Lion of Judah

The Lion of Judah giving level demonstrates a powerful commitment to tzedakah and community leadership. With a minimum annual gift of \$5,000 to the Federation's Annual Campaign, Lion of Judah donors join a global sisterhood of thousands of passionate, philanthropic Jewish women who are making a meaningful impact in their local communities and around the world. As a Lion, donors gain access to exclusive events, leadership development opportunities, and transformative missions to Israel and other global Jewish communities. Being a Lion of Judah is not just about giving—it's about shaping the future of Jewish life with strength, compassion, and enduring legacy.

Step-Up Lion

The Step-Up Lion program provides a pathway for women to become a Lion of Judah by gradually increasing their annual giving to the \$5,000 level over a three-year period. Step-Up participants immediately become part of the Lion sisterhood, gaining access to exclusive events, leadership opportunities, and global experiences—while building their philanthropic commitment over time.

Pomegranate Society

The Pomegranate Society celebrates the strength and generosity of women who make an annual gift of \$1,800 or more to the Federation's Annual Campaign.
