




Age Distribution-All Americans - 2012




Median Age is 37 Years 13% are Age 65 and Over 6% are Age 75 and Over

Age Distribution-Houston - 2016



Changes in Age of Children Over Time






Age Distribution by Geographic Area






Where Do the Children Live?

Age 0-17 (10,200 Children in Jewish Households)






25 Age Distribution by Synagogue Membership




Age Distribution by Chabad Attendance




Age Distribution by JCC Membership (Persons in Jewish Households)






Single Parent Households with Children Age 0-17 at Home






Household Structure by Jewish Identification

Percentage of Children Age 0-12 Living in Households with Full-Time Working Parents







What Percentage of Persons Age 65 and Over Live Alone?


Persons Age 65 and Over Who Live Alone




Persons Age 75 and Over Who Live Alone


Current Marital Status by Age (Adults in Jewish Households)


Level of Secular Education

(Adults Age 25 and Over in Jewish Households)




Level of Secular Education

(Adults Age 65 and Over in Jewish Households)






Unemployment Rate






Elderly Persons Employed Full or Part Time






Elderly Persons Employed Part Time






Household Income Cooperation Rate

(Jewish Households)




Median Household Income

(Adjusted for inflation to 2015 dollars) (Jewish Households)




Household Income of Households with Children

(In thousands)












Profile of Low Income Households

Households Living Below the Federal Poverty Levels




Households with Elderly Persons Living Below the Federal Poverty Levels







(Jewish Respondents)




Household Financial Situation
