Being Jewish with Jonah Platt



The Times of Israel Daily Briefing

For a clear and concise daily update, this is an indispensable resource. In just 15-20 minutes, the podcast provides a rundown of the day's most significant news from Israel and the Jewish world. It's an excellent way to stay informed on the key issues, political developments, and security matters that are part of the daily conversation in Israel.

Israel Story

Dubbed the Israel "This American Life," *Israel Story* shares deeply personal, beautifully produced narratives that capture the diversity and complexity of Israeli society. Post–October 7, their *Wartime Diaries* series highlights intimate stories of resilience and loss, giving listeners a profoundly human window into Israeli life.

For Heaven's Sake

Hosted by scholars Donniel Hartman and Yossi Klein Halevi of the Shalom Hartman Institute, this podcast explores Israel's toughest moral, religious, and political dilemmas. Their conversations model respectful debate and thoughtful analysis of Israel's challenges in real time.

Identity/Crisis

Another Shalom Hartman Institute production, hosted by Yehuda Kurtzer, this podcast examines Jewish identity in the modern world. It explores topics from antisemitism to continuity, connecting the American Jewish experience with global Jewish life.

State of a Nation with Eylon Levy

Known globally as Israel's former wartime spokesman, Levy now takes listeners behind the podium. Blending eloquence with sharp analysis, he interviews policymakers, thinkers, and journalists, unpacking the stories behind the headlines.

Two Nice Jewish Boys

Launched in 2016, this is Israel's longest-running English-language podcast. Hosts Naor Meningher and Eytan Weinstein offer lively weekly conversations on Israeli life, politics, and culture, often featuring high-profile guests—from politicians to artists to Nobel laureates.

Unapologetic - The Third Narrative

Palestinian Israelis Ibrahim Abu Ahmad and Amira Mohammed bring an honest, grassroots perspective to conversations often reduced to geopolitics. In English and aimed at Jewish and international audiences, their candid dialogue explores identity, coexistence, and what peace could look like.

Unholy: Two Jews on the News

Israel's top anchor Yonit Levi and British journalist Jonathan Freedland unpack the week's events from Israeli and Diaspora perspectives. With honesty, humour, and insightful guests, they model the kind of cross-Atlantic Jewish conversation that is rare and vital.
