(Jewish Respondents Age 65 and Over)



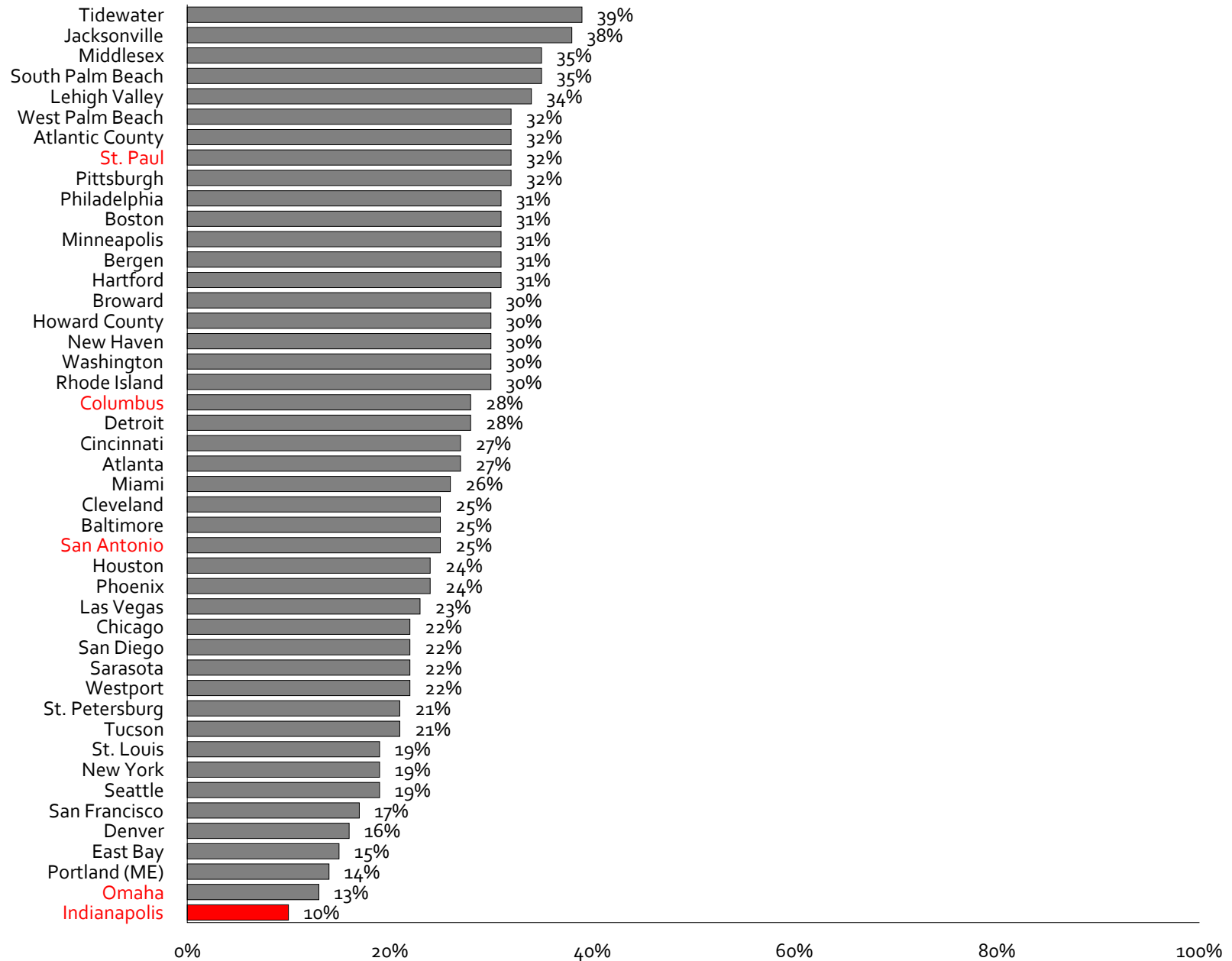

Attitude Comparisons with Pew 2013 US National Sample



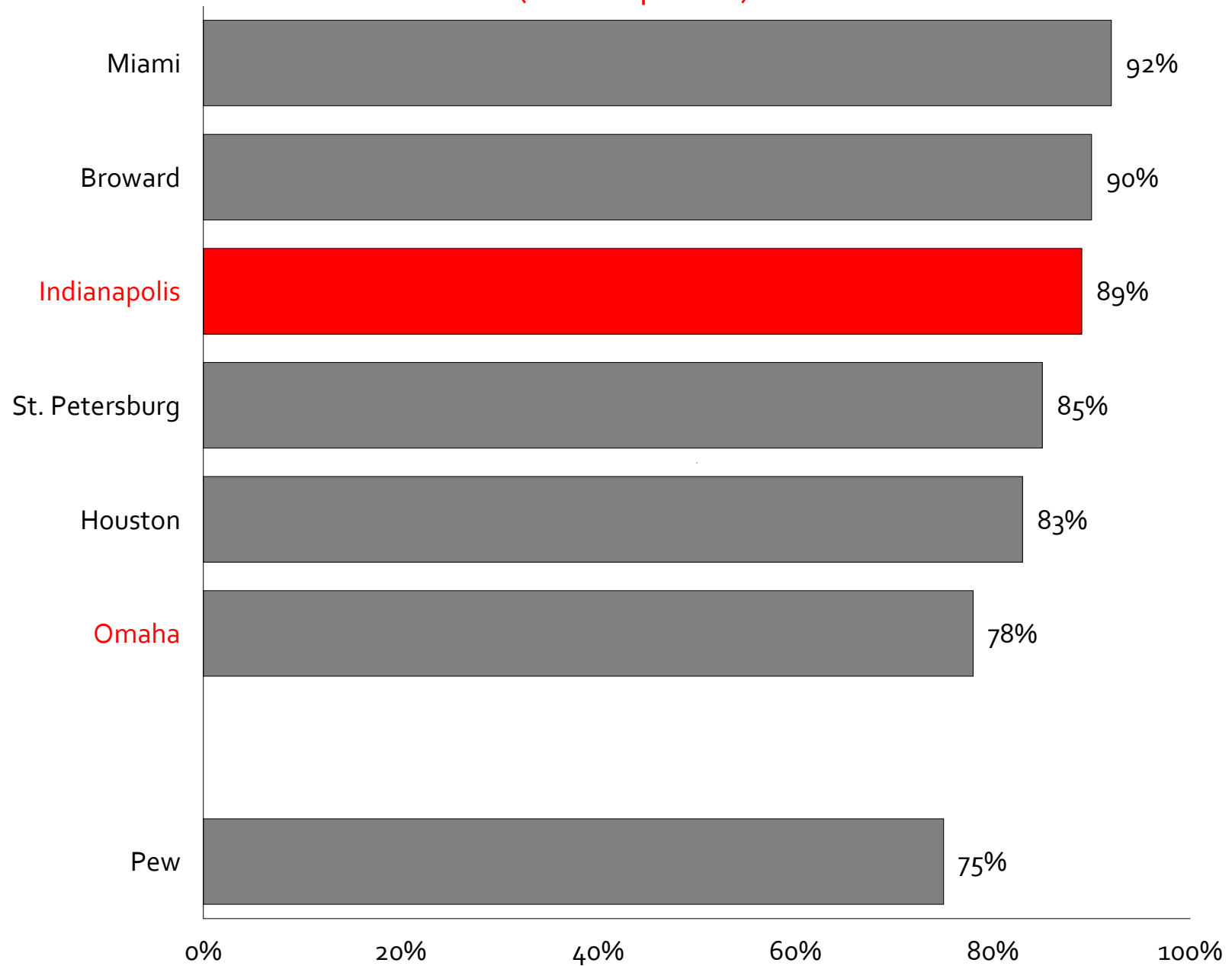

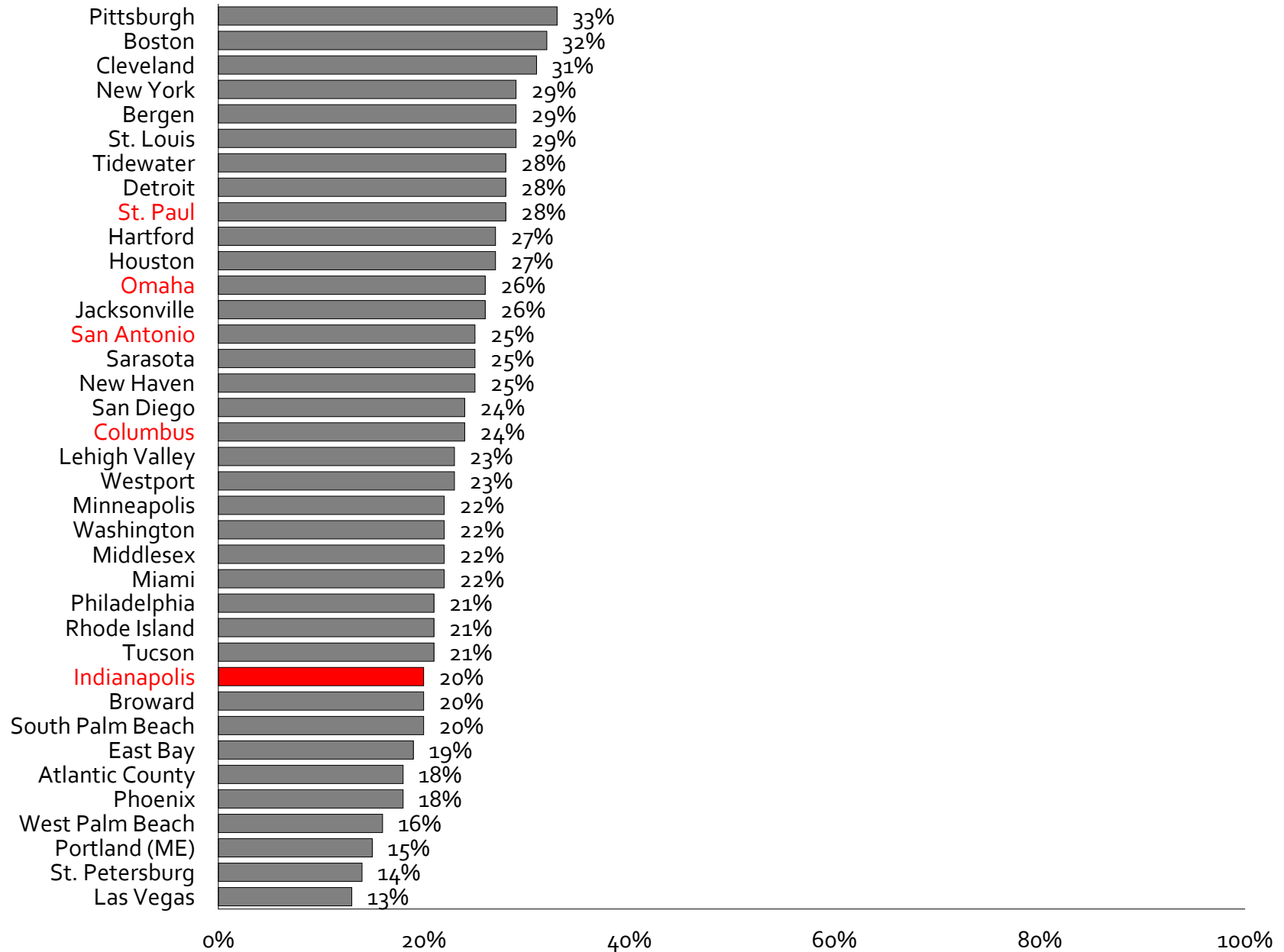

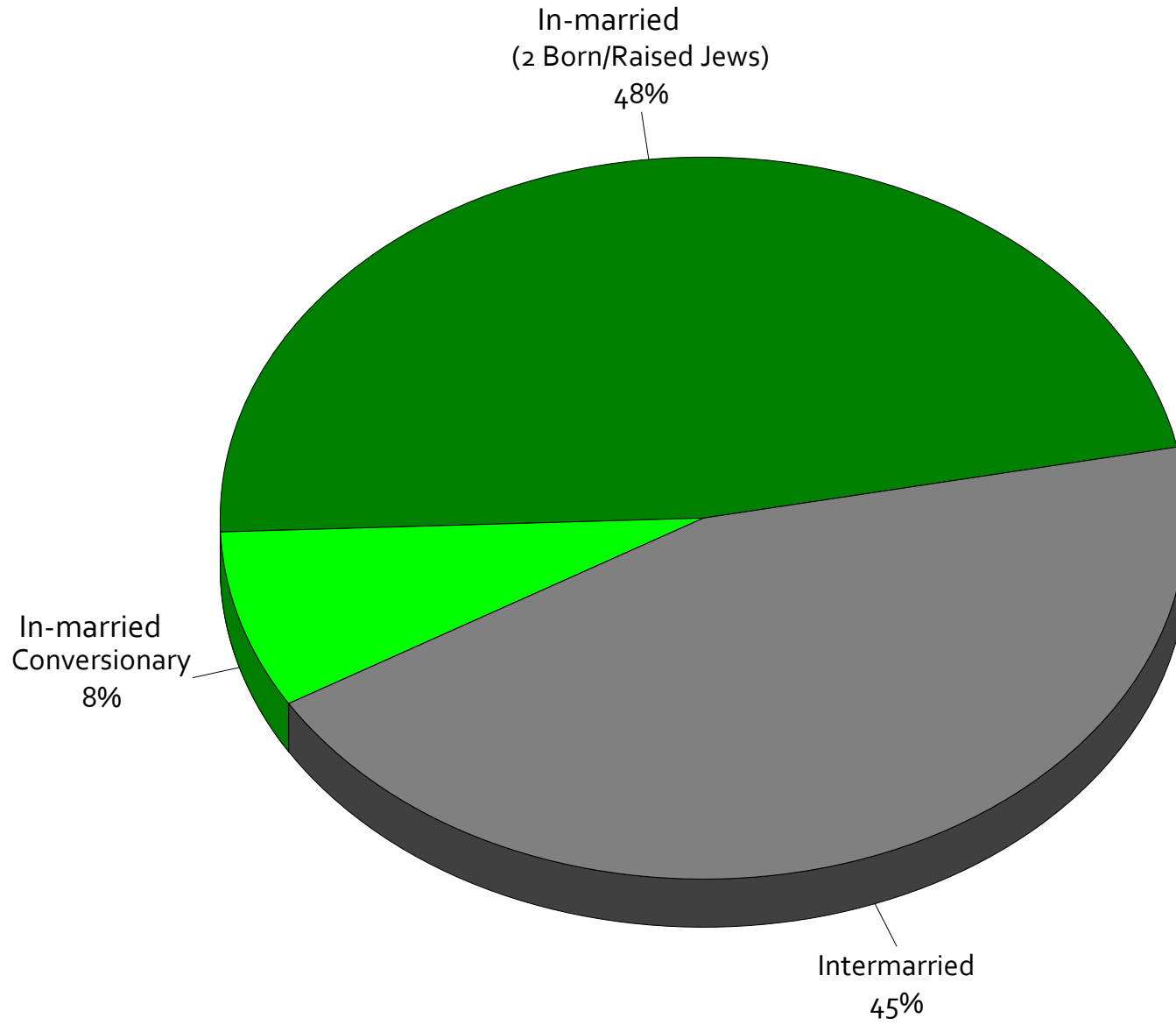

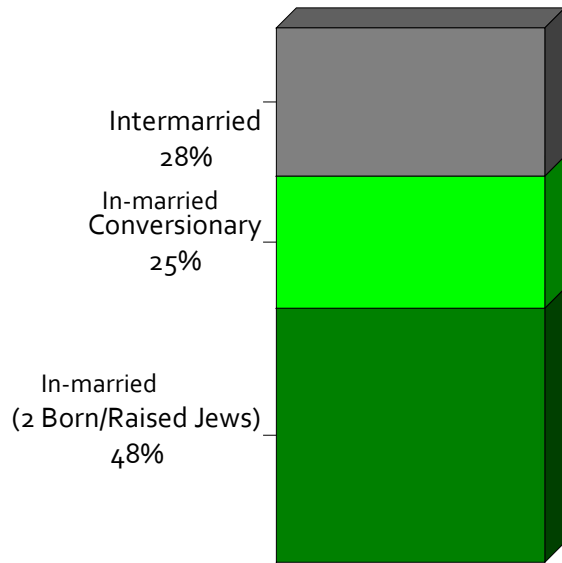

(Married Couples Age 65 and Over)

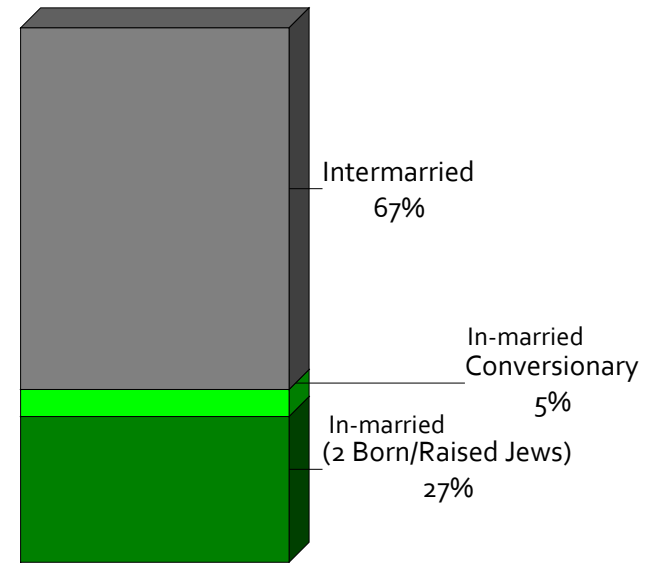

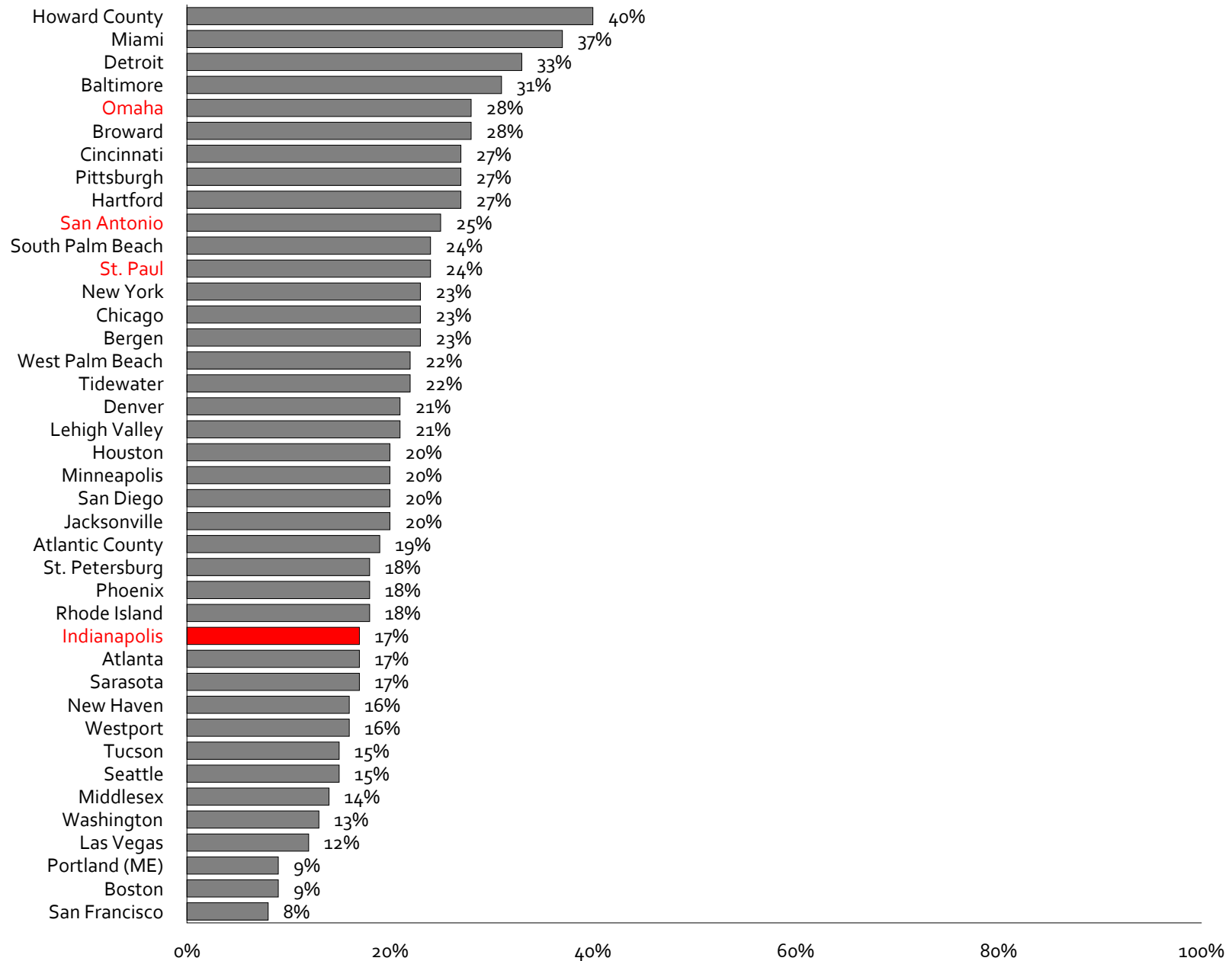

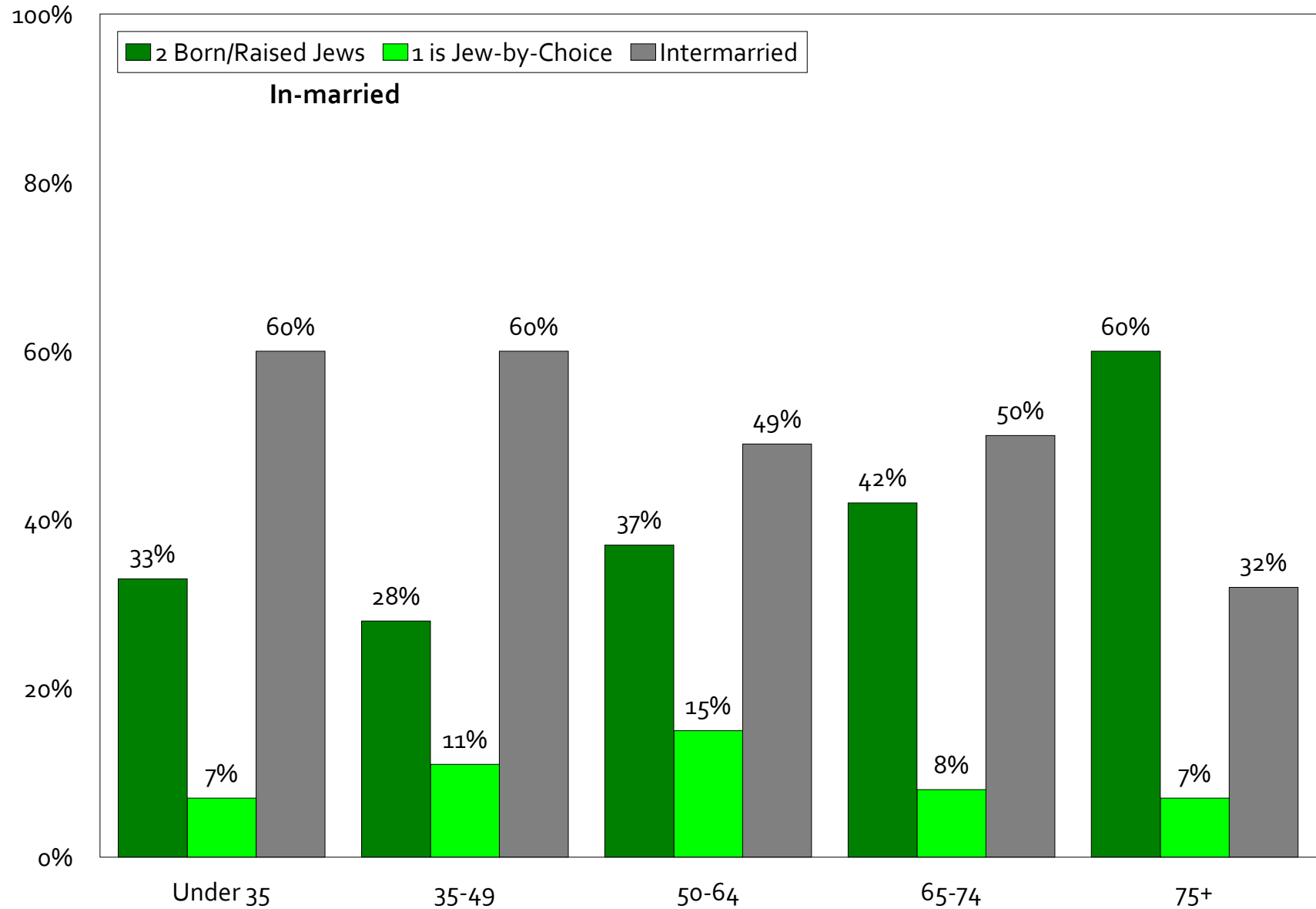

Types of Marriage by Age of Head of Household

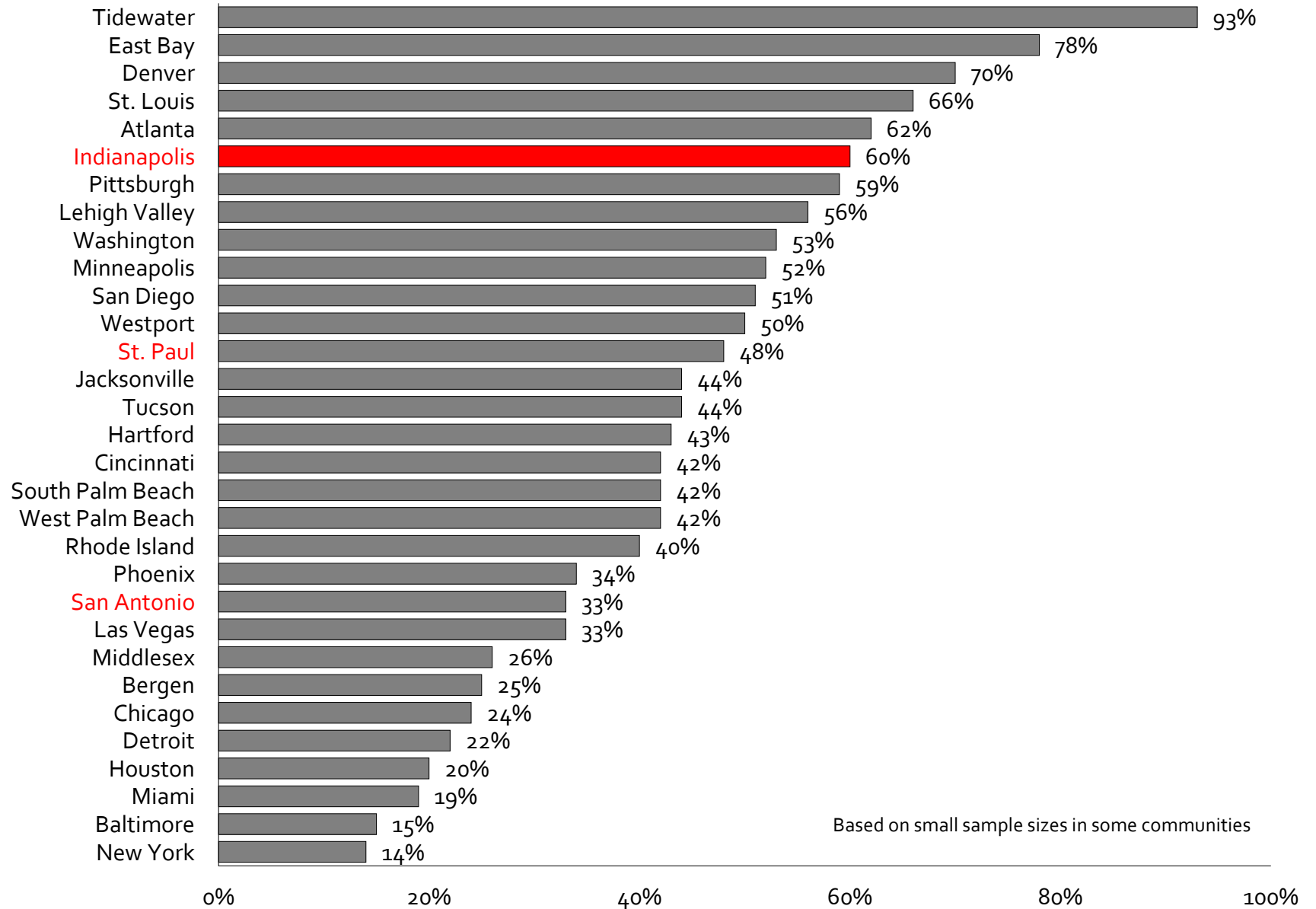

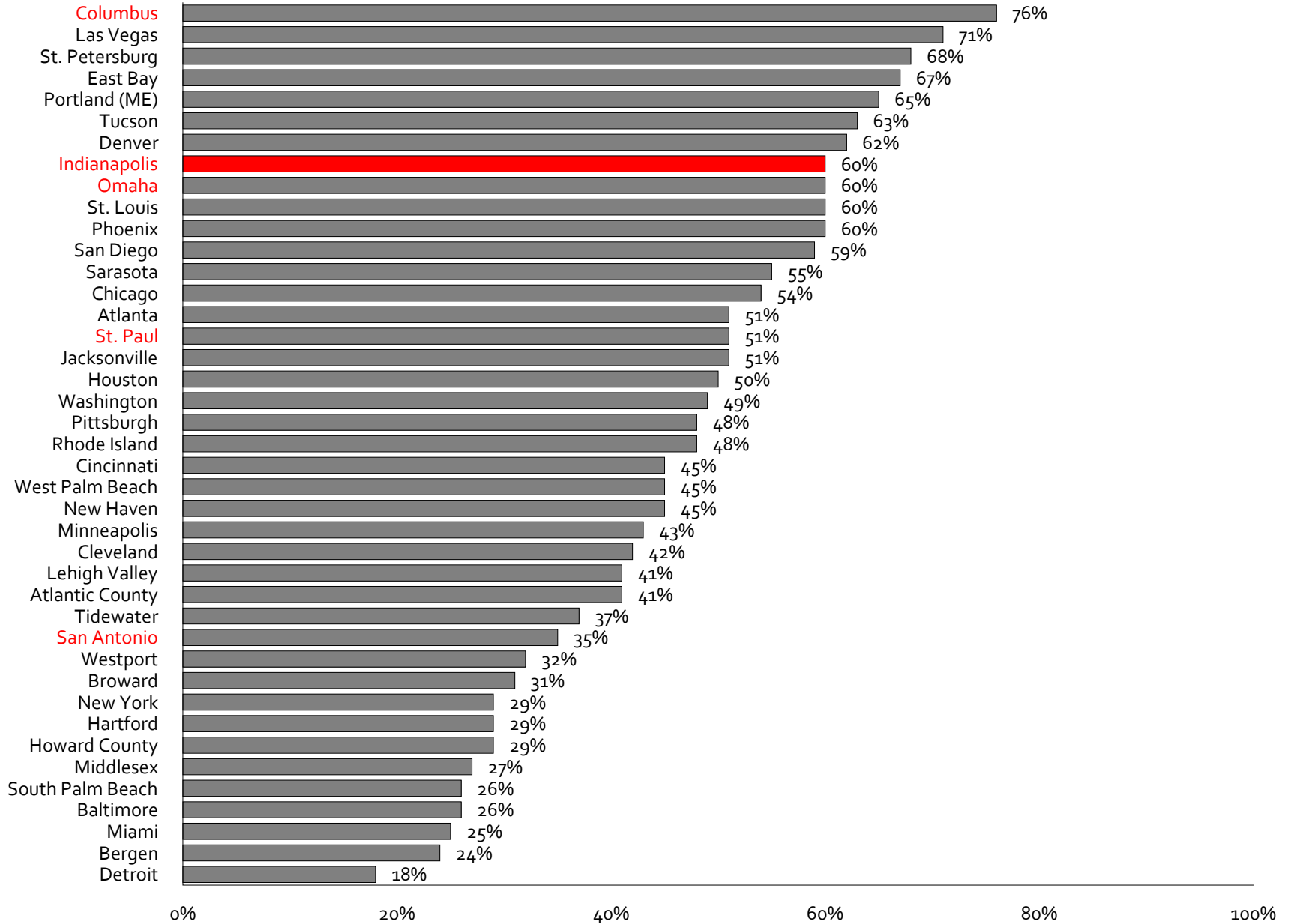

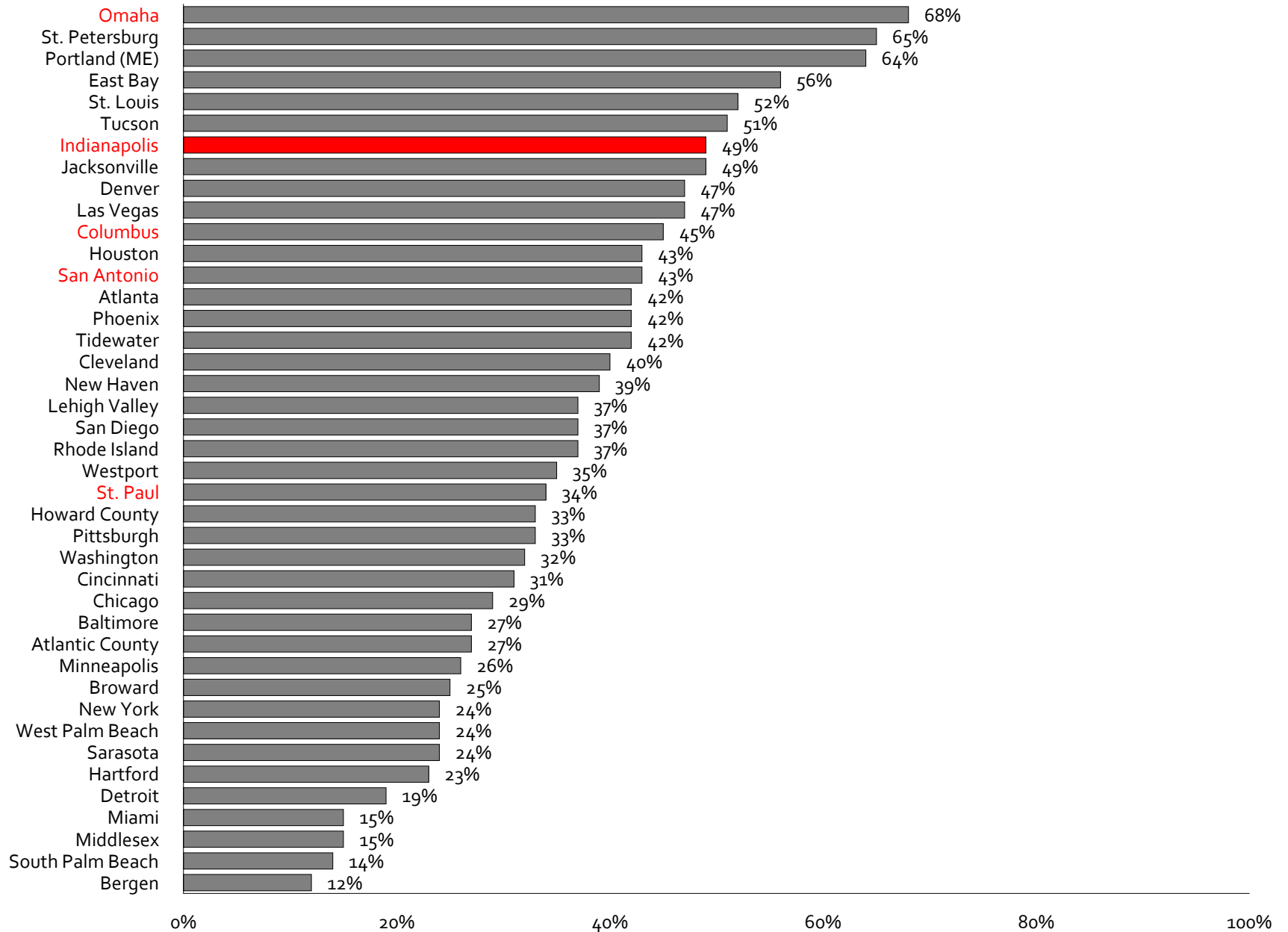

translates to

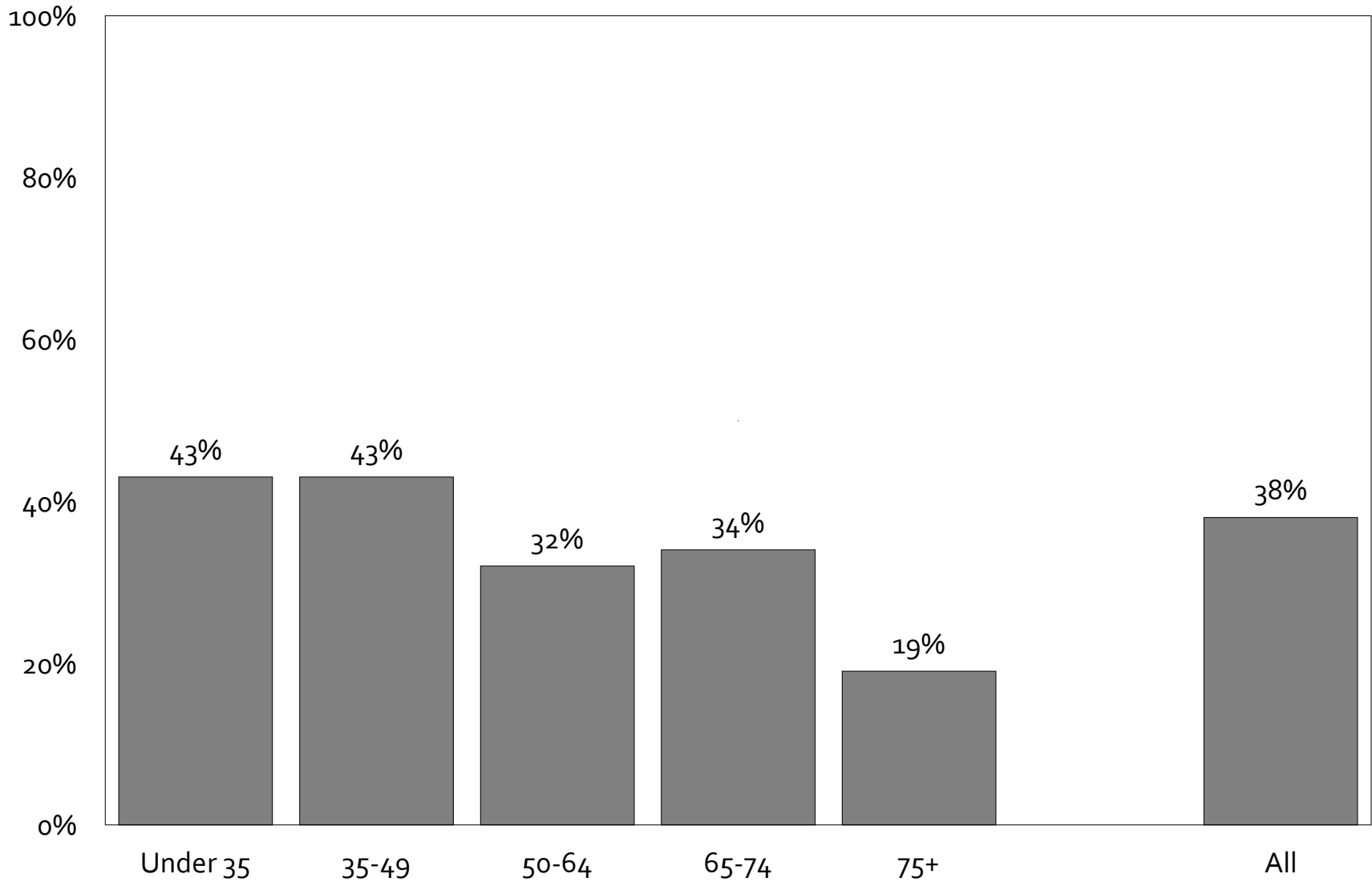
38% Individual Inter-marriage Rate

25% of all Jewish adults (both married and single) are inter-married

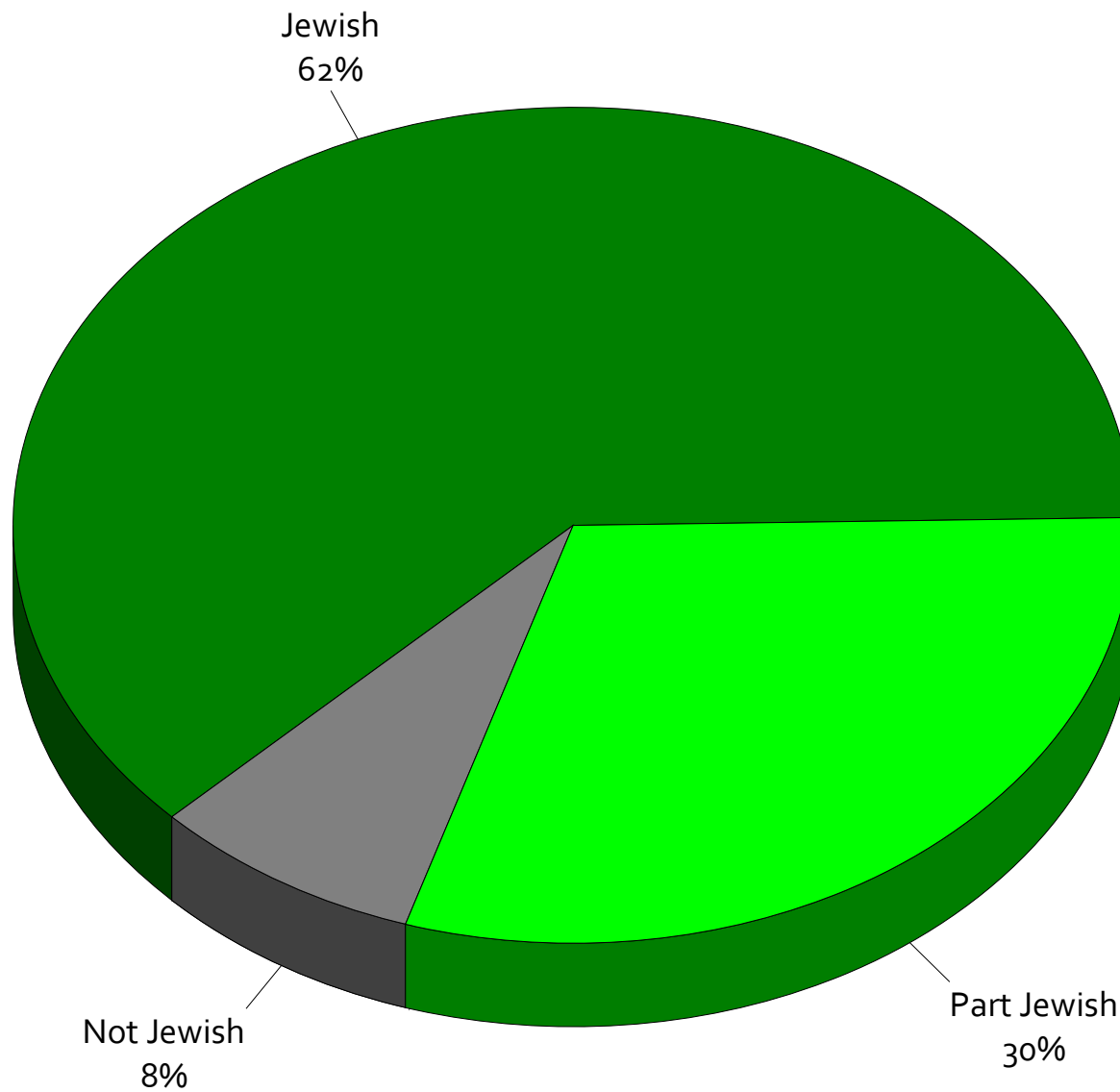

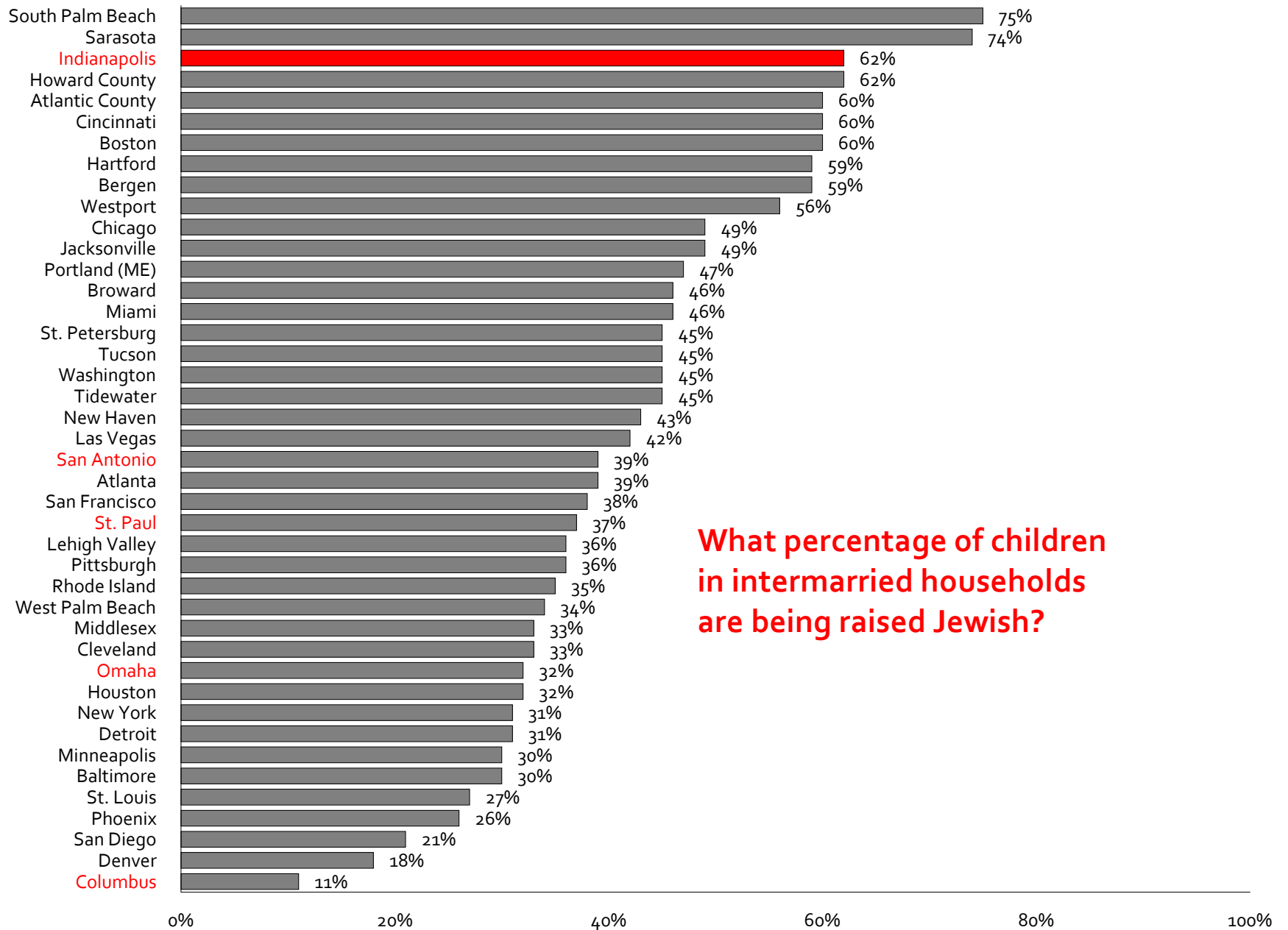
Current Religion of Children in Intermarried Households

Children Being Raised Jewish in Intermarried Households

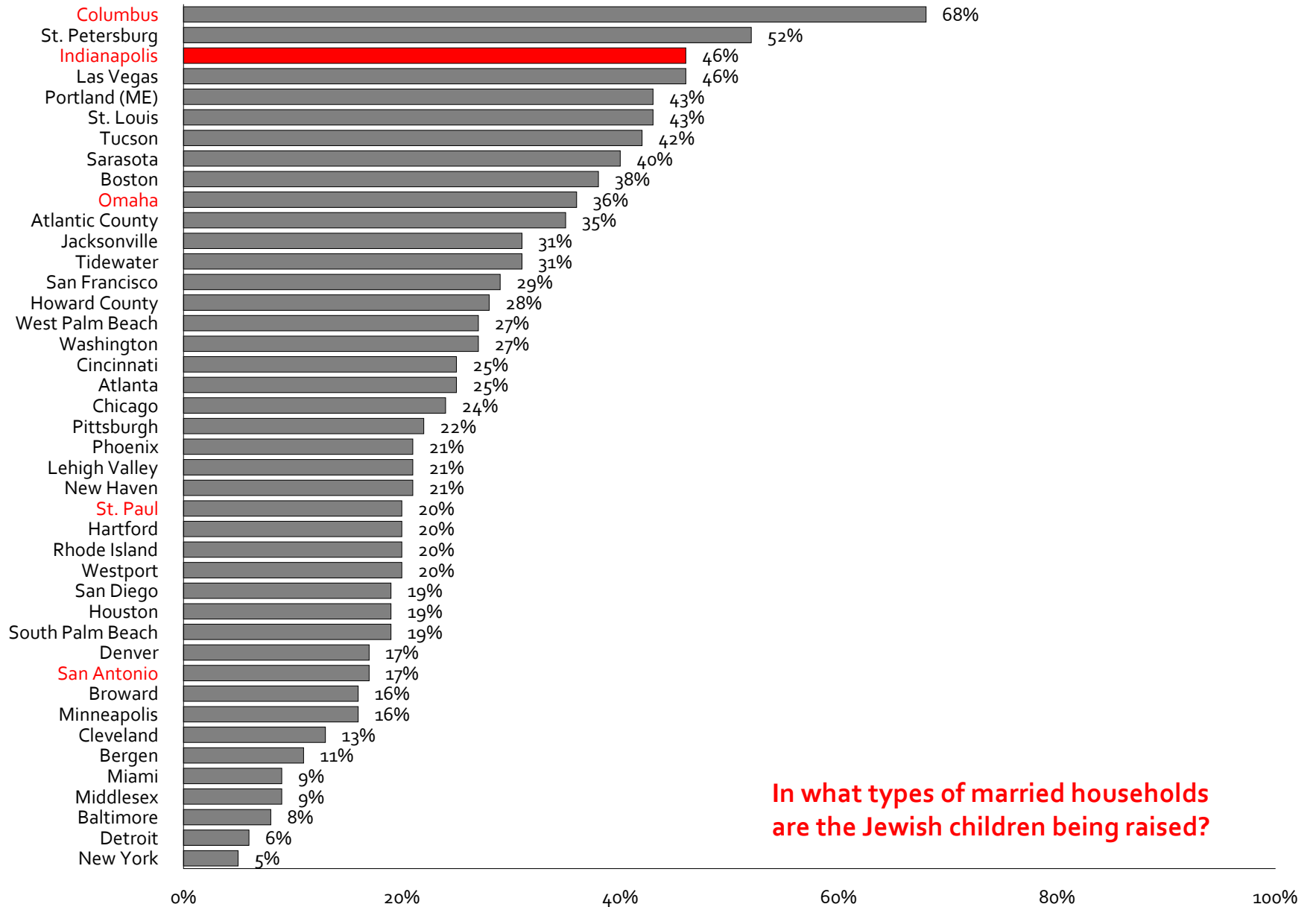

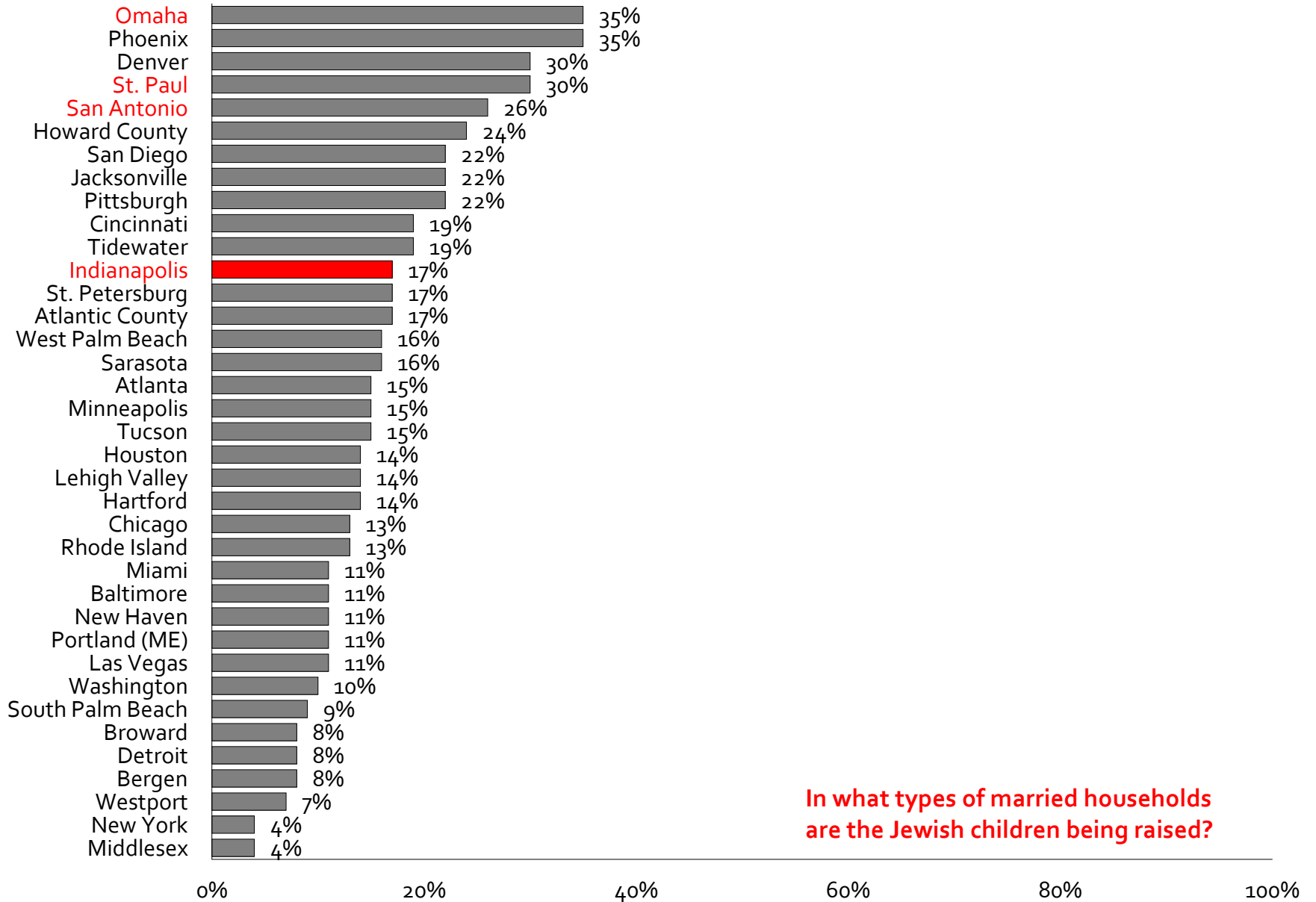

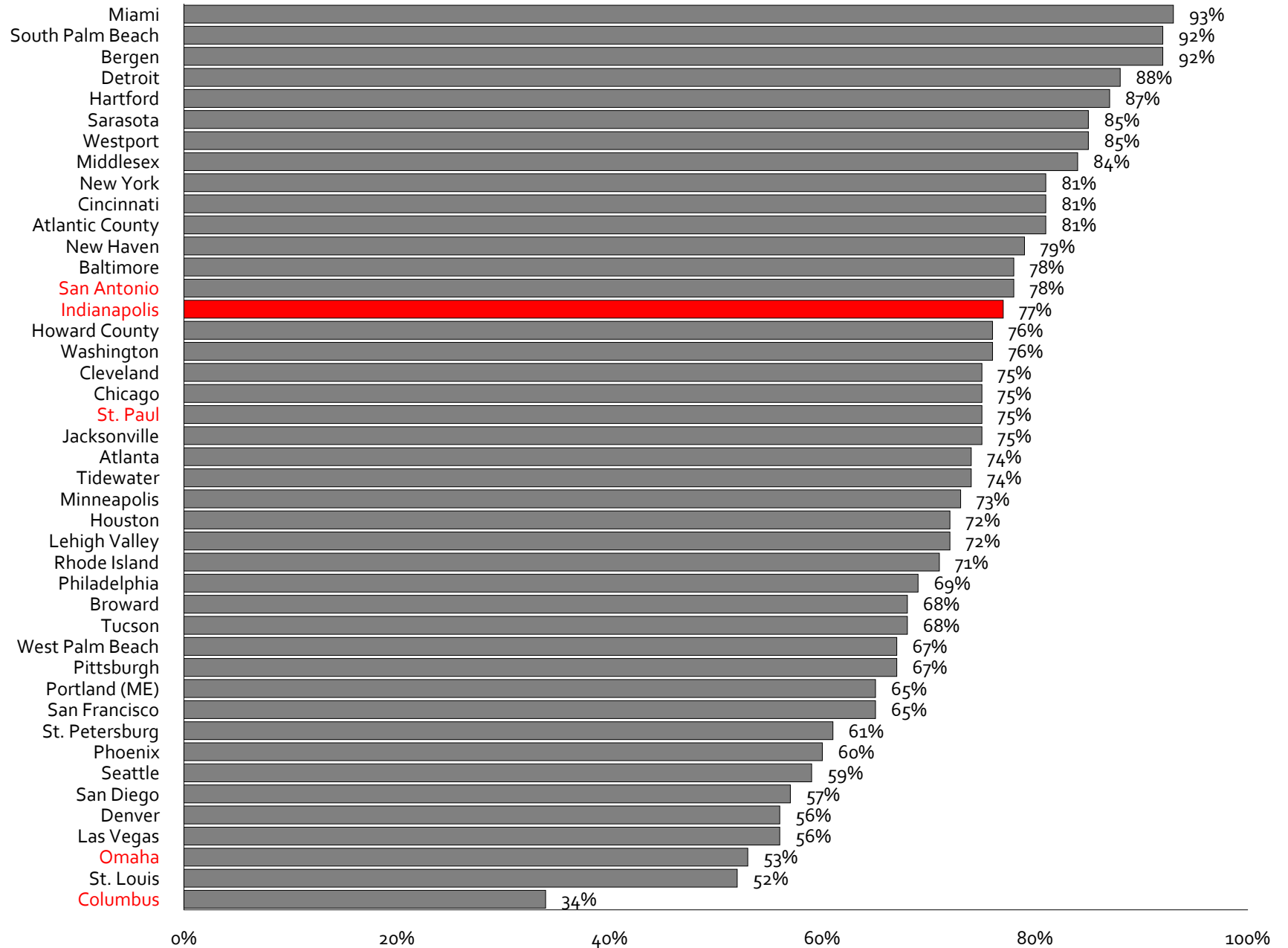

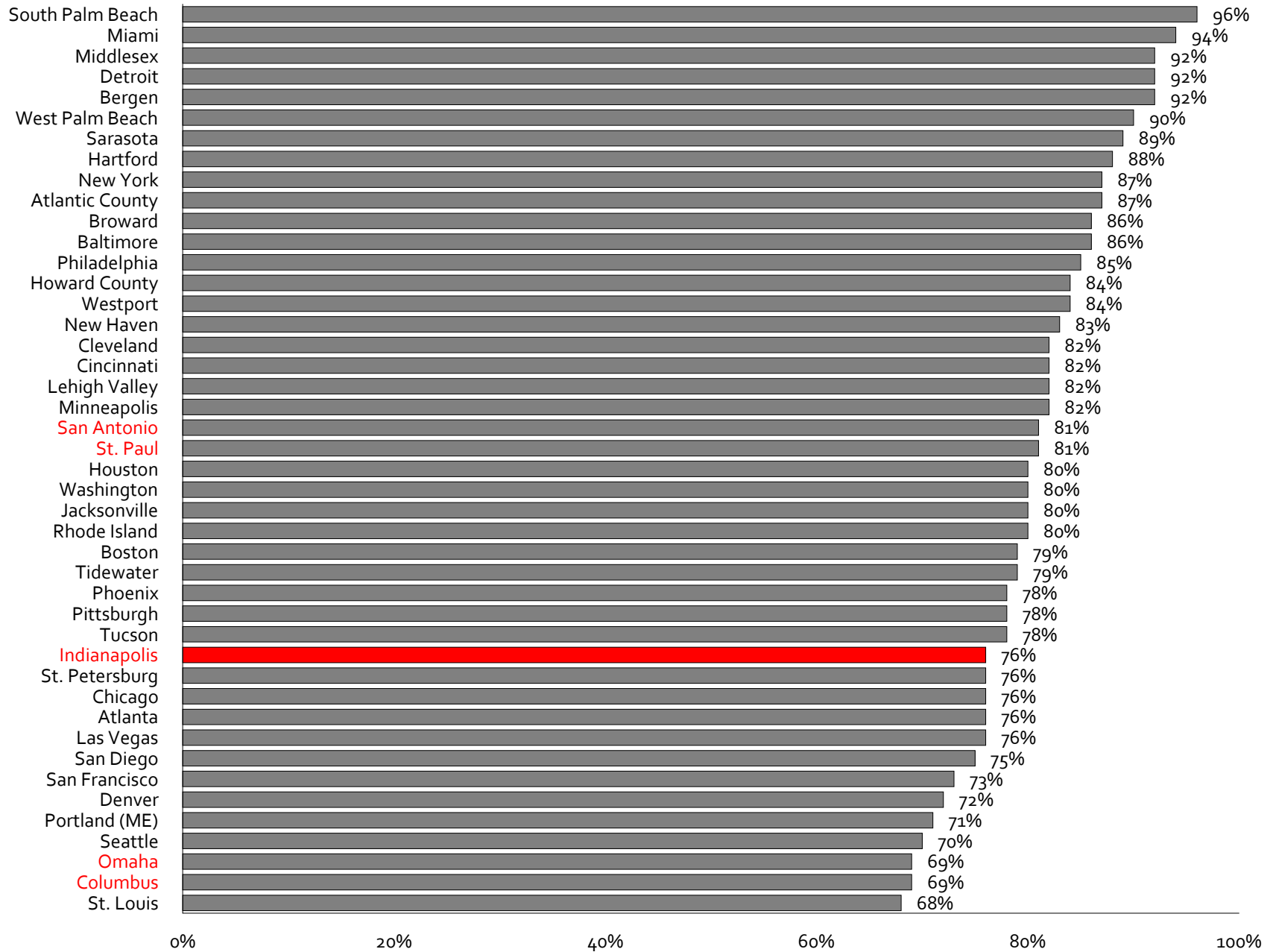
