

*The following incidents occurred across the state that are reported directly to me/SCN or that I've read about in the news. This list does not include incidents that are shared with me by the ADL or the Oregon Bias Hotline, unless they are in the public domain. This list may inadvertently omit incidents, and some may be omitted for privacy.*

#### August 2025

- On 15 August 2025, an identified individual attempted to gain access to a Portland synagogue by attempting to catch a closing door by a staff member. He was stopped and told not to return, and he complied. Since 28 June 2025, He has also attempted to contact staff at other synagogues to share his conspiracy theories regarding Sandy Hook, Aurora (Colorado) shooter, Jeffrey Epstein, the Holocaust, along with other national news events within the last 15 years.
- On 5 August, while a group of 20 people were peacefully gathering/marching for the hostages in Gaza, a man exited a nearby restaurant on SE Hawthorne Blvd in Portland and began yelling profanities, including "heil hitler... he should have finished the job".
- On 5 August, a Portland business owner received a message from the contact page on their website. The message said "Hi there, I have a cousin in the IDF who has been collecting the skins of the children he euthanizes in Gaza. Wondering if you could help me stitch these into some kind of blanket?"
- On 5 August, the resident of a private residence in Portland that was tagged last year with the word "Jew" had an interaction with an unidentified man in a park across the street from their house. The man appeared to be looking for something, and the resident asked if he could help. The man quickly escalated his voice, body movement, and threatened the resident and called him something "Jewish". The man then continued to yell at our house for the next 10 minutes and screamed, "I know where you f&\*(ing live". Portland Police were provided with a photograph.
- On 5 August, a flyer advertising a Jewish festival in Portland was tagged with "F%&\$ IDF" and "Free Gaza."
- On the morning of 1 August, a Jewish staff member of an Oregon university exited their residence and found a noose made of graduation cords hanging from their vehicle's windshield wipers.

#### July 2025

- On Wednesday, 30 July, a staff member from UO's College of Arts and Sciences reported discovering multiple antisemitic publications, including materials celebrating the October 7th Hamas attack, being distributed throughout the student union —specifically near the O Desk, Fishbowl, and outside the ROAR Center (a registered student organization office). These publications include violent rhetoric calling for the murder of Jews and display logos of several UO-affiliated groups. The materials were allegedly printed, stocked, and restocked

over several days. On 29 July, an unidentified person placed swastika graffiti on the door and windows at a local organization.

- On 19 July, a Portland synagogue received suspicious emails from an identified person who has reportedly been sending similar emails to organizations in various states.
- On 11 July, chalk graffiti was photographed at NW 23<sup>rd</sup> and Raleigh St in Portland. A phrase stated, “You [need?] to be more careful. Mossad’s careless actions will cost you your arm and both your legs. I’ll make sure of it”. It is not clear who the message was directed to.
- On 14 July, a known person sent two suspicious contact form submissions to a synagogue in Portland.

### **June 2025**

- On the overnight of 20 June, someone smashed a window at a synagogue in Portland. The individual/s appeared to have used the iron lid from the nearby water meter.
- On 21 June, a Portland-based Instagram account wrote a suspicious social media post regarding a Jewish-owned business. The post read "Heads up, folks. New Zion15t has entered the villa."

### **May 2025**

- On 21 May, a person with an Israeli flag positioned themselves across the street from a protest at the ICE building on Macadam Ave in Portland. Two different individuals came over to harass them, leading to the flag being taken and the person being knocked to the ground.
- On 19 May, a Jewish-owned business was vandalized with “Die Zionists” and other anti-Israel graffiti. It was reported to the Portland Police.
- On 13 May, an employee at a Portland organization received a suspicious email. The email was written in English, then translated into French and Arabic. The email also included links to Google Drive folders, Facebook accounts, and a YouTube channel.
- On 12 May, the SCN Duty Desk and RSA Anderson both received a spoofed phishing email purporting to be from a Jewish organization in Portland, Oregon. The sending party asked the recipient to click on a file for review. No funds were lost because of this incident.
- On 10 May, an unidentified male walked past the an organization in Portland and motioned a sieg heil, twice.
- On 8 May, a vehicle drove twice through the driveway of an organization in Portland and subsequently attacked the guard.
- On 3 May 2025, two swastikas drawn in black spray paint were discovered on the sidewalk and a lamppost in Beaverton, OR.

- On 1 May, an employee terminated from a Jewish owned business began to send aggressive text messages to the owner and staff of the establishment. These messages included mentions that people would "burn for your hated" and that "Zionists deserve karma." The employee also stated he would "die for what I believe in."

#### April 2025

- On 23 April, a Portland synagogue received a suspicious email submission. The content of the submission appears to be nonsensical.
- On 21 April, a Yelp user named left a review of an organization in Portland, and said, "i hate this im german and hate jews, so frick this school i hope you get farted on..."
- On 14 April, a known male subject sent a suspicious email to a Portland organization. "Yes, I am Iran." he wrote, "Are you ready for my jihad? We shall execute the enemies of Islam!"
- On or about 11 April, a port-a-potty in Medford, OR was vandalized with the phrase "Kill Kikes" with a Nazi swastika.
- On or about 3 April, at a Portland synagogue, an unknown person pried open the door of a wall-mounted case and crumpled up a document posting building hours and contact info. The document had not yet been replaced, and on the night of April 7 or morning of April 8, the door of the case was again pried open, and this time a partially undecipherable message was written inside. The case is out of camera view. A group of about four young people spent the night camped out in front of the main doors just under the case.

#### March 2025

- On 30 March, an unknown male subject vandalized a local synagogue and its neighbor building. The vandalism was not antisemitic in nature. The subject spray painted several graffiti words and images on the exterior of the buildings that are associated with a streetwear apparel brand.
- On 27 March, an unknown subject sent a spoofing email to a staff member of an organization in Portland. The unknown subject sent an email from the victim's own email address but with the name "American Express." The subject of the email was "Action Required: Validate Your Dispute Charge for Credit Processing on your Card."
- In Spring 2025, a registered nurse at Oregon Health and Science University Hospital in Portland, made several antisemitic posts on Instagram in which she expressed support for Hamas, disparaged deceased Israeli hostages, and implied she would refuse to treat Jewish patients, likening Jews to animals.
- On 1 March, a Portland-area synagogue received an email from an identified person who said "My number is [xxxxx], and I just want to say f--- all of you Jews. And you also been killed in the Holocaust. Heil Hitler, Von [unintelligible]." The caller was

responsible for two other calls to two other synagogues in Washington and Oregon. The FBI handled the matter.

- On 1 March, a synagogue in Portland received a suspicious but nonsensical content submission

### **February 2025:**

- On 25 February, an identified individual made a suspicious phone call to a Portland synagogue.
- On 24 February, a male subject made a suspicious phone call to a Portland area synagogue. The subject asked if the Talmud states that "all non-Jews are scum and should be eliminated."
- On 21 February, a Portland business owner was reported for harassing two small businesses based in Portland. The harasser has been posting anti-Israel content on Instagram that condemns the businesses for their support of Israel. The account has been posting the names of the business owners, along with related articles and personal information about their respective businesses.
- On 19 February, the word "Jew" was discovered written in black ink on the window of a personal residence in a suburb of Portland.
- On 14 February, a Portland-area Shabbat service was interrupted with a pornographic image in a "zoom bombing" incident. The group appeared to bypass the waiting room.
- On 14 February, an Oregon synagogue received a voicemail saying, "I hate the Jews".
- On 12 February, a Portland-area staff member received a call from an identified number and began a rant about how "you people" leave trash everywhere in the community and leave it to everyone else to clean up. She then went on about how the "F-slur [for the LGBT community] god only had one child, named Jesus Christ." When she was asked after that how they can help her, she hung up.
- 11 Feb – a swastika and "Love" + the image of a swastika was found on a lamppost at the Portland Transit Center.
- 3 February – A community member received a phishing email from a spoofed account of a Portland-based Rabbi.

### **January 2025**

- On 30 Jan, an individual reported from southern Oregon that a local pawn shop had a picture of Hitler on their wall.
- On 30 January, a Portland woman pulled into a strip mall parking lot when a female, walking with another female, stared into the car at her. The walker slowed down her walking pace, leaned forward, and gave the reporting party a nazi salute. The female

continued to stare, holding up her arm, then finally moved out of the curb cut area so the victim could continue into the lot.

- On or before 29 January 2025, a male subject left a suspicious voicemail on the answering machine a Portland area organization. The subject has been identified and the information has been shared with law enforcement. In the voicemail, the caller stated "Heil Hitler" as the German Marching Song played in the background of the call.
- On the evening of 21 January, two Jewish families in a suburb of Portland heard loud noises outside their house and exited to find pieces of white bread in their yard. One family had a nearly full loaf found across their front flower beds, and the other family found two slices of bread and an empty Wonderbread bread bag. Both families have students at Mountainside High School, attend a local dance studio, are members of their high school JSU, and wear Stars of David, but the students do not live near each other. The incidents were reported to the local PD who are investigating. Videos have been located but not provided. Six students were involved in the incidents which took place about 30 minutes apart.
- On 20 January, staff arrived at the office of a housing non-profit in the Gateway area of East Portland to find a small swastika drawn adjacent to the office door. The organization is focused on racial, housing, and economic justice, and the Executive Director and some staff and board are Jewish - though it is unknown if it is connected.
- On 20 January, antisemitic graffiti was discovered at a cafe restroom in Portland. The graffiti was a drawing of the Magen David being thrown in the trash with the words, "Free Palestine Fuck Israel." Additionally, a sickle & hammer was etched into the wall. The report also stated that the words "The Jewish religion is narcissism" were written above the toilet.
- On 4 January, a dark Crossover stopped in front of a Portland area organization's gate and the front-seat passenger started recording with a cell phone. They left when a hired security guard approached.
