Where New Energy Starts First

We invest across all eight impact areas. That doesn't change. But we also identified where to concentrate new investment based on the biggest gaps and greatest opportunities right now:

The Two Questions Everyone Has

① *"If my agency isn't named in a priority, am I out?"*

No. Priorities are where new energy starts—not where support ends. Your work continues.

② *"Are roles getting blurry between Federation and Foundation?"*

No. If anything, they're clearer than ever. Federation and Foundation each have their own independent strategic plans. Where they come together is in service to this shared Community Strategic Plan. You'll still know who to go to for what.
