Candidate must demonstrate:

- Work ethic
- Character
- Volunteer experience in the Indianapolis Jewish and/or Indianapolis community

Complete this application, sign, date and submit with the following:

1. Essay - A typed and double-spaced essay that describes why you qualify for the scholarship and what does it mean to you to be part of the Indianapolis Jewish community
2. Transcript - Official school transcript
3. References - Three letters of reference from teachers, employers, clergy, personal mentors, etc. (no relatives or significant others).
4. Photograph - Include a photo.

NOTE: Final candidates will have a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee to be conducted at the Jewish Federation office. 2019 date to be determined.
