

Photo Release Guidance (Last Updated 3/19/2018):

As we finalize details for the launch of our resource site, we would like to begin collecting photos from the events and programs you are running. We have created a template (JotForm) for your use to assist in uploading photos and accompanying JFNA photo releases (we require our legal release signed by each individual in each photo in order to consider reproducing it on our site or in other materials):

Please complete a form for each JFNA-funded project/event for which you are submitting photos (e.g. if your agency had a theater excursion, a live music concert, and a coffee socialization hour, you would complete three forms). This will allow JFNA to organize and use the photos from each innovative project appropriately. Do not upload any photos lacking signed releases, as JFNA will not be able to use them.

Please note, you cannot save your progress on an individual online form and return to it later, so be sure to enter all information for a form in one sitting.

Photos you submit from JFNA-funded events may be used to demonstrate successful innovations in providing Person-Centered, Trauma-Informed supportive services to Holocaust Survivors, update the Federal Government on our progress, and make a case for future funding of the grant. We are excited to see the results of your hard work!
