

INTEREST-FREE LOANS FOR DAY SCHOOL FAMILIES



Families with students in the Jewish day school system can benefit from interest-free loans from UJA's partner, Jewish Free Loan Toronto (JFLT). JFLT offers Jewish School Loans of up to \$15,000 per family to assist with tuition costs for parents with children enrolled in a Jewish school in Ontario, from kindergarten to Grade 12. To make these loans more accessible, families enrolled in UJA-affiliated schools do not need guarantors or interviews to qualify for the loans. CHARITABLE RECEIPTS

Day school families, regardless of whether they access other affordability options, are eligible to receive a charitable receipt from their school for the religious studies portion of their tuition. This can significantly lower a family's out-of-pocket tuition cost.

We have included a worksheet in the back pocket of this booklet which can be used, with the help of your school's tuition office, to estimate the size of your charitable receipt and your out-of-pocket tuition cost. HOW TO APPLY

for Day School Scholarships



STEP 1

See if you qualify

Use the online Day School Scholarship calculator to see if you qualify and receive an estimate of how much you can expect to pay in tuition fees for the upcoming school year. The calculator can be used to estimate your family's eligibility for all Day School Scholarships, including Tuition Assistance and the Generations Trust Scholarship. STEP 2

Connect with your school

Connect with the day school of your choice to receive further information regarding your eligibility and to learn more about the application process. It's important to ensure your child is registered with your school before you apply for a Scholarship.

STEP 3

Apply for a Scholarship

Use the simplified UJA Community Scholarships portal, which will guide you to the Day School Scholarship application that's right for your family. You can access the portal at ujacommunityscholarships.ca.
