



# CJP ON THE NORTH SHORE

Combined Jewish Philanthropies, Greater Boston’s Jewish Federation, brings together the people, partners, and resources to fulfill the most important needs and aspirations of our community. We hope you’ll take advantage of these opportunities for the North Shore.

## JEWISH LEARNING AND ENGAGEMENT

### Families with Young Children

- **Parenting Through a Jewish Lens** brings parents together with expert facilitators to explore how Jewish values can strengthen family life.
- **Welcome Baby!** welcomes families into the Jewish community with a home visit, gift tote, and information about community resources like family-friendly programs, events, and activities.
- **PJ Library®** delivers free high-quality Jewish children’s books and music to homes every month.

### Youth and Teens

- **CJP’s Discover Day School** program provides tuition grants to middle-income families enrolling at schools like Cohen Hillel Academy for the first time.
- **One Happy Camper** provides \$1,000 grants to first-time Jewish overnight campers.
- **The North Shore Teen Initiative** connects Jewish teens to their peers and motivates participation in Jewish life after becoming bar or bat mitzvah.

### Adult

- **iEngage** features “Engaging Israel: Foundations for a New Relationship,” which is hosted by two local synagogues and is based on a curriculum from the Shalom Hartman Institute that explores the foundation of our relationship with Israel.
- **Me’ah** is an intensive Jewish education experience for adult learners of all backgrounds.
- **Open Circle Jewish Learning** offers rich and accessible Jewish learning experiences in small group settings facilitated by excellent educators.
- **Torah Hub** brings three local synagogues and the Chabad community together at the JCC for community learning about the greatest Jewish heroes.

### Other Opportunities

- **The Jewish Community Center of the North Shore** and **the North Suburban JCC** offer a wide range of programs with support from CJP. They provide Jewish cultural, family, and holiday events, support for campers and students with special needs, and Israel education.
- **InterfaithFamily** partners with CJP to provide welcoming programs and learning opportunities for interfaith couples and families.

## SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL

- The North Shore Planning Committee brings Israel-related discussion and activities to the North Shore, such as the **Hatikvah Officers Mission** that brings active duty IDF officers to our community each spring.
- **Strategic Israel Engagement** programs inform, engage, and empower the Greater Boston community in support of Israel. The **CommUNITY Israel Dialogue** enables productive conversations about Israel while **IAC** supports Jewish life and Israel advocacy on campus.

## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

- **The North Shore Planning Committee (NSPC)** works to strengthen Jewish life on the North Shore and fulfill CJP's mission. The NSPC also identifies, recruits, and engages individuals for volunteer and leadership involvement on the North Shore and beyond.
- **CJP's Anti-Poverty Initiative** works to understand and combat the root causes of poverty to help people move beyond crisis to achieve greater stability.
- **CJP Leadership Development Institute** offers support to synagogues and agencies for leadership and board development.
- **Inclusion** programs ensure that people of all abilities can live a life of meaning and purpose. CJP programs and partners include **Transitions to Work**, a national model for workplace inclusion, the **Ruderman Synagogue Inclusion Project**, and **Gateways: Access to Jewish Education**.
- **JewishBoston.com** is the online home of the Greater Boston Jewish community, housing community events including those on the North Shore, blogs, recipes, and more.

## CONNECTIONS

- **Professional Networks** like **Lawyers & Accountants**, **Healthcare**, **Financial Services**, and **Real Estate**, **Construction & Design**, bring colleagues from across the Greater Boston area together for networking and philanthropy.
- **Women's Philanthropy** sponsors acts of service, meaningful giving, and engaging events, including the North Shore signature event, **Choose to Connect**. With CJP, women harness their collective power to care for the most vulnerable populations, strengthen the Jewish community, inspire the next generation, and empower their families and friends to change the world.
- **Young Adults Initiative** brings together adults 22-45 to build a strong generation of engaged Jewish leaders through learning programs like **Eser** and social events like **North Shore on Tap**.
