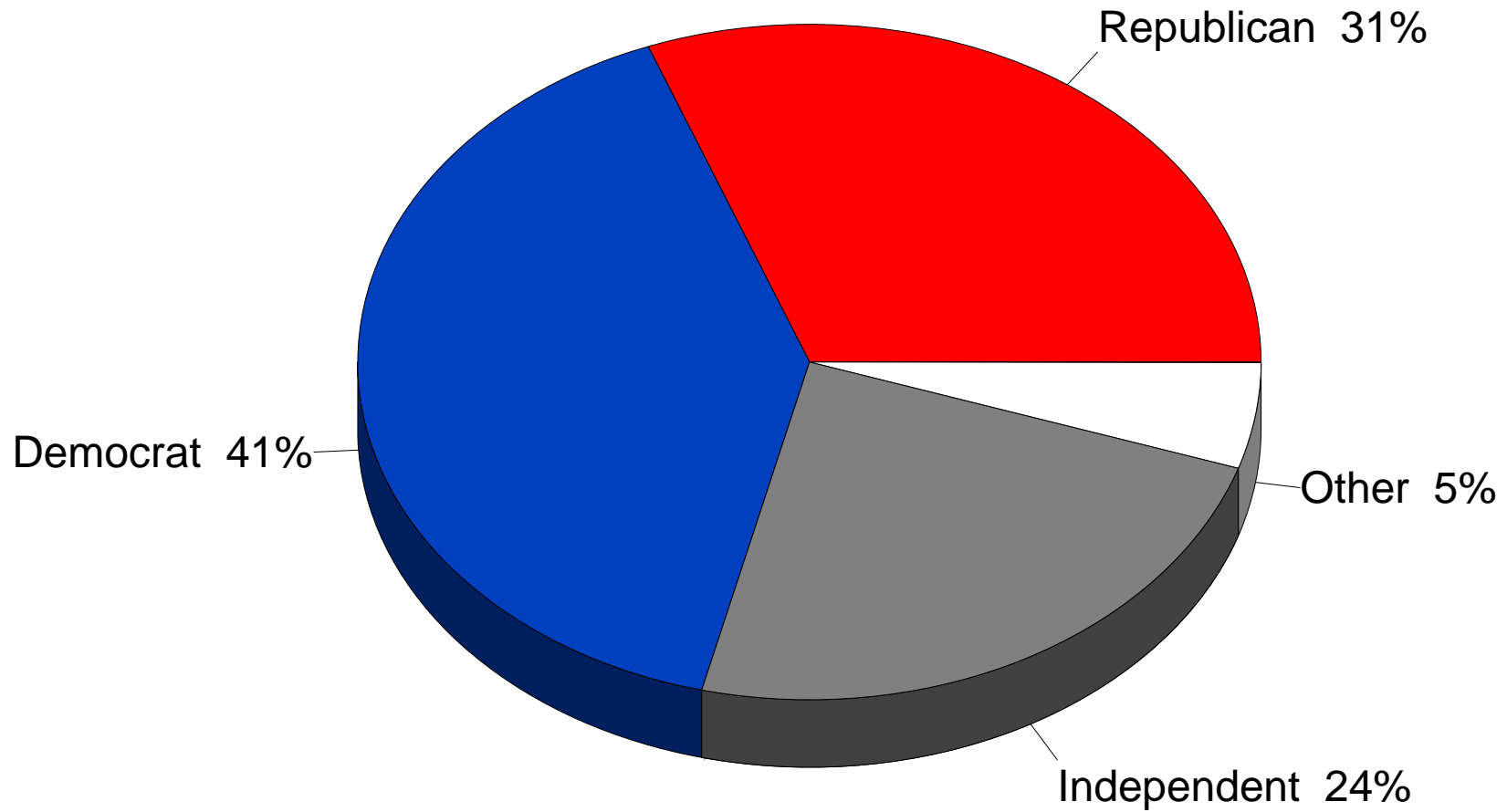

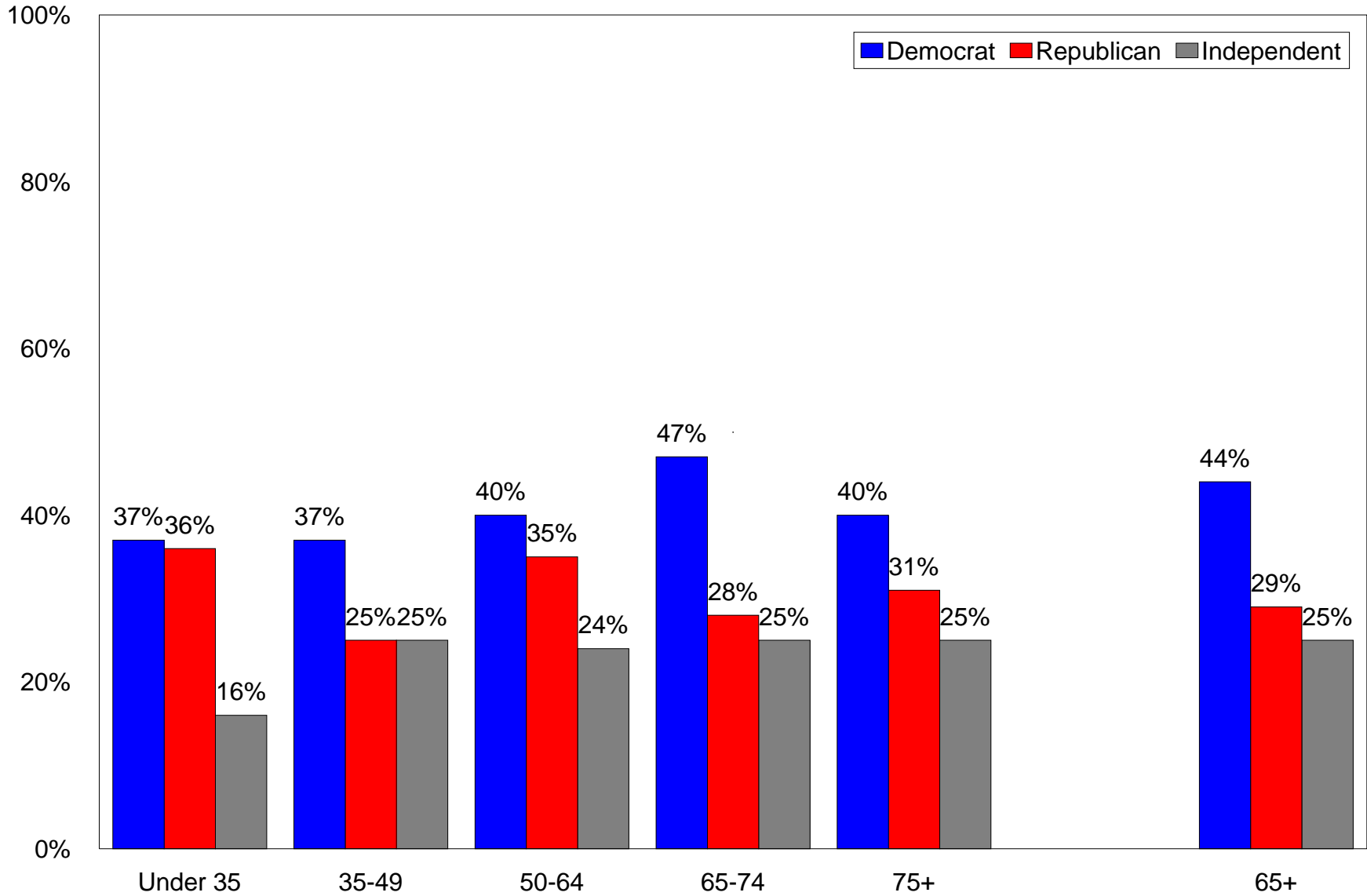

# Political Party by Age

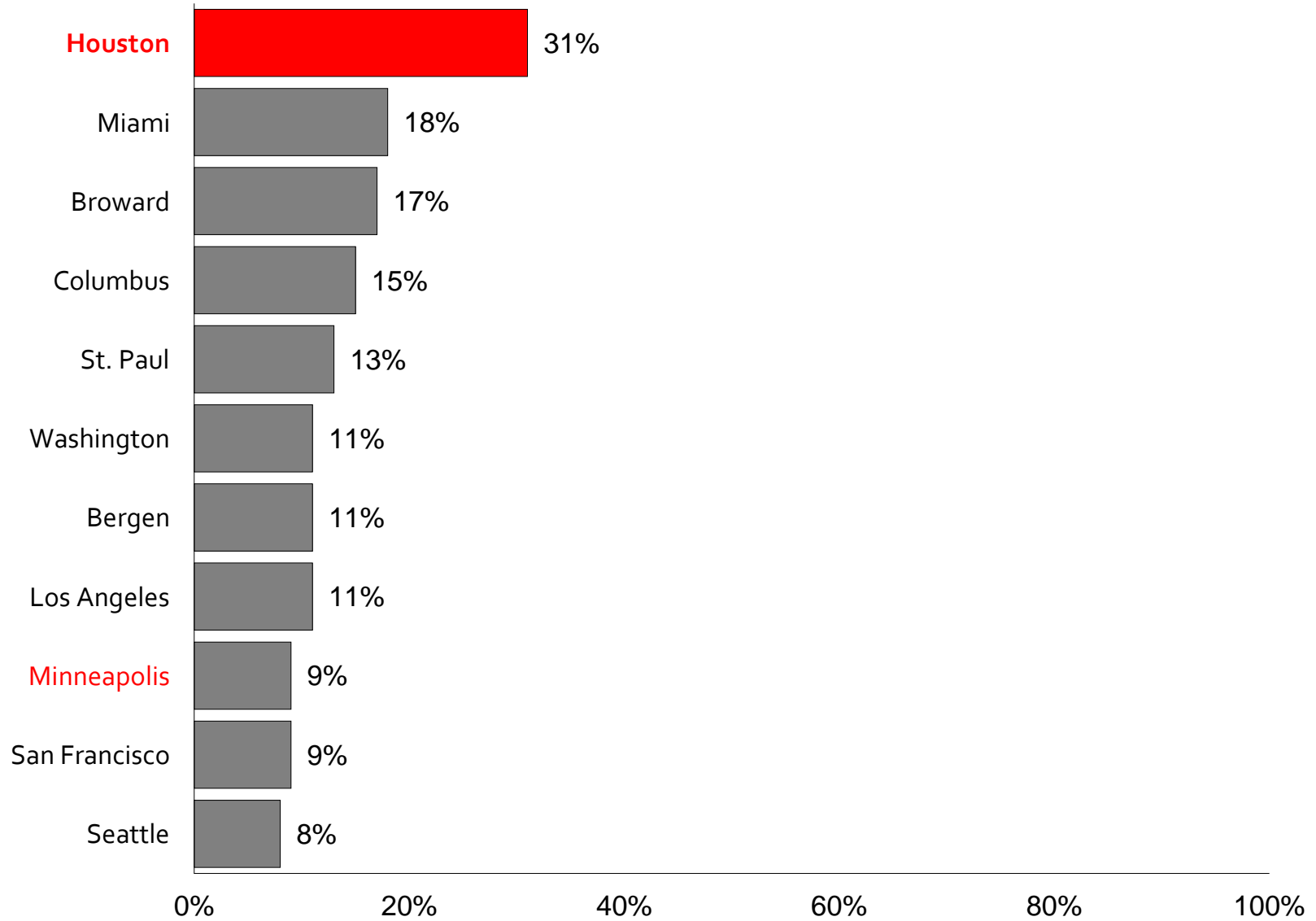

# Percentage Republican

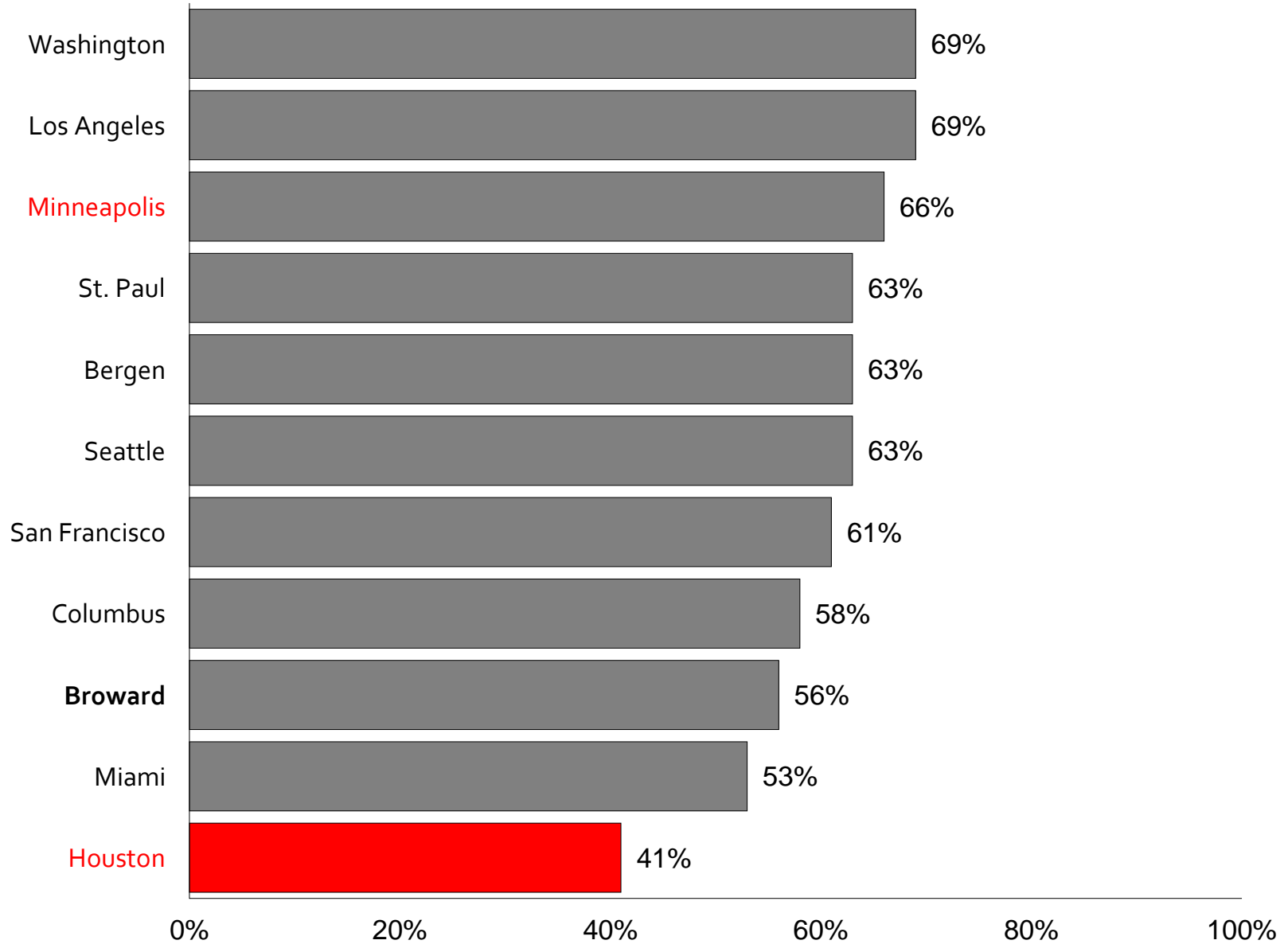

# Percentage Democrat

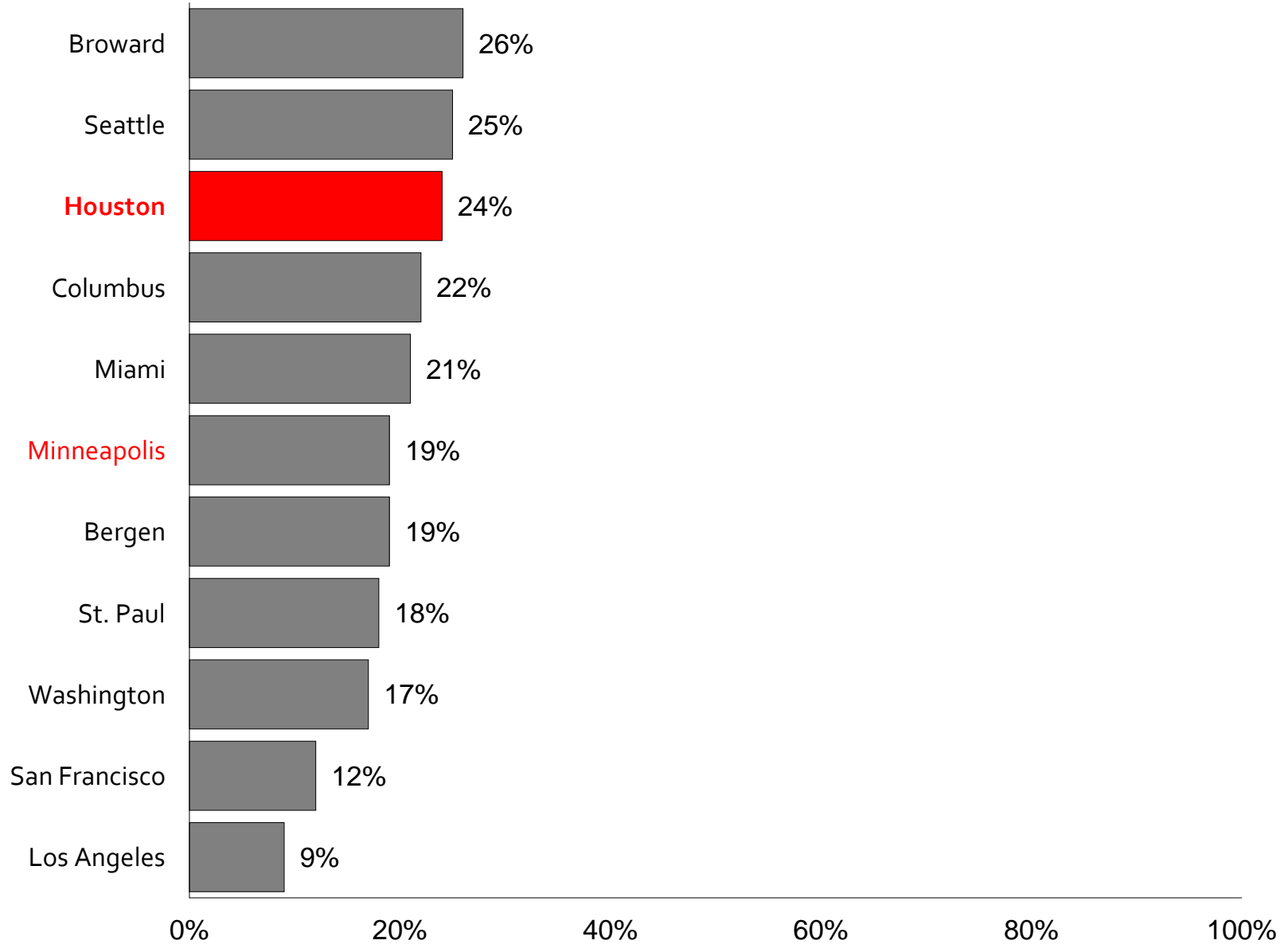

## Profile of Republicans

- 29% live in the Core Area; 18%, in the North; 15% in the Central city; and 13%, in Suburban SW
- 73% have lived in Houston for 20 or more years
- 13% are under age 35; 17% are age 35-49; 37% are age 50-64; and 33% are age 65 and over
- 63% are male
- 21% are households with children; 16% are elderly couple households
- 58% earn an annual household income of \$100,000 and over; 30%, \$200,000 and over
- 7% are Orthodox; 29%, Conservative; 30%, Reform; and 33%, Just Jewish
- 33% of married couples are intermarried
- 48% are synagogue members; 22% attended Chabad; 18% are JCC members; and 21%, Jewish Organization members
- 38% participated in a JCC program in the past year
- 57% contain an adult who visited Israel
- 29% are extremely attached to Israel; and 31% very attached
- 36% donated to the Jewish Federation in the past year
- 8% donated \$1,000 and over to the Jewish Federation in the past year

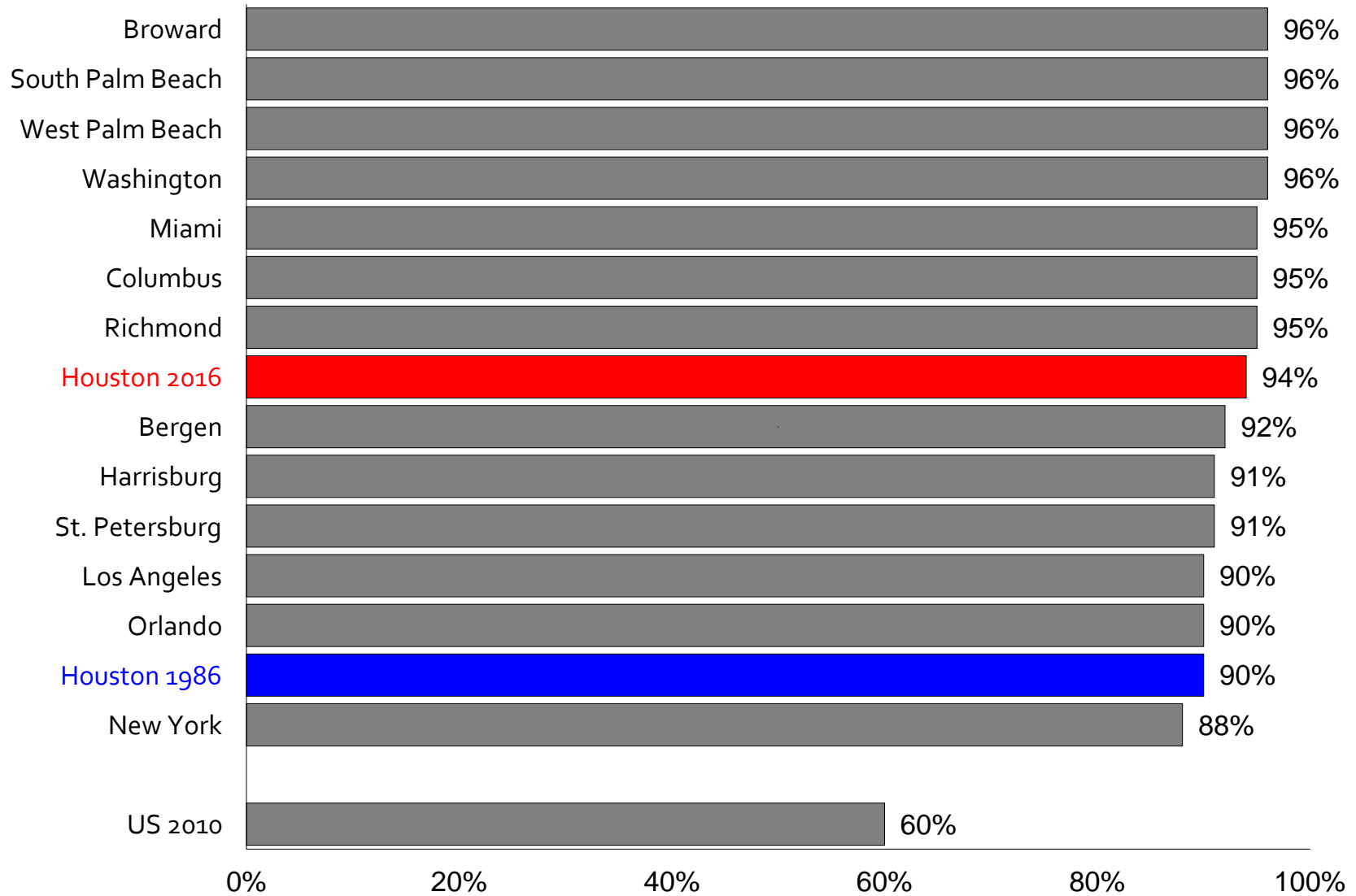


## Profile of Democrats

- 37% live in the Core Area; 16%, in the Central City; 14% in the North, and 13%, in Memorial
- 70% have lived in Houston for 20 or more years
- 10% are under age 35; 19% are age 35-49; 32% are age 50-64; and 39% are age 65 and over
- 46% are male
- 24% are households with children; 23% are elderly couple households
- 57% earn an annual household income of \$100,000 and over; 28%, \$200,000 and over
- 1% are Orthodox; 21%, Conservative; 48% Reform, and 29% Just Jewish
- 37% of married couples are intermarried
- 41% are synagogue members; 17% attended Chabad; 19% are JCC members; and 28%, Jewish organization members
- 48% participated in a JCC program in the past year
- 62% contain an adult who visited Israel
- 14% are extremely attached to Israel; and 26% very attached
- 42% donated to the Jewish Federation in the past year
- 9% donated \$1,000 and over to the Jewish Federation in the past year

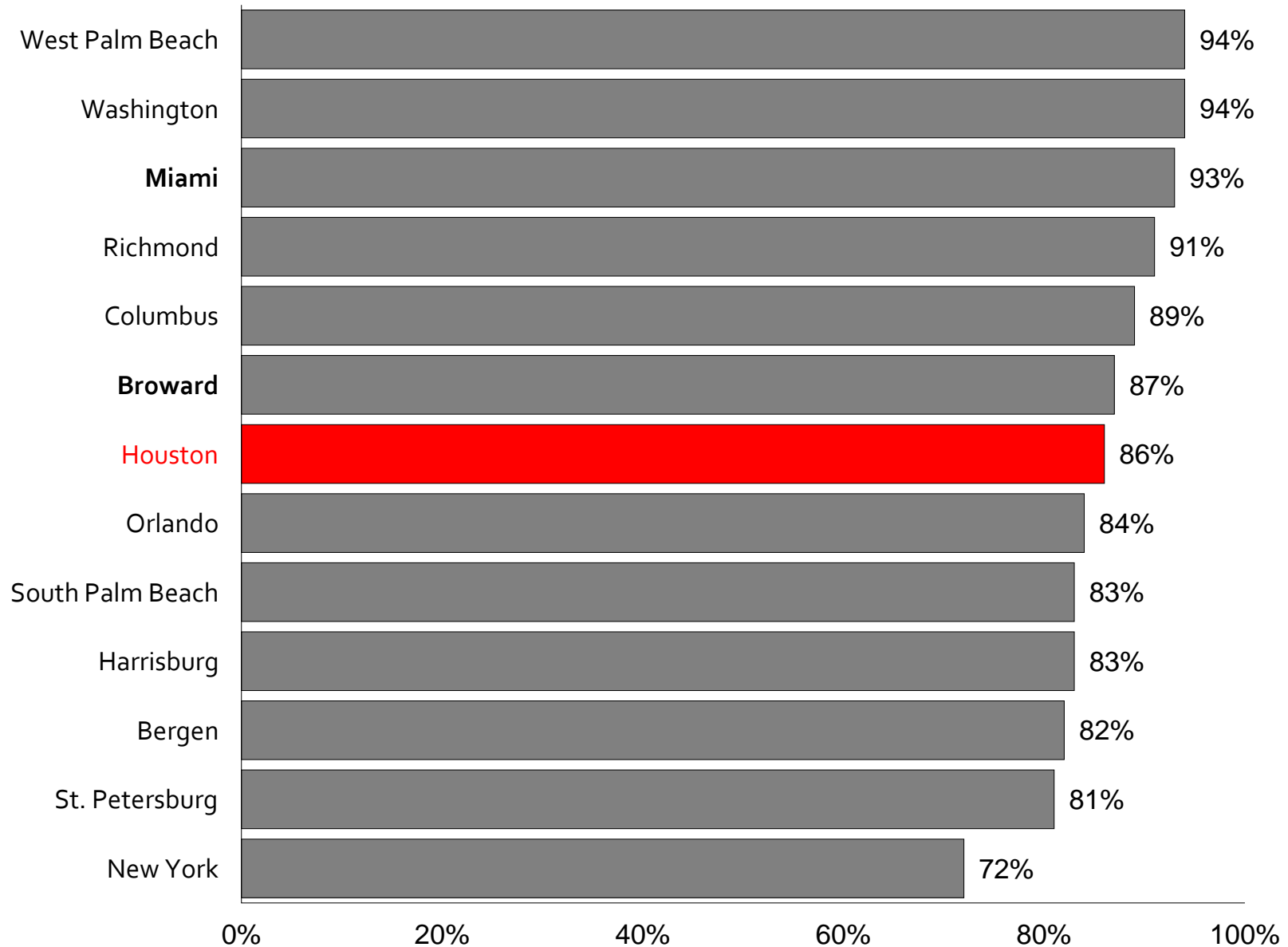

(Respondents)



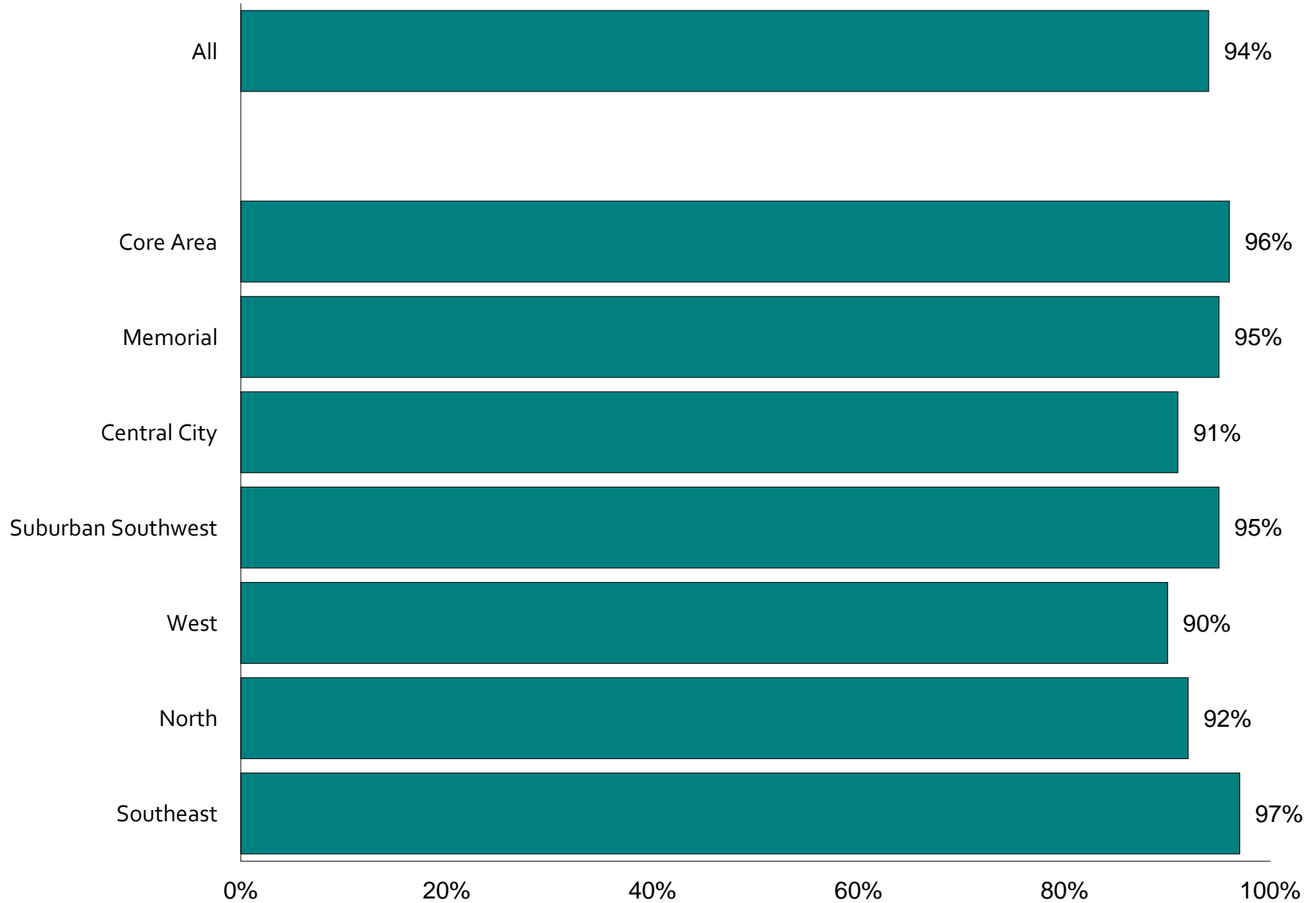
# Registered to Vote Under Age 35

(Respondents Under Age 35)



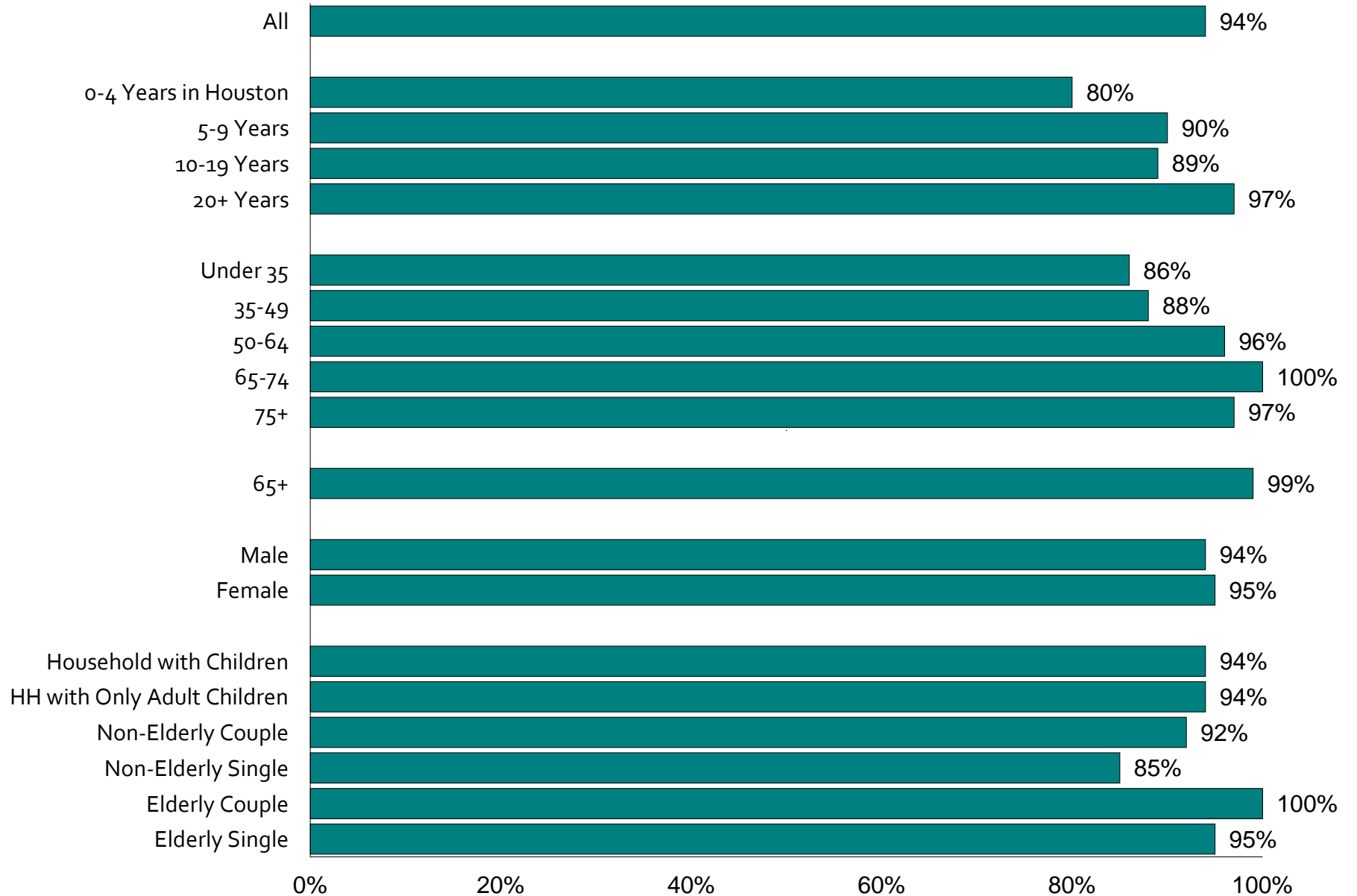
