## Advocacy Day Recap

On Tuesday over 250 Jewish community members from across Maryland joined the Baltimore Jewish Council, the Jewish Community Relations Council of Greater Washington, and the Jewish Federation of Howard County for our annual Jewish Advocacy Day. Participants met with their legislators and concentrated on four key issues: anti-boycott, divestment & sanctions (BDS) legislation; earned sick leave; the BOOST scholarship initiative,; and budget priorities. After their meetings, community members celebrated with legislators and members of Governor Hogan's administration at a reception in the Miller Senate Office Building.

Also present at Advocacy Day were 40 teens from Students Taking Action for Change (STAC) and the Elijah Cummings Youth Program in Israel (ECYP). The students toured the State House, watched their first floor session, listened in on key hearings, met with their legislators and hosted a mock bill debate before they joined the reception. Thank you to everyone who made this year's Advocacy Day a success!
