The Federation System's Nationwide Efforts

Jewish Federations have been at the forefront of combating antisemitism in its many forms, from incidents in schools and on campuses to discriminatory practices in workplaces and public spaces. This includes everything from swastikas on school lockers and attempts to introduce biased curricula in grade schools to the rise of antisemitic chants and exclusionary actions in cultural and civic settings. In response to these threats, Federations have worked closely with law enforcement and local leaders to address and mitigate the impact of antisemitism in communities across the country. Jewish Federations continue to amplify their presence in media through news articles, interviews, and op-eds to educate the public and combat antisemitic narratives.

In specific sectors, Jewish Federation lay leaders have spearheaded focused efforts to combat antisemitism in healthcare spaces, confronting harassment and discrimination against Jewish medical professionals. On college campuses, Federations collaborate with university administrations and Jewish student organizations like Hillel to ensure swift responses to incidents and the safety of Jewish students. Federations also help promote a more inclusive environment through faculty and administrator training programs. Jewish Federations of North America delivers actionable resources, high-level guidance, and customized strategies to help communities respond to crises in real time and proactively strengthen community relations across all sectors of society.
