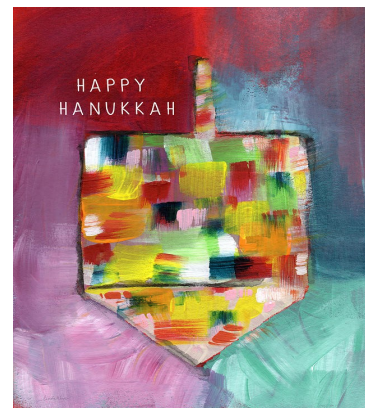

A Message From Wendy Cedar, Executive Director

What a wonderful, supportive Jewish community we live in! Members of our community have donated over \$20,000 directly to the Israel Fund to help support Israelis during this terrible war. AND, so many people have made additional donations locally, which not only supports Jewish life and fights antisemitism in Orange County, but further supports the work of our international partners who help Jews in Israel and around the world. We are so grateful for your generosity that helps us fulfill our mission.



Part of that mission is to support Jewish life in the county. Last month, we were able to do that with the help of clergy from 5 of our partner organization, who coordinated a beautiful, shared erev Shabbat service and kosher dinner at Temple Sinai in Middletown. While we weren't able to take photos during the wonderful event, we had over 100 people in attendance, and the communal joy and comfort were palpable!

We also had about 60 people, including about 14 young children, participate in a Choose Your Own Adventure Shabbat sponsored by the Newburgh JCC, with help from a grant from PJ Library. 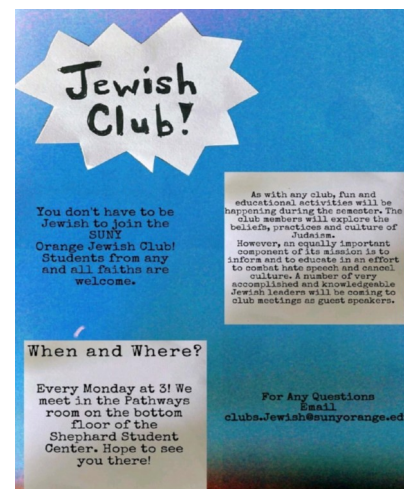

Close to 300,000 people gathered at the National Mall in Washington, DC on Tuesday, November 14th. With a quarter-million viewers watching via live-stream and worldwide media. Some of our community shared their photos with us below (Abbe Distelburger, Dr. Leslie Geen & Dr. Steve Rubinsky).

Abbe Distelburger was able to attend the March and here is what she shared:

"The March for Israel was such an amazing and uplifting experience. It's been so hard to watch the news and read the papers in the aftermath of the most horrific day in Jewish History, October 7th, as I feel that most of the world has turned against us and has become increasingly anti-Israel. To feel the love and bipartisan support that day by members of Congress, to hear the strong messages of Never Again, to hear the messages that we as Jews will never give up, and of course, to hear the most impassioned pleas from family members of the hostages, was just so powerful. For the first time, I didn't feel that we, as a Jewish people, were alone in this fight against anti-Semitism or in our pro Israel stance against Hamas."



The Harold Levine Named Endowment Fund Program

The Harold Levine Endowment Program of the Jewish Federation of Greater Orange County currently has 61 Endowments with a principle of over \$4,500,000. These funds can be established with any amount of money. The interest is reinvested in the funds until they reach a corpus of \$5,000, at which time distributions can be made to named charities.

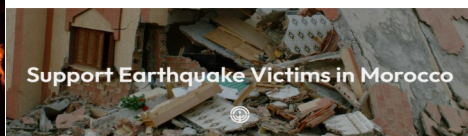
