spot for Quality Child Care

Tuition Fees

All full-year tuition fees are required to be set-up on a monthly Tuition Payment Plan. There is a one-time \$50 registration fee per child. This fee is not included in the rates listed below. All families enrolling in Child Care must be members in good standing at the Shaw JCC of Akron. A 25% discount will be applied to membership fees as long as the enrollment in the program is sustained.
