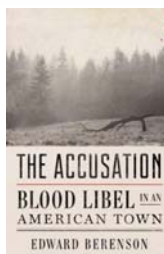

A chilling investigation of America’s only alleged case of blood libel, and what it reveals about antisemitism in the United States and Europe.

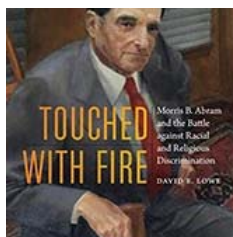
